A further reminder has been sent.

2. It appears probable, therefore, that if a favourable reply is given to our A 221 of 3 July, copy to you, resulting in the release of Capt. COSTARELLI from Military Service, further difficulties to his visit to Egypt may arise from the Egyptian end.

3. It might therefore speed up the repatriation if a further application were made to the Egyptian Government from Egypt.


