SEARCHLIGHT MATERIAL FROM SARDINIA

1. A report has been submitted by Col. Dalfiume regarding the shocking state of searchlight equipment consigned from Sardinia as a result of negligence in its handling, guarding, loading and unloading. Much of the equipment is irreparably ruined - i.e. projectors with shattered mirrors - in other instances valuable and vital parts have been removed while most of the tool and spare boxes have been rifled.
2. Since there is still more searchlight material to come over from the island it would be appreciated if strong representations were made to the appropriate authorities to insure that further consignments of equipment are properly handled and guarded. If this is not possible it is suggested that the equipment be left in Sardinia since, if it experiences the same treatment, it will be of no use to us and the more valuable parts will only find their way to the Black Market.



(12 January 1945)

1. 574 Coast Regt. R.A. are retaining the use of one 90/53 gun of the ANNA Battery, ISCHIA. This is in addition to the equipment specified in MMIA letter 6/3 of 15 December 1944.

It was not considered necessary to obtain prior authority for this retention because, as all the guns must inevitably remain on the island, they are better cared for when they are manned and in use.

1. Reference MR letter 091.711/367 G.C.P.-O dated 11 November, 1944, addressed to Chief Commissioner, the Allied Commission for Land Forces Sub-Commission (MLTA).

2. Para. 6 of above-mentioned letter states that Italian Military authorities be requested to make available for our use all searchlight equipment and spares at the "Officina Galileo" Florence.

Before sending a truck to Florence to collect spares, including carbons, it would be appreciated if you would ask the Italian authorities to instruct the "Officina Galileo" to allow searchlight stores to be withdrawn as and when demanded by a properly accredited representative of this Headquarters.

3. Additional supplies of equipment and stores have recently been inspected inardinia by our Searchlight Liaison Officer and Col. Voltiune. These, it is understood, will be brought over to the mainland with other military stores in the course.

It is not known what priority is being given to the transportation of this equipment to the mainland but it is requested that as and when the equipment is brought over it should all be consigned to the 3 Compagnia Fotoelettricisti at Nervi (working exclusively for MAF) and also that priority should be given to the mobile type of equipment ("Autofoto") and to the 60 cm. equipment which includes vapour mercury projectors ("a vapor" or "mercurio") of which there are six at Cagliari (Cagliari).

It is requested also that the authorities at Sardinia be instructed to release any searchlight material which this Headquarters may require as and when demanded by Col. Voltiune or any MAF official. It may shortly be necessary to fly quantities of carbons over from the island to the mainland.

1. 19 R.A.C.A.T. cannot be disbanded until:
 - (a) Guns are dismantled and stored at DIREZIONE ARTIGLIERIA CAVIA.
 - (b) Ammunition removed to PIENO DI MASTRO-POZZUOLI.
 - (c) Accommodation stores removed to NAPLES ()
2. At present we are working on the guns with one track heavy breakdown, on loan from 22 AA Bde, and 8 to 10 trucks (partly from Corlit Companies and partly from 22 AA Bde.). Work is going ahead well, but is occasionally held up through lack of transport or non-availability of the crane to unload at CAVIA (borrowed from 17 Transit Depot R.A.C.O.). At present 7 heavy pieces, 11 mountings and 20 platforms remain to be removed; in addition there are still 8 x 20 mm guns to be removed. All above belong to Army batteries.
3. The ammunition has nearly all been removed already from the Army AA Batteries, and is no problem.
4. All accommodation stores for Army Batteries, which should be removed last, will take approximately 25 vehicle trips.
5. Almost all the guns and ammunition of IV C.D. Group are being taken over by 574 Coast Regt. RA, leaving only 4 guns with ammunition to be removed.
6. The Naval H.A.A. Batteries (195, 606, 813, 180, and 215) are being left to the last. A verbal understanding has been given to provide a crane and transport when available for removal of the guns and ammunition, but the position will have to be reviewed once the army units have been dissolved and personnel assigned to P.B.S.
7. It is estimated that, provided facilities remain available as at present, all army personnel will be available for assignment to 212 Command by 15 December 1944, with possible exception of one or two small detachments.

Figures, showing number of men each Battery, are being obtained. It should be possible to ship ISCHIA and CAIARI personnel direct to NICIDII or BAGNOLI for ASTROMI.



1. Reference (s) stated that the four (4) 75 mm. AA guns manned by T/720 Battery, 1st Regiment Artiglieri Marini, and deployed on Grottammare Airfield (Heel of Italy) were no longer required and requested that they be withdrawn from action. The battery concerned was under the command of the Italian Ministry of Marine.

2. This office has been informed by the Minister of Marine that the dismantling of AA battery No. T-720 has been ordered and that the guns will be stored in a magazine. The personnel, approximately 5 officers and 70 men, has been absorbed by other batteries in service which are in need of replacements.
