1. A certain communication was arisen at 2 Comandante Militare Territoriale over the writing of War Ministry letters 1/2306/ser dated 1 Dec 65 addressed to you and 1/310/ser dated 28 Sep 65 addressed to 2 Comandante Militare Territoriale offices of both of which have been sent to this HQ.

2. This HQ submitted reports to 2 Comandante Militare Territoriale for the provision of space heating in billets occupied by personnel of this Unit, there being no longer a Unit HQ in GULCA, who would normally have performed this work.

3. Though Comandante Militare have surveyed all the billets requiring space-heating and estimated the extent of fittings required, they consider that the word "maintenance" (mantinut), which they are bound by the War Ministry letters to carry out, does not incl such work as this.

4. It is pointed out that winters in GULCA are very harsh and that the normal ord issue of 6 stores oil burning with their relatively low horsepower allocation would not be sufficient to heat three separate flats and one Villa. Further, owing to their size or sit, central heating is either impossible or impracticable in any of the billets.

5. It is felt that 2 Comandante should be empowered by War Ministry to carry out work such as the above without, as is at present the case, having to refer each request to them for decision.

6. War Ministry has now been approached by 2 Comandante Militare Territoriale and as the matter will doubtless be referred to you, it would be appropriate if your authorization could be given for the speedy execution of this work.

Capt. LOCKWOOD TATHAM RASC, our Liaison Officer at 7 BLU, inspected the above unit on June 17th, and the following comments resulting from his inspection are passed on to you for your information and whatever action you may consider necessary.

1. Although efforts have been made to improve drainage it is still not adequate.
2. 40 civilian labourers were employed, and it is considered that this number is excessive.
3. The O.C. was anxious to move to better accommodation at Ponte di Messo, but the move is being held up owing to the delay in necessary engineering work outstanding there; it is suggested that this work is expedited in order to accelerate the move.

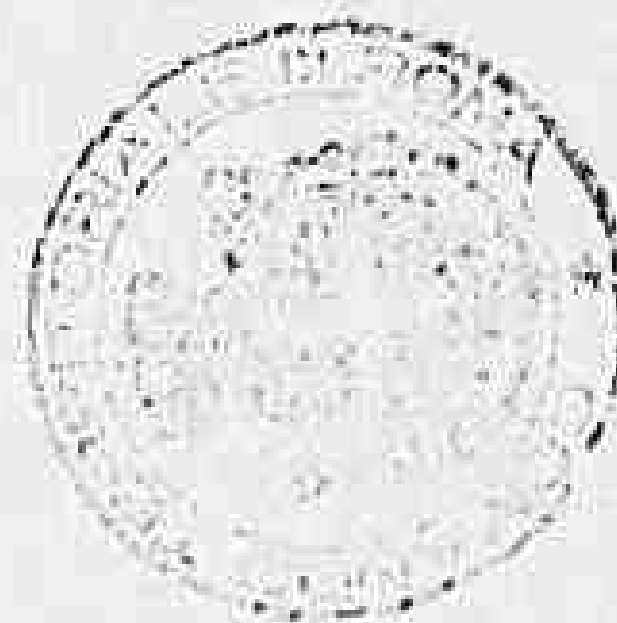

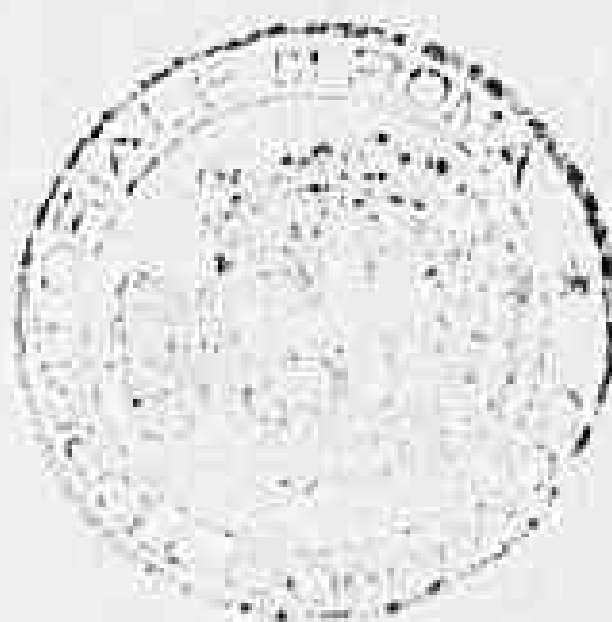
