Reference your 12 A dated 6 May 45.

1. Your para 1. It is correct to say that a Gruppo is equipped and maintained through normal British supply channels, and that all vehicles and equipment supplied are held on charge by the Gruppo or any of its supporting units. It is, however, incorrect to say that all vehicles and equipment supplied to a Gruppo are debited against the Italian Government. The position is as follows. The Gruppi are treated, basically like any other unit of the Italian Army and receive a basic scale of clothing and equipment as laid down by the Combined Chiefs of Staff in PAM 338 of 26.2.44, no copy to you. If, however, we decided to use any portion of the Italian Army to fulfil an allotted task for which the basic scale of clothing and equipment is insufficient, then extra equipment may be loaned to them to carry out the task. In this direction, you are invited to read AG Memorandum 400/105 of 22 Sep, para 3(a). It will, therefore, be seen that, whilst the Gruppi are, in fact, receiving British equipment, it is not debited to the Italian Government. In another directive AG 400/031 GDS of 6 Oct 44, copy to HQ 5 Army, it is stated that when the allotted task has been completed and we require the Gruppi to return such equipment that they have had on loan, any items of equipment originally supplied and not returned after a period of 15 days on receipt of demand to return, will then be debited to the Italian Government. It is obvious that the question of vehicles HLR'A, leases of equipment, are not covered.

2. This Headquarters has not yet received any guidance from the War Office on the financial angle or ultimate charges to be made against the Italian Government for any or all of equipment supplied, to fulfil an allotted task. For your information, this staff section is now actively pursuing this matter with the Financial Adviser and other interested parties in this Headquarters, in the hope of achieving at least an interim policy. You will be advised immediately a decision has been reached.

3. In the meantime, you are requested to continue to record all losses, the SLU should investigate and AFM G 998 should be completed and disposed of through MIA. In this way we shall have a record of all leases of equipment so that should the ultimate policy be that the Italian Government pay, we have records ready to implement such a decision.

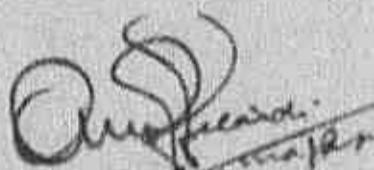

1. A ruling is requested on the position of Italian Gruppi di Combattimenti in relation to Losses of Vehicles and/or Equipment of any sort and the procedure to be adopted.

2. Each Gruppo is equipped and maintained thro' British sources through normal supply channels and the B.I.U. attached to the Gruppo. All vehicles and equipment so supplied are held on charge by the Gruppo direct and not by the B.I.U. or other Unit of Formation on behalf of the Gruppo.

3. All vehicles and equipment supplied to a Gruppo are debited against the Italian Government. The system of accounting and payment is not known to this unit but is carried out by B.I.U.

4. From the above it would appear that the question of writing off any such losses or charging payment of the whole or any part of the lease to an individual in an Italian internal matter only, as whatever the decision the ultimate cost of replacement is borne by the Italian Government. It is therefore considered that the normal British procedure of Courts of Inquiry is not applicable.

5. It is requested that:-

1) A ruling be obtained that losses be dealt with through Italian channels and that British procedure be dispensed with.

2) A directive be issued as to the correct procedure for obtaining replacements of vehicles and equipment lost where write off action has been taken through Italian channels.
