the following is a statement of the case as requested.

1. Towards the end of 1944, this Sec began to inquire into the activities of a suspect political group connected with the Unione Proletaria. The leader of this group, VAVALLI, was head of the UNIONE PATRIOTTI. An NCO of this Sec contacted VAVALLI, SCHIAVONI, STRAPPO and others and reported on their activities.
2. In order ostensibly to prove their zeal in collaborating with the Allies, these persons on several occasions passed to the NCO various informations re stolen cars and Allied goods. On these occasions the NCO took action in company with a member of CCRR att this Sec, Brig. LOMORO Quinto, formerly att 35 FSS, by whom he had been given in Sep 43 at SALERNO the local rank of Lieutenant, pending confirmation by HQ CCRR.
3. On at least two occasions the information given by VAVALLI led to successful police action, once in the recovery of a quantity of Allied food in collaboration with CMP and again in the recovery of a stolen requisitioned car in collaboration with the Squadra Mobile (Dott LUGLIE).
4. Subsequently, on or about 22 Nov 44, another information was given, i.e. that a certain CROCIANI was in unlawful possession of a stolen car. The same action as before was taken and LOMORO was called in. In effect, the circumstances of CROCIANI's possession of the vehicle were suspicious.
5. Instead, however, of allowing normal police action by LOMORO, VAVALLI forced CROCIANI to sign a document putting the car at the disposal of the Unione Patriotti.
6. In view of this obvious abuse of his good faith, LOMORO protested violently and immediately reported the whole matter to the Nucleo di Polizia Militare del Ministero della Guerra, Ufficio Recupero and then to the Direzione Generale Artiglieria e Motorizzazione, Ministero della Guerra. On his return to this HQ he also reported the matter to the undersigned, who agreed the action taken.

7. Some 4 weeks ago, an arrest warrant for LOMORO was presented at this HQ on a charge of attempted extortion of a car from CROCIANI. In view of the above circumstances, the matter was explained to Capt. GENIOLA, of the Compagnia Interna CCRR, ROME, charged with executing the warrant. He stated that, where arrest of Italian military att to Allied units was concerned, arrest could be suspended at the request of OC Unit concerned if the circumstances of work etc required. Advantage was taken of this facility and a completely documented report was sent to Capt GENIOLA on the whole case, for transmission to the Procura del Regno, requesting that arrest be suspended.

8. The motives for this request, apart from the above circumstances were (a) shortage of personnel of this Sec to cope with the work on which it is engaged and (b) the excellent record of service by LOMORO with Allied units since Sep 43.

9. It is pointed out that it is in NO way desired to interfere with the process of the Italian law-suit involved. LOMORO is available at any time to appear in court and the undersigned has already provided, via Capt GENIOLA, written testimony in his favour. It is considered, however, in the best interests of the heavy commitments of this Sec that he should be allowed to remain at work with it until such time as the case is heard and it is requested that the suspension of arrest be upheld.

1. It is considered that your above quoted letter does not entirely cover the matter raised in M.M.I.A. letter A 231 of 3 Aug 45, for the following reasons:-

- (a) In accordance with M.M.I.A. Instruction No 18 dated 1 Dec 44, All Italian Soldiers, (which includes CORR personnel) are subject to Italian Military law, administered by the Italian Authorities. Therefore Capt SAUER was not justified in taking personal action in the case of the above named NCO who is required by the Italian Army Legal Authorities on charges framed under the Italian Military Law.
- (b) Furthermore, since Sgt MORO is only attached to 276 Fld Security Section he is under the local CORR HQ for the purpose of administration, the O.C. 276 Fld Security Section is not justified in refusing to hand him over to the Italian Authorities in order that Military Legal Proceedings may be completed.

1. Capt SALTER, OC 276 Fd Security Sec is at present in PARIS but is expected back within a few days.

2. The CSM at present in charge of the Section has however been contacted. He states:-

(a) The question of the charge against the above-named NCO has been dealt with personally by Captain SALTER who has been in contact with the Legion of Carabinieri, ROME, on the subject. The outcome is not at present known.

(b) The question of the promotion of the above-named NCO was handled through 94 Sub-Area and 3 District. Authority for the promotion has not yet been received but is understood to be imminent. The NCO has held the rank of Lieutenant since approximately September 1943, and had been interviewed on this matter by the Commandant Carabinieri ROME who had approved his promotion to Officer Rank.

3. In view of the above, it is suggested that the matter be held in abeyance till the return of Capt SALTER, who, it appears, is the only person in a position to give the required information.

On June 29th, the judge-examiner of the Rome Territorial War Tribunal issued an arrest-warrant against Sgt. LO MORO Quinto, who is on the effective strength of the Naples Carabinieri Territorial Legion and who is on duty at the 276 F.S.S. Section which is located at 59 Via Sicilia, Rome, and who is accused, together with others, of attempted extortion against Cruciano Angelo.

The Commander of the Rome Internal Carabinieri Co., in order to carry out the arrest order, informed the Commander of the English police, Capt. ~~Rafter~~, who did not adhere to the request for the handing of the Senior NCO, and who stated that the NCO could not be replaced and was necessary in important operations.

It was reported, furthermore, that since Sept. 1943, Sgt. LA MORO has been under the command of the a/m English police, who have conferred on him the rank of Carabinieri Lt., a rank which he still holds, but for which no recognition was given nor could be given by the Italian authorities.

We beg MMIA to kindly intervene in order that the work of the military judiciary authorities may be carried out and to kindly give us any possible info regarding the exact position of Sgt. LO MORO.
