The following is extracted from a letter received

6009828 L/Cpl FOWKE W. R.A.O.C.

The above named was tried by FQCM on 11 and 12 May 42 and placed under stoppage of Pay to the amount of £18 (eighteen pounds) on two charges - Improperly using a WD Vehicle and Petrol for his own use and Negligently driving same and causing damage thereto.

The soldier states that the award was reduced to 25 (five pounds) by GOC Troops Paiforce, but no records are held by OZE Paiforce or this GHQ of such reduction, and it appears that as a result the soldier has incurred a large debtor balance.

At the time in question the soldier was serving with 4 Ordnance Field Park, under Lt.Col. W.A. BADCOCK.

It would be appreciated if you would contact this officer with a view to obtaining confirmation of the soldier's statement, and any additional information that he may be able to provide in regard to the authority for the reduction.

In the latter connection, L/Cpl FOWKE states that the remission of £13 was published in his Unit Orders and was also read out to him by his Commanding Officer in the presence of a Witness when the findings were promulgated.

29th August 1944. Florence Area. CITATION. George LEWIS 1074525, Gunner, 3rd Field Regt., R.A. British Army, for Gallantry in action on 21 November 1943, near ST. ANGELO, Italy. When forward observation Officer, whom he was accompanying as observation post assistant, was killed, Gnr. Lewis assumed command of the entire observation post party and continued the attack under continuous and accurate enemy mortar fire. Later, when a determined enemy counter attack forced a withdrawal, Gnr Lewis remained with his party at this post until the latest moment before withdrawing to the Sangro River, carrying a badly wounded Officer down precipitous slopes for two miles under heavy enemy fire. Arriving at the river bank, it was found that the level of the water has risen about four feet and had become a raging torrent. Realising the Officer's need for urgent medical attention, Gnr Lewis and the two remaining members of his party attempted to cross the river with the badly wounded Officer. In this effort his two companions were drowned and Gunner Lewis, after much struggle, crossed the river and reached the main observation post. The outstanding courage and devotion to duty displayed by Gnr Lewis are worthy of the highest traditions of the military service.
