Lt.Col. Ugo PINI, Regular Army, who just returned from captivity, pointed to his particular psychological condition in being forced to live apart from his wife, Anna, and his son, Attilio, both residing at Mogadiscio (Somaliland) Viale Gasperini, Casa Incis.

The abovementioned relatives :

- have been in the Colony for over 7 years;
- are reported to receive only 100 shillings a month for living expenses which the Mogadiscio Commune pays them;
- are said to have been unable to repatriate in 1943 because charges of ant-Fascism were filed against them with the Fascist home government.

The wife, whose health is failing, is further - more anguished by the fact that she has not seen for 6 years. another son who lives in Italy.

We will appreciate it if your Sub-Commission will give benevolent consideration to this case in order that, if possible, the family of this officer be repatriated.

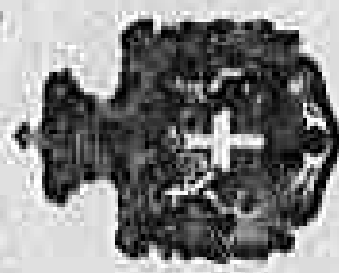
