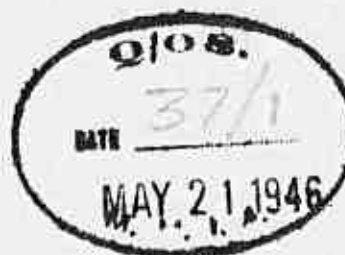

SUBJECT: Capacity of Italian (BR-ITI) Rft Depots and Training Center

TO: All Concerned

1. Reference is made to letter, this headquarters, file reference DMT/87/MT1, dated 9 January 1945 (not to Headquarters 1 District, Rome Area).

2. Clothing and equipment has now become available in sufficient quantity to allow of an increase in the planned intake of Italians into the Army. As a result it will be necessary to increase the capacity of Italian Base Rft Depots and RTC ICF beyond the figures agreed at the DMT meeting. These figures were:

3. Revised figures will be:

Italian Combat Force Rft Trg Center	2,500	11,250

4. Addressees are requested to base plans for training, maintenance and final accommodation on these increased figures.

Subject: Italian Army (000-000)

C. All concerned.

1. The Italian Army has been in operation as a co-ordinated force for some sixteen months, and in that time it has accumulated considerable experience for the Allies. It has proved necessary to set conditions in Allied material resources into the maintenance of the Italian Army and all necessary steps should be taken to ensure an adequate return on this outlay. It is essential that all British units and divisions working with the Italian Army should interest themselves in the Italian Army unit under their control, so that efficiency is increased and losses of manpower reduced to a minimum.

2. Certain orders are now being issued for Italian Depot and Training Establishments as under:-

3. These units all have British staffs attached, and these staffs should be given every help to ensure the smooth working of the Italian Training and Depot System.

4. Where specialist training is arranged by attachment of recruits to British units or schools, an active interest should be taken in the Italians, so that maximum benefit may be obtained from them by the Allies when they join their units.

5. The concerned will submit reports on the working of these Depots and schools and will include in these reports any remarks on

outlay. It is essential that all British E. & W. Co. Ltd. which are with the Italian Gov. should be kept in the Italian pay and under their control, as the settlement is increased and means of cooperation, which is a necessity.

4. It is not considered advisable completely to equip these men owing to abnormal losses experienced during the time elapping from departure from camp until arrival at destination.
