1. The General Staff has decided to make the remnants of the Garribaldi Div into an Italian Combat Group. It will not be on the same scale in size as previous combat groups in so far as it will contain three Infantry Bns only. There will be no supporting troops so far as is at present known.

2. The Garribaldi Combat Group will concentrate at Viterbo within the next week. Upon arrival in their concentration area, they will immediately become a fighting responsibility for clothing and equipment. You will therefore arrange for 3,000 sets of M4A1 pants, (there is no point in putting them in battle dress at this stage), underwear, boots, equipment, etc., to be packed and sent to this Rome area Allied Command for issue upon their arrival at Viterbo.

3. Suggested method of equipping is that the JAG now at GSH/1043 take over the liaison part of things and that JAG/1043 is the responsible Ordnance representative through whom all requests for equipment required should be channelled. This Staff Section will release such controlled stores as are required to JAG/1043.

4. It is not known when this Combat Group will be required for operations. JAG/1043 will notify this Staff Section in due course.
