(b) Officers of the Reg. Med. Corps are permitted to practise their profession outside duty hours if they so wish, and this applies to Capt. ARBITO. He may practise his profession under local authorities provided this is agreed by the Allied authorities on the spot.

Further to the above we ask your mission to kindly inform the officer as follows:

- 1°) - We do not see how he can temporarily give up his present status of POW which is essential for the status of regular army officer;
- 2°) - Officer belonging to the Reg.Med Corps,at home,are authorised to practice their profession during off duty hours:the same,providing it is within the limits laid down by the local allied authorities,applies to your status as POW,Capt.ARDITO may practice his profession in Somalia.

The officer is at present in Somalia - "De Martino" Hospital - Mogadiscio C.P. 389.

At the same time we ask you to kindly forward the officer concerned the attached certificate.
