Rome, 7 January 1946

Dear Brigadier Carr,

With letter dated 10 October 1945 a group of mothers of young soldiers who are being held in concentration camp No 209 at AFRAGOLA have applied to H.R.H. the Lieutenant General of the Realm in order to plead on behalf of their sons who were compelled to report for military service in accordance with the laws and proclamations in force at that time and also in order to avoid reprisals against their families.

The ladies in question were told to wait until the examination of their sons' cases would be concluded.

With letter dated 20 December 1945 the above said group of mothers has applied once again to the Lieutenant General of the Realm in order to bring to his attention that so far no steps have been taken with regard to their sons while the soldiers held in the concentration camp at COLTANO have already been released.

In order to adhere to the application in question, I would be very grateful to you if you could kindly let me have some information on this subject so that I may keep the mothers informed.

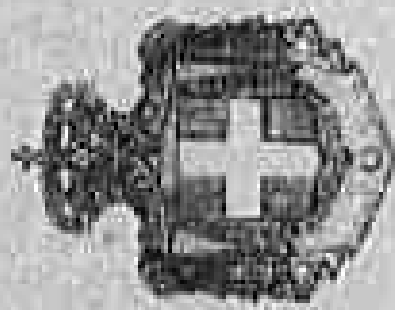

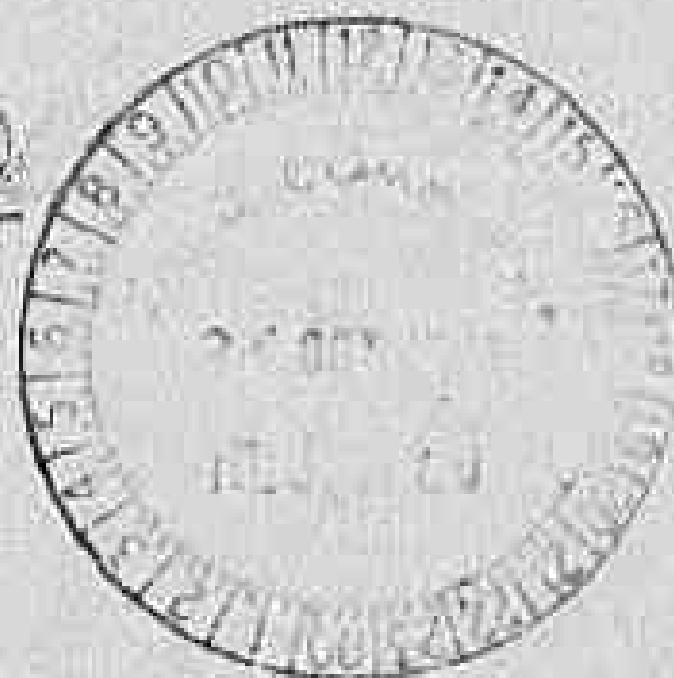

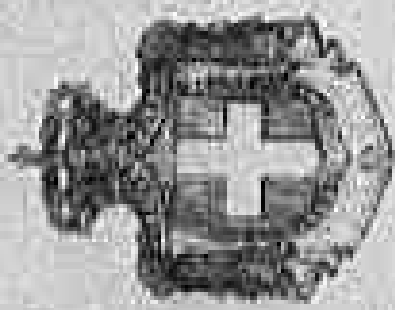

3. The terms of reference of M.M.I.A. lay down that this HQ is responsible for passing to the Ministry of War the Commands of A.E.H.Q. in so far as they concern the present Italian Army. This HQ has therefore no dealings in respect of personnel who have been enlisted or re-enlisted into the present Italian Army i.e. since Sep. 1943.

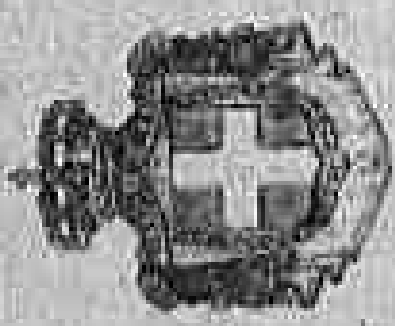

1 It is felt that as enquiries about Italians in Allied hands are addressed to the AFHQ (Provost), so enquiries about Italians in camps guarded by the Italian Army should be channelled through Land Forces to the Ministry of War, as it would not be appropriate for other branches to approach that Ministry.

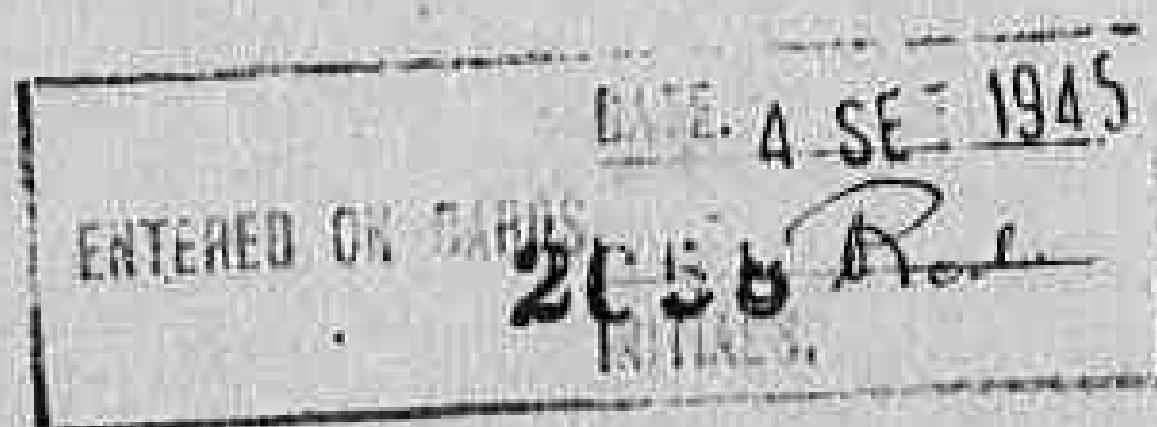

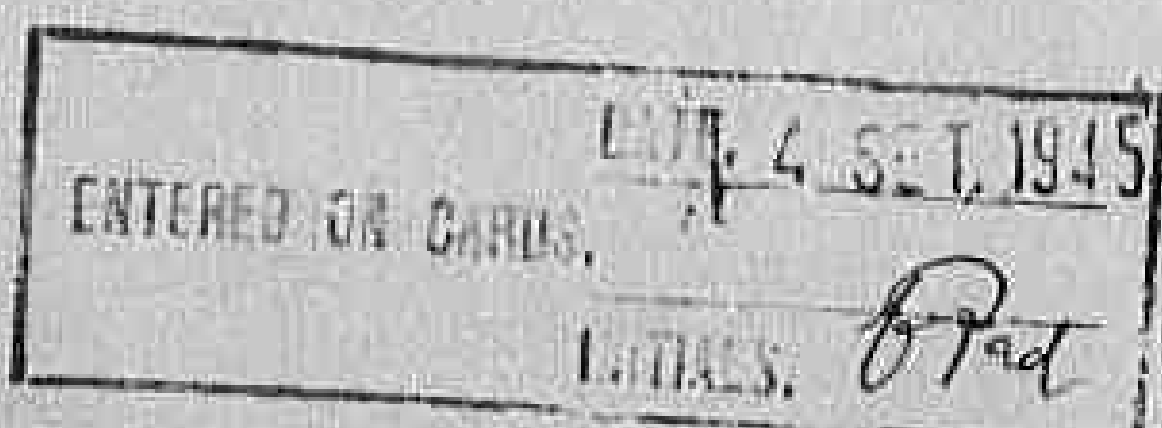

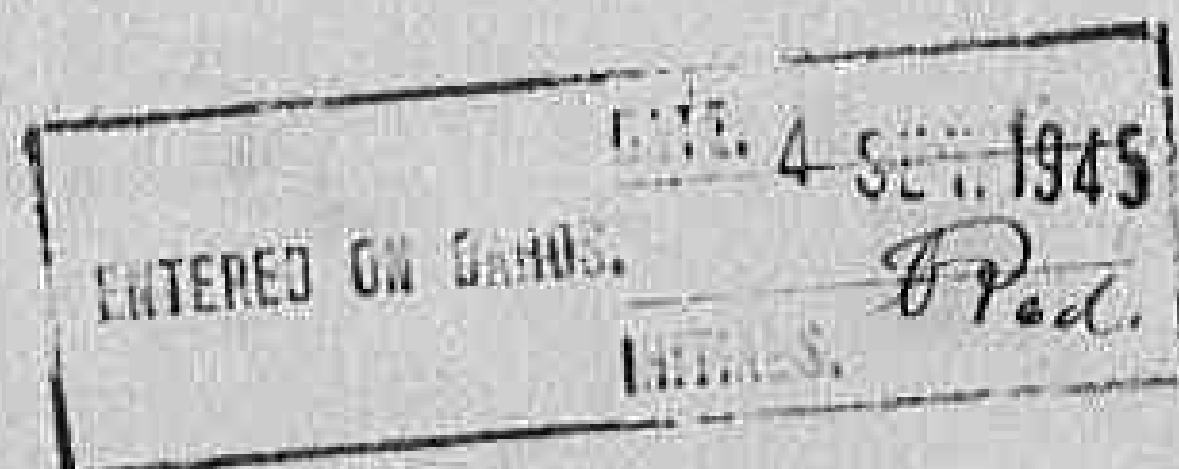
