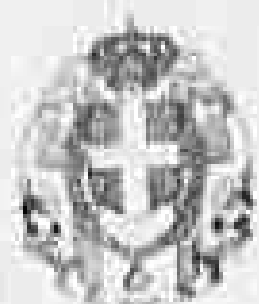

1. It is agreed that Medical and Pharmacist officers who are entitled to discharge should be replaced by the qualified personnel to whom you refer, but it is not considered desirable to increase further the total number of officers so employed.
2. Authority is given, therefore, to commission officers to fill vacancies created by the demobilisation of Medical and Pharmacist officers on a one for one basis.
3. The preliminary training at military hospitals should take place before the men are commissioned.

SUBJECT : 113 Mobile Dental Unit

"CHESONA" Combat Gp has requested SMRE to put the 113 Mob Dental Unit at the disposal of same Gp to meet the requirements of the troops under command.

Bearing in mind that the 113 Mob Dental Unit:-

- Has already been assigned to PRIULI and CHESONA Combat Gps as an auxiliary unit;

- has served - for one month - at the CHESONA Combat Gp and successively has been put at the disposal of the PRIULI Combat Gp where it is actually located since the month of March 45.

We beg MMIA to authorize the temporary transfer of this Ambulance to the CHESONA Gp in order to split in equal measure the service between the 2 Combat Gps, to meet requirements of troops under command.

Subject: Drafting of Doctors and Chemists.

The deficiency of Medical and Pharmaceutical Officers in the cadres and the need to replace those elements who have the right to be discharged from the army, call for the urgent employment as 2nd. Lieuts M . O. of men who are in possession of medical and pharmaceutical degrees. These men should have the following ~~xxx~~ qualifications:

- (A) They should not yet have fulfilled military service.
- (B) They ~~should be~~ in the army (including combat groups) as N.C.Os or O.Rs .

For the time being about 450 doctors and about 50 pharmacists are available. They could be employed thus improving considerably the actual situation.

The best procedure to be followed in order to use a/m personnel as officers is to incorporate them immediately in the army as 2nd. Lieuts as soon as their moral, physical, and intellectual qualities have been ascertained. Commission will be granted as soon as the procedure established by standing laws has been carried out.

These Lieuts will be posted for one month at military hospitals to undergo a minimum of training before being posted to the units.

We beg M.M.I.A. kindly to ~~grant approval~~ approve the a/m proposals.
