1. Reference is made to your letter, subject as above dated 25 June 1946 no 14427.

2. Records of this headquarters regarding court proceedings against Major of Infantry Martino, show that:

a) On 30 March 1945, before a Superior Military Court at IVIG Q, he was charged with violation of Proclamation No. 1, Art. IV, Section II, for wantonly possession of Allied property. To this charge he pled not guilty. He was found guilty by the court and sentenced to ten years imprisonment, of which he lost three years were suspended. The court also ordered a fine of 100,000 lire. On 22 May 1945, on review, the conviction and sentence were quashed and a trial is now ordered before a different court.

b) The case came to trial before a Superior Military Court held at Vienna on 12 July 1945. In this trial the offense charged was the same. He accused pled not guilty. He was found guilty and sentenced to three and one-half years imprisonment. Disposition of property as provided by the Geneva Convention was ordered. Conviction and sentence in this case were affirmed on review on 10 October 1945.

c) On 12 May 1946 the conviction and sentence were reexamined. The conviction was affirmed, but the sentence was reduced to ten to one year and six months.

1. Many incidents have occurred of Italian non-Regular officers approaching officers of this U.L. stating that they have been in the Army for 3 years or more and now wish to stay on in the Army, but are prevented from doing so by reason of the fact that they are obliged to accept their release.

There is evidently a system whereby these officers can convert to regular Army, by either going before a board or taking an examination, what they call "concorso".

However these "concorsi" for non-regular officers who wish to become regular officers have not started yet, and it appears that if an officer wishes to convert, but his release is due before these exams start, he is obliged to go on release.

Thus for an officer who is due for release in August, it is a matter of luck that decides whether he can have the chance of staying in the Army, viz. if they decide to hold the "concorso" in July.

2. The exact policy of the Ministry of War regarding the acceptance of applications for the conversion of officers from non-regular to regular is not known, but presuming that it is in favour of accepting the applications of officers within certain age limits (e.g. under 40) could it be ascertained that a fair chance is given to any applicant in that his release should automatically be deferred pending the holding of the examinations.

3. As an example of the sort of the present system, two names relating to the applications of two officers in this Territorial Command are submitted.

Both the above officers are non-regulars, but have been in the Army for 15 and 13 years respectively. They are both technical officers, hard workers and good at their jobs.

They would wish to stay in the Army, taking regular examinations, but since their release is due within a few weeks they cannot await the regular Army examinations and are obliged to accept release.

These officers are 35 and 33 years old, have spent the whole of their career in the Army and are now obliged to leave it through no other reason (to the best of our knowledge) than the fact that the present system of conversion is not elastic.

These officers are highly recommended by this B.I. and it is suggested that being specialists it is in the interest of the Italian Army to keep them on.

If possible it would be desirable if these two cases could be referred to the Ministry of War. Naturally both officers have made their individual applications.

1. We have learnt that Colonel G. MAJIDA, Head of the Allied Requisitions Control Office of the Engineer Section at the Italian War Ministry is due to be placed on the retired list at the end of July 1946.
2. This officer has been in contact with the Italian War Ministry and often with other Italian Government Departments since our arrival in Italy.
3. We have almost daily conferences with him on the numerous questions - often extremely complicated and urgent - arising out of our occupations in Italy.
4. Furthermore, it is to his Service that our claims have or are being passed for assessment and payment in accordance with the various agreements entered into with the Italian Government on the subject.
5. Occupations are referred to in para. 5 of the British Civil & Military Affairs Agreement - now under discussion - and claims are referred to in para. 15 thereof.
6. Our total occupations number about 65,000 of which only approximately 10,000 have been assessed so far by Colonel MAJIDA's Service which is very much understated. Relinquishments number about 45,000 leaving approximately 20,000 current occupations to be dealt with by us under the British Civil & Military Affairs Agreement.
7. About 6,000 claims have been transferred to Colonel

3. We have almost daily conferences with him on the numerous questions - often extremely complicated and urgent - arising out of our occupations in Italy.
4. Furthermore, it is to his Service that our claims have or are being passed for assessment and payment in accordance with the various agreements entered into with the Italian Government on the subject.
5. Occupations are referred to in para. 3 of the British Civil & Military Affairs Agreement - now under discussion - and claims are referred to in para. 18 thereof.
6. Our total occupations number about 45,000 of which only approximately 30,000 have been assessed so far by Colonel MALIZIA's Service which is very much understaffed. Relinquish-ments number about 45,000 leaving approximately 20,000 current occupations to be dealt with by us under the British Civil & Military Affairs Agreement.
7. About 6,000 claims have been transferred to Colonel MALIZIA's Service, not one of which has so far been assessed or paid. This is not Colonel MALIZIA's fault as he has taken all necessary precautions and made repeated requests for the necessary staffs and transport to undertake the work. He is fully familiar with the situation and is ready to act as soon as he receives satisfaction. Strong pressure is being brought to bear on the Italian Government at the moment with a view to obtaining that they carry out without delay their obligations in regard to claims and set up the necessary machinery to deal with them.
8. Colonel G. MALIZIA is the "key man" on the Italian side in regard to both claims and claims. We cannot speak too highly of his services. He has proved most helpful and co-operative. Furthermore, his knowledge of Italian Government machinery and policy and of our own problems is very extensive.

He is an extremely active and undoubtedly influential officer and the numerous questions we take up with him are dealt with in a most comprehensive manner and invariably receive immediate attention. He obtains results where others fail and we have no hesitation whatever in stating that his departure at the present juncture would be nothing short of a catastrophe and contrary to the interests of the Service.

9. We understand that Colonel MALIZIA would be willing to defer his retirement if called upon to do so.

10. We appreciate the fact that the policy at the moment in the Italian Army is to retire the older officers to make room for the younger ones but we venture to urge most strongly that an exception be made in this case and that the Italian Government be approached with a view to their maintaining Colonel MALIZIA in his present appointment.

11. He has not approached us on the subject and we are writing on our own initiative - convinced that the measure we suggest is in the interest of the British Forces generally.

12. We have had an informal conversation with Colonel MALIZIA's commanding officer, General CHIVARO, and ascertained that he is anxious to retain this officer's services.
