DECEMBER 13 REAR ADMIRAL W STONE, USNR, CHIEF COMMISSIONER OF THE
ALLIED COMMISSION, ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT THE REMAINING ITALIAN TERRITORY
NOW UNDER ALLIED MILITARY GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING THE ISLANDS OF LAPEDEIRA,
LIVOGA, AND SPINIGLIERIA BUT EXCLUDING VENEZIA GIULIA AND THE PROVINCE OF
UDINE, WILL BE RETURNED TO ITALIAN ADMINISTRATION ABOUT DECEMBER 31 (.)
THE PROVINCE OF UDINE IS BEING RETAINED UNDER ALLIED MILITARY GOVERNMENT
SOLELY FOR MILITARY REASONS AND NOT IN ANY SENSE BECAUSE IT IS CONSIDERED
A DISPUTED AREA (.). ALLIED MILITARY GOVERNMENT OFFICERS WILL BE WITHDRAWN
FROM THE AREAS TO BE TRANSFERRED, BUT A SMALL NUMBER OF ALLIED COMMISSION
LIAISON OFFICERS WILL REMAIN TO FACILITATE THE TRANSITION FROM ALLIED TO
ITALIAN ADMINISTRATION."

DECEMBER 13, 1945. ADMIRAL W. STONE, USMC, CHIEF COMBAT STAFF OF THE ALLIED COMMISSION, ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT THE REMAINING ITALIAN TERRITORY NOT UNDER ALLIED MILITARY GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING THE ISLANDS OF LAMPEDUSA, LIPARI, AND STREPOLETTA BUT EXCLUDING VENEZIA GIULIA AND THE PROVINCE OF UDINE, WILL BE RETURNED TO ITALIAN ADMINISTRATION ABOUT DECEMBER 31 (.) THE PROVINCE OF UDINE IS BEING RETAINED UNDER ALLIED MILITARY GOVERNMENT SOLELY FOR MILITARY REASONS AND NOT IN ANY SENSE BECAUSE IT IS CONSIDERED A DISPUTED AREA (.) ALLIED MILITARY GOVERNMENT OFFICERS WILL BE WITHDRAWN FROM THE AREAS TO BE TRANSFERRED, BUT A SMALL NUMBER OF ALLIED COMMISSION LIAISON OFFICERS WILL REMAIN TO FACILITATE THE TRANSITION FROM ALLIED TO ITALIAN ADMINISTRATION."

To : The Russian Representative to Allied Commission.

1. The attached statements show rates of pay and allowances applicable to officers and O.Rs. of the Italian Army, both married and single.

2. It should be noted, however, that in addition to the rates shown, troops who were fighting with the Allies during the Italian Campaign received an additional 45 Lire per day. Troops who were working as Service Units to the Allies during the campaign received an additional 32 Lire per day, and troops engaged on heavy manual labour for the Allies throughout Italy received an additional 20 Lire per day (up to the rank of Sgt.)

3. For your information all Italian rates of pay are at present under re-consideration and within a short time alterations may be made.
