SUBJECT: Recognition of Patriots Military rank.

1) - At the meeting held on the 16th. January, the Council of Ministers decided to recognise the rank reassumed by patriots at the orders of units operating against the nazi-fascists.

In view of this a Lieutenantcy Decree draft was drawn up which laid down, in substance, that:

- a) - such recognition - up to the rank of Lieut. Col. in the Army or equivalent rank of the other Armed Forces, only - would be carried out, taking into consideration the size of the unit commanded, in action against the enemy, by the competent Minister for each Armed Force after having heard the opinion of the appropriate Commission which he will appoint (Arts. 1 and 2);

b) - the forming of a patriots transitory roll was planned in which would have been entered both the patriots who were originally soldiers and those who were civilians; (Art. 4);

c) - the regular army officers and NCOs, instead of being entered

- a) - such recognition - up to the rank of lieutenant. In the army or equivalent rank of the other Armed Forces, only - would be carried out, taking into consideration the size of the unit commanded, in action against the enemy, by the competent Minister for each Armed Force after having heard the opinion of the appropriate Commission which he will appoint (Arts. 1 and 2);
- b) - the forming of a patriots transitory roll was planned in which would have been entered both the patriots who were originally soldiers and those who were civilians; (Art.4);
- c) - the regular army officers and NCOs, instead of being entered on said roll, would have been reentered on the respective rolls of their former service in the rank which they had reassumed; 1988
- Eventual recognition of higher ranks would be carried out on the basis of instructions in force for promotion for merit in the field. This recognition would have been permanent. (Art.3);
- d) - for the reserve officers and NCOs, Junior NCOs, and O.R.s, and for patriots not belonging to the Armed Forces of the State, the eventual recognition of rank on the part of the Commission referred to above would have been carried out only on a temporary basis. The permanent confirmation and transfer to the reserve rolls would have taken place at the end of the war (Art.3);

e) - the possibility was planned, finally, of transferring to the regular army rolls, at the time of the reorganization of the Armed Forces at the end of the present conflict, the officers and NCOs entered on the patriots transitory roll, with ranks to be determined later (Art. 5).

2) - On the 12th. March 1945, the Ministry of War - Cabinet - forwarded with letter 931/L.O. the draft of the Legislative Decree intended to establish the rules for ~~the~~ said recognition to the Minister concerned, for ~~the~~ necessary approval.

On the 15th. March 1945, the Ministry of War - Cabinet - issued, with memo. 572/L.O., ~~all the Ministers with~~ the draft of the legislative decree referred to above *to all Ministers*.

On the 16th. March 1945, the Council of Ministers approved said legislative measure with the exception of agreement with the minister for Occupied Italy (enclosure 1).

On the 22nd. March 1945, the complete approval of the minister for Occupied Italy was received provided that one of his representatives was included in the commission referred to in Art. 2 of the draft.

On the 22nd. March 1945, the complete approval was received of the Navy Minister who proposed some amendments which were

On the 28th. March 1945, ~~the~~ complete approval was received of the Finance Minister who would have liked the measure to have applied to the troops of the Carabinieri Division also. This proposal was rejected by this Ministry.

On the 4th. April 1945, the approval of the Air Minister was received.

On the 9th. and 10th. of April however, the Minister of

Occupied Italy verbally proposed other alterations through the War Ministry L.O. at that Ministry (Lt. Col. CANO), notwithstanding having already given its approval. Following verbal agreements made between H.E. Casati and H.E. Scoccimarro, the latter agreed to withdraw the request for the alterations which he made through the L.O., insisting only, in order that the decree be passed, that the opinion of the Minister for Occupied Italy be consulted in addition to that of the Ministerial commissions before recognition of rank. This alteration having been accepted, the decree was all ready for signing, in the text shown in enclosure 1, when on the 28th. April 1945 new proposals for alteration were received from the Minister for Occupied Italy.

To our observations in which were explained the reasons for being unable to comply with the proposed alterations, the Minister for Occupied Italy replied with letter of 15th. May giving notice that if we insisted on not complying with his requests he would resubmit the draft of the decree to the examination of the Council of Ministers for amendment, with the text as shown in enclosure 2.

It was decided to consult H.E. Cadorna, Commandant C.V.I., and Army Chief of Staff, before replying to the latest letter of the Minister for Occupied Italy.

3) - The main differences between the draft of the decree ^{page 6} by the Minister of War and that proposed by the Minister for Occupied Italy, are the following:-

- a) - The Ministry of War intended to recognise the ranks of those who were distinguished at the unit command in action against the enemy; the Ministry for Occupied Italy wanted to extend the recognition to the organisers of the patriot formations as well;
- b) - the Ministry of War planned for the promotion of regular army officers and NCOs to the next highest rank on the grounds of meritorious service in the field and by the normal procedure; the Ministry for Occupied Italy upheld the principle that said personnel could jump more than one rank.

c) - the Ministry of War planned for a ministerial commission for each Armed Force; the Ministry for Occupied Italy insisted on a single interministerial commission.

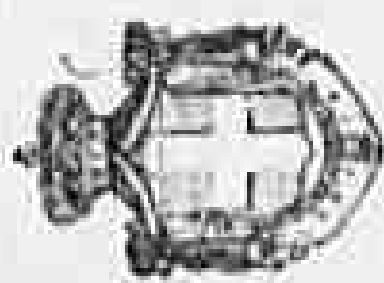

1. The War Ministry has furnished the following replies to the questions you raise reference the enrollment of partisans :-

- (a) It is confirmed that recruits may not exceed 26 years of age and they must be at least 19 years of age.
- (b) For the present, partisans are given the same rank they formerly held in the Italian Army and the rank is not, therefore, restricted to the maximum rank of caporale maggiore. Ranks held in partisan organizations are not, at present, recognized. A law, now under discussion, is contemplated which will give partisans a rank in the Italian Army corresponding to the one held in partisan units, the maximum rank to be Lt. Colonel. However, this is still in the study and discussion phase and is for your information only.
