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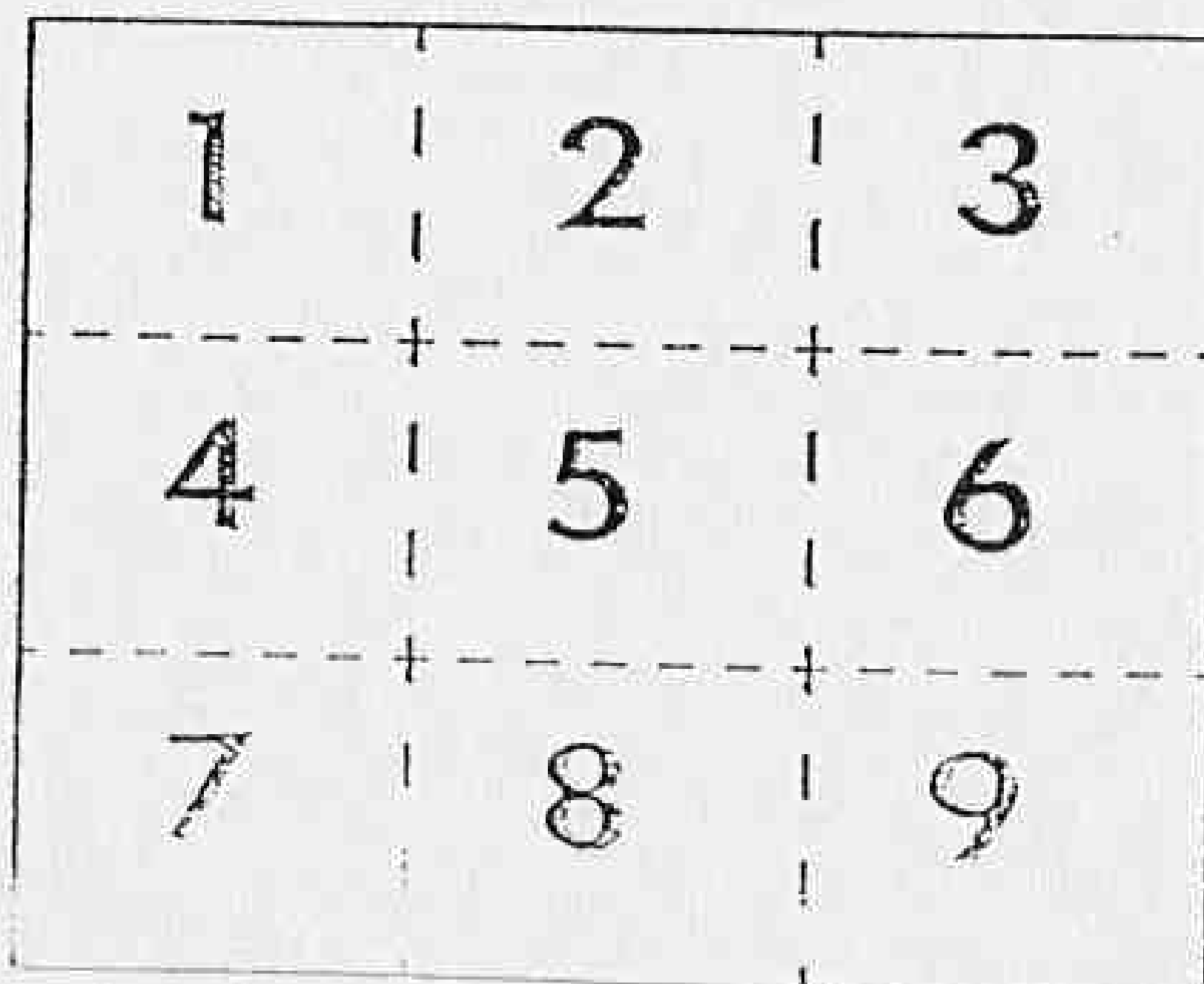
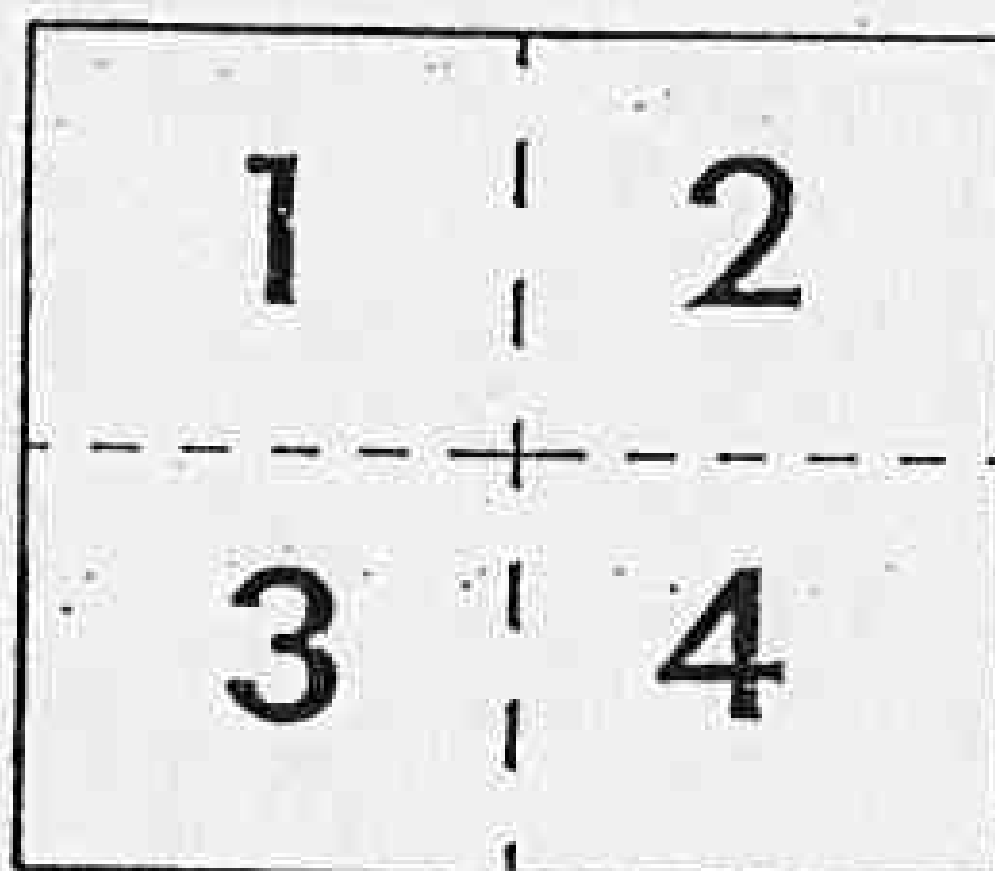
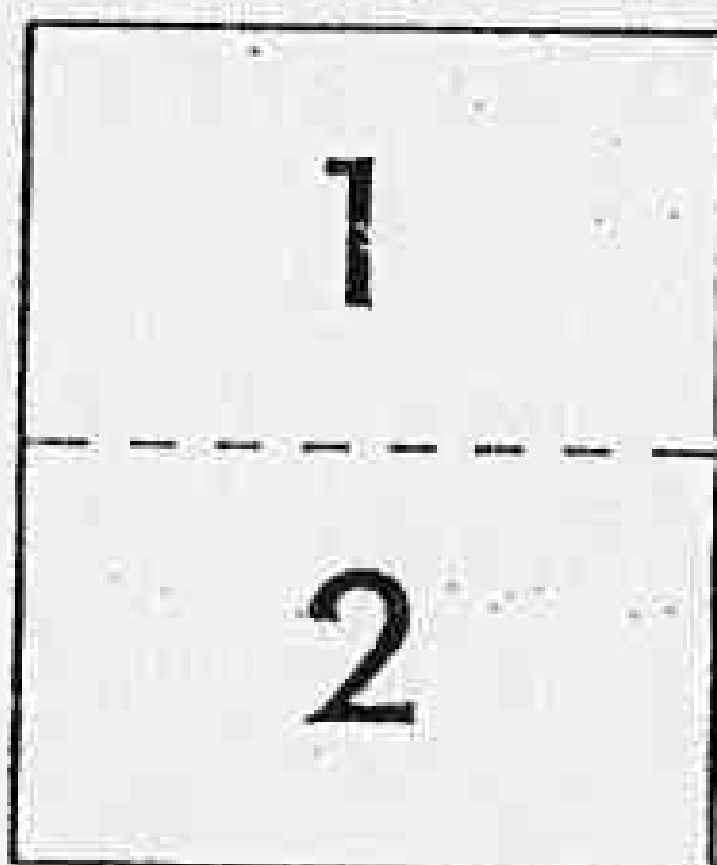

1. We are assured by the Ministry of War that by the middle of December the deficiencies referred to by General PAINTER will have been made up. These officers will be drawn from the following sources, which explain the delay :-

- (a) Officers who have returned from internment in Germany. Most of these returned to ITALY in September, have received 60 days repatriation leave and will therefore be available for duty towards the end of November.
- (b) Reserve officers now being pulled up, vide para 4 of A 117 of 24 Oct. Of these, 5 Artillery and 4 Infantry officers are earmarked for CREMONA Division. They are expected to join the Division at the beginning of December.
- (c) Regular officers newly commissioned from the LECON Academy who finish a course at CESAMO on 22 December.

2. Meanwhile six of the thirteen officers referred to in your A 626 of 21 October have been permanently posted to CREMONA Division, and 3 officers (3 Captains and 6 Lieutenants) left 802 Reorganisation Centre OVHITO for CREMONA Division on 1 November. It is hoped, therefore, that the Division will be fully manned by the end of November.

December the deficiencies referred to by General FAHREY will have been made up. These officers will be drawn from the following sources, which explain the delay:-

- (a) Officers who have returned from internment in Germany. Most of these returned to ITALY in September, have received 60 days repatriation leave and will therefore be available for duty towards the end of November.
 - (b) Reserve officers now being called up, vide para 4 of A 117 of 24 Oct. Of these, 3 Artillery and 4 Infantry officers are earmarked for CHEMOM Division. They are expected to join the Division at the beginning of December.
 - (c) Regular officers newly commissioned from the LICCE Academy who finish a course at CESANG on 22 December.
2. Meanwhile six of the thirteen officers referred to in your A 626 of 21 October have been permanently posted to CHEMOMA Division, and 3 officers (3 Captains and 3 Lieutenants) left 802 Reorganisation Centre Orville for CHEMOMA Division on 1 November. It is hoped, therefore, that the situation is now substantially better than when you wrote on 19 October.
3. The question of Lieutenant CAUHA is being replied to separately.

As known, the definition of screening procedures (and consequently, separation) assumes an ever increasing importance in the framework of the reorganisation of the army. The uncertain position caused by these procedures prevails on the officers' category with serious moral and economical repercussions.

Furthermore, the definition of screening procedures becomes urgent in view of the carrying out of work dealing with the technical selection of officers.

1. The points made in your report of 15 October to General BROWNING on the subject of officer deficiencies have been noted, and we will do all we can for you.
2. The information you have given us in various signals regarding these deficiencies has been passed on to the Ministry of War and impressed on them. We hope to send you shortly details of the number of officers Cremona may expect to have posted to them.
3. The Ministry's main difficulties are that of officers available from distanded units a large proportion are due for demobilization; and that the requirement of 635 officers for training at GESANO in order to become instructors for the new Territorial Training Centres has absorbed many of the officers most suitable for the Infantry Divisions.
4. Authority has been given today for the call-up of 209 young Reserve officers, a proportion of whom should soon be posted to you.
5. Your A 15 of 17 October has just arrived and will receive attention in the same connection.

Ref conversation with OC 51 BLU reference the precarious situation as regards Officers in which this Gruppo finds itself for various reasons. The fact is that an insufficient number of Officers are available for training, operations and to maintain discipline.

The attached table shows that the number of Officers available is enough to perform the above mentioned duties if one takes into account the establishment. But the following points must be borne in mind. They show that this is not the case and I feel it my duty to point them out.

1. From the total number of Officers present today, 66 will be lost, some to be transferred, others to be discharged and others to be sent on quarterly leave because they are University students. They are still with their units because they have not been replaced. These are Officers who have been waiting to go for some time and have lost their keenness and they do not work as they should do.
2. Garrison duties (gds at Arms, installations, frontier duties) deduct another 12 Officers. To these should be added those detailed for barracks duties (Duty Officer etc) which amount to approx. another 24 Officers.
3. The course on "intelligence" ordered by the General Staff take away from their units as instructors and students another 14 Officers.

These will have to be trained. With the available Officers the Gruppo is in a more than precarious poen and the Coys will only have one or two Officers.

In view of the above may 66 Officers be allotted to this Gruppo to substitute those awaiting discharge and those awaiting to go on quarterly leave or as has already been asked, 10 to 15% of Officers over establishment, all subalterns.

May this matter be represented to the proper authorities as it is particularly urgent.

For the moment I have had to stop all Officers' leave.

ITALIAN ARMY - OFFICERS.

In accordance with the orders of the Supreme Allied Commander as published in SMIA Administration Instruction No 18 of 1 Dec 1944 (paras 4c, 9b and d, and 12) the following procedure will be adopted for the supervision of officers' appointments.

1. Appointments, promotions, transfers, discharges or disciplinary measures in respect of Italian Army Officers will be effected by the Ministry of War in accordance with Italian Army Regulations and subject to the following supervision by SMIA.

2. Italian Officers for these purposes will be classified as follows:-

General Officers.
Grade 1. Colonels, Lt Colonels and Majors.
Grade 2. Captains and Subalterns.
Grade 3.

3. Appropriate action will be taken in one of the following ways:-

- Miscellaneous Action for breach of military discipline under Italian military law.
- Adverse Report for inefficiency as an officer.
- Displacement Report for unsuitability in present employment.
- Favourable Report for officers recommended for advancement on account of good work.

In each case the recognised Italian methods and procedures will be followed. Otherwise more rapid means will be taken.

Grade 1. General Dislike.Grade 2. Colonel, Lt Colonel and Major.Grade 3. Captain and Lieutenant.

3. Immediate action will be taken in one of the following ways:-

(a) Disciplinary Action for breach of military discipline under Italian Military Law.

(b) Adverse Report for insubordination as an officer.

(c) Displacement Report for unsuitability in present employment.

(d) Favourable Report for officers recommended for advancement on account of good work.

In each case the recognised Italian methods and procedure will be used where time permits. Otherwise no award shall be given at the discretion of the commanding officer (Allied or Italian).

4. Action may be originated by:-

(a) The Allied Command (or his liaison staff) if the award of troops submitted by the Italian (Allied or Italian) or of other troops directly under Allied command.

(b) The Director IFA in the case of troops maintained in Italy nationally (Allied or Italian), and not directly under Allied command.

(c) The Commanding Officer (Italian) of the officer concerned, in the case of a unit of any category.

5. Action originated by an Allied authority (including Director IFA) will proceed as follows:-

Grade 1 (and Colonel) will be referred fully to the Allied Commander concerned to IFA for action with the Ministry of War. The Commanding Officer (Italian) of a officer concerned will be informed of action being taken, to enable him to pass his opinion to the Ministry of War through Italian Channels.

5. (Cont'd).

Grade 2. Colonels as for Grade 1 above.

Lt. Colonels and Majors will be referred to the Commanding Officer (Italian) concerned (with copy to WHIA) for necessary action through Italian channels to the Ministry of War who will report action taken to WHIA. If satisfactory results are not obtained within reasonable time, a report will be made through normal Allied channels to the appropriate Army, District or Base Section Commander for reference to the Senior Italian authority under his command. If this fails to achieve its object a full report (with recommendation) will be made by the Allied Commander direct to WHIA for action with the Ministry of War.

Grade 3. Will be dealt with through Italian channels except in a serious case or when the officer concerned has previously been reported on by an Allied Commander when it will be dealt with as for Grade 2.

6. Action originated by the Commanding Officer (Italian) will proceed as follows:

Grade 1. (and Colonels) will be referred through Italian channels to the Ministry of War who will only take action after consultation with WHIA. If the officer is in a unit under Allied Command, the Allied Commander concerned will be informed (through the appropriate Liaison Officer) so that he may forward his opinion (either with the report or separately) to WHIA.

Grade 2. Colonels, as for Grade 1 above.
Lt Colonels and Majors will be dealt with through

6. Action originated by the Commanding Officer (Italian) will proceed as follows: -

Grade 2. Colonels, as for Grade 1 above.

Lt Colonels and Majors will be dealt with through Italian channels to the Ministry of War, who will report action to MHA. The appropriate Allied Commander or his Liaison Officer will be informed of the recommendation and of its result.

Grade 3. Will be dealt with through Italian channels except in a serious case or when the officer has previously been reported on by an Allied Commander when it will be dealt with as for Grade 2.

7. The filling of appointments which have become vacant for any cause, is the responsibility of the War Ministry. When caused by action under para 5 or 6 above, or where the officer proposed to fill the appointment has been involved in such action, the proposal will first be referred to MHA.

8. An officer removed from an appointment on the recommendation of an Allied Commander will not be re-employed except with approval of MHA.

9. In any case where an Allied Commander considers that an Italian Officer should be dismissed from the army, a full report is sent by that Allied Commander to MHA, whose responsibility it is to ensure that such action is taken as is warranted by the facts of the case (vide Adm. Instr. No 18 para 12).

- 3 -

10. The above procedure does not affect:-
- (a) The authority of any Allied Commander to suspend from duty temporarily any Italian Officer placed under his Command who falls in his duties (referred to in MIA Adm Instruction No 18 para 9(b)).
 - (b) The recognised procedure for placing under arrest or on charge any officer accused of any breach of Italian Military Law.
11. If there is any doubt as to the correct procedure in any case not covered by the above instructions, the matter is to be referred to MIA for decision.

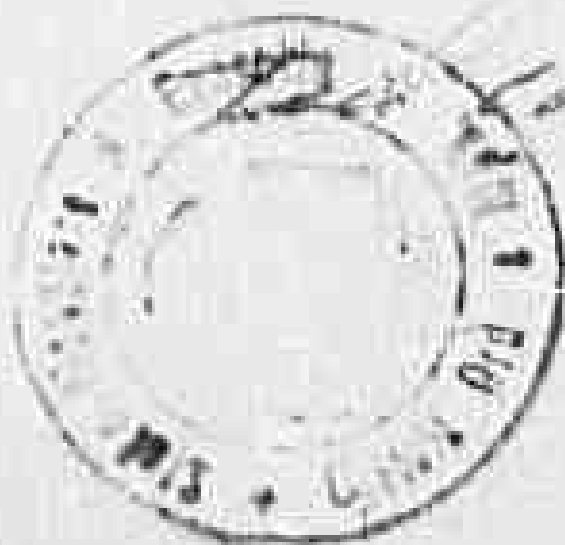

1. The C.A.O. has been considering carefully your letter 4/5/2 of 5 Jul on the subject of provision of Italian Officers for parties of EV employed on mine clearance. Capt GARDNER has written a similar note almost word for word as you as he also has been asked for the 7 officers. I am answering this as the C.A.O. is anxious for it not to be brought to a head.

2. PRINCE 101 is undoubtedly under Allied Command for Ops and for all major ADM. but it is undoubtedly within the province of the War Ministry to run minor matters of internal Italian ADM. I think the posting of those officers might have quite reasonably been considered in this light.

3. The whole matter of this mine clearance is on the highest level of priority. The C.A.O. personally discussed this with the C.G.O. and stressed that everything possible must be done. The 7 officers must go and must be good chaps. If we bring this to an "open fight" the officers will still go and we shall have created a fuss for nothing and a fuss which is contrary to the C.A.O.'s expressed policy.

4. The whole question of Italian ADM control of groups is between Districts/M.O./Territorial HQ/SEA HQ/BN etc is being thrashed out now and the days will come to you as quickly as possible.

G-5 Section, AFHQ, has informed this Headquarters that it has been agreed that the Italian Government may be permitted to appoint service attaches to neutral capitals subject to each individual appointment being approved by both the British and American representatives as well as the Supreme Allied Commander Mediterranean. Consideration would also be taken as to whether such appointments would be useful to the Allied war effort.

2. In the case of the United Nations, appointments would be limited to countries whose forces are actively engaged in the Italian theatre and would also be subject to SACMED's approval.

3. It is not intended that this information be transmitted to the Italian Government unless applications have been received by you from the Italian Government for the appointment of service attaches. Therefore, it would be appreciated if you would inform the Executive Commissioner's Office if any applications have been received to date.

SUBJECT: Replacement of Officers entitled to be discharged.

1. As you know, approximately 1,500 officers who have their residence in Mother Italy, must be discharged from the army.
2. The replacement of these officers could be carried out as follows:-
 - (a) by transferring officers becoming available following the disbandment of units. However, we have no basis to calculate the number of officers which may be obtained from that source.
 - (b) by employing gradually, regular army officers repatriated from P O W Camps. However, due to the actual speed of repatriation, this procedure is so slow that it is inclined to delay the discharge of those who are entitled to be discharged.
 - (c) by calling up to the army for probationary service, the officers in the reserve who have not yet done such service.
3. Whichever decision is taken, it is expected that there will be a fluctuation in strength:-
 - (1) in excess, for the short period during which officers to be discharged will be working together with those who are going to replace them.
 - (2) less, in the event of deciding (although without causing a crisis in the functioning of the units) to discharge officers for whom there is no necessity to provide substitutes.
4. Of the solutions submitted we are in favour of adopting those referred to in para 2 letter a and b alone. In order to hasten these discharges, we could also adopt, when possible, that referred to in para 3 no. 2 above.

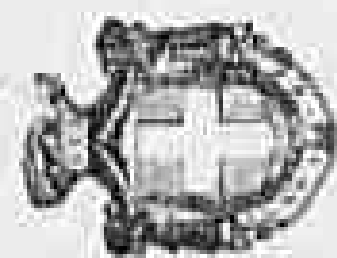

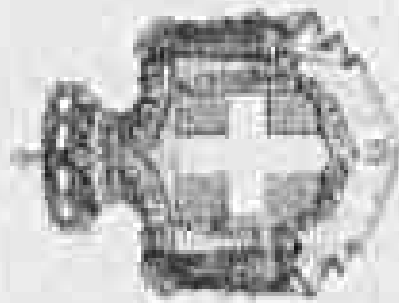

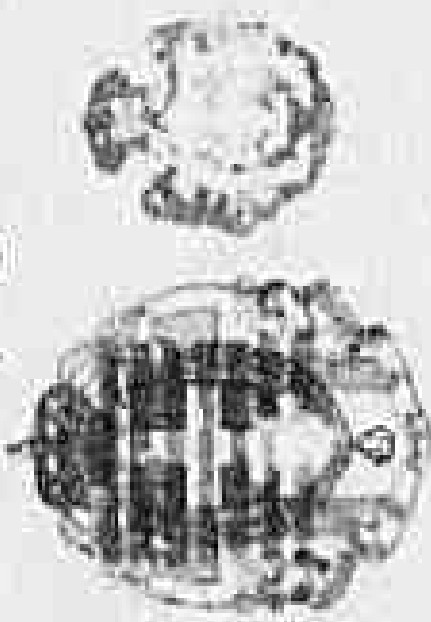

They will be dealt with immediately in one of the following ways.

- (c) Demobilized.

One of the above courses will be followed irrespective as to whether the officer is a Regular or on the Reserve.
