With ref. to R.E. services carried out through Italian Army channels since the maintenance of isolated units was introduced is given below to give a picture of any bills which may pass from Italian channels to you.

(a) Married Quarters (O.R.s)

With the number of O.R.s on the establishment having permission to marry, quarters had to be provided, this was obtained by converting existing requisitioned flats into two married quarters each, and in such a way four quarters were provided up to the standard of providing adequate cooking, hot water and baths and colour wash or distempered buildings.

(b) Married quarters (Officers)

The cost expended on this type of quarter was only general maintenance and making the quarter allotted up to a good state of repair, such as repairs to window, over hauled of central heating and electricity and gas.

(c) Officers Mess

This building although on a British requisition had been occupied by a section of the Italian C.I.C. and an amount of repairs were needed to make this house in a good state of repair. It is interesting to note that this building has now been handed over to the R.A.F. as a mess and living accommodation so that the cost expended on repairs has not been lost to military needs.

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It is considered that all R.E. services carried out through Italian Army channels have been essential and that the costs have been fair and reasonable.

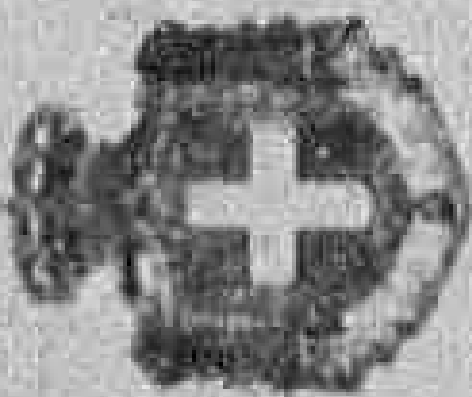

Further to verbal agreement between Maj Coplestone and Lt:Col. Pecoraro.

26th Engrs Repair W/shop at Villa Vicentina has pointed out that releases of equipment are still taking place to other Units upon authority of Allied Authorities.

Thus for instance:

- two hutments, type Russia have been released to the State Railways Works Office of Cervignano.
- A stock of fencing pickets has been drawn by trucks from Trieste Comune.
- 80 tons of wired-irons (12 m/m thick) is being transferred to the Ship yards.

In order to avoid further losses and releases of materials we ask your Mission to consider the possibility that Allied Authorities concerned authorise the Italian Military Admin. to withdraw from its stores the remaining material stored at Villa Vicentina.
