I, Giovanni Messe, Marshal of Italy and  
Chief of the General Staff,

By virtue of art. 1 of Proclamation No. 1710 dated September  
8, 1943 of the Supreme Commander,

HAVE AWARDED

the Silver Medal for Military Valor "Sul Campo"  
to 1st Lt. Uguccione Ranieri Bourbon Del Monte, Artillery  
Reinforcements, - born on February 2, 1906 in Florence, -

with the following motivation:

"This officer has a very highly developed sense of duty; when  
the armistice was signed he boldly crossed the lines placing  
himself at the disposal of Italian Army authorities in  
liberated territory. He volunteered for a perilous assignment,  
landed behind the German lines where, through intelligent  
initiative and quiet disdain for personal danger, he  
set up an efficient organization for the recovery of Allied  
prisoners and succeeded in saving a good many of them.  
Later he joined a group of patriots with whom he  
participated in many bold actions until the arrival  
of the troops of liberation."
