In respect of the others, in possession of a degree only, who have not, due to excess, carried out functions technically connected with the requirements of the practice of the forensic professions, this inscription does not appear to be admissible, above all by virtue of the consideration that even in the professional organisation of 1874 in Italy, the degree in jurisprudence did not, by itself, constitute title to professional qualification, which always requires a period of professional apprenticeship together with one or two examinations.

Therefore, we regret that, limited to such professions, we are unable to give the approbation asked for.

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In respect of the other professions, the question is one for the Ministry of Public Education, which alone can evaluate the advisability of permitting or otherwise, in the enclosed regulation.

Questo Ministero ringrazia dell'accoglimento fatto alle sue osservazioni sull'art. 5 dello schema in oggetto.

Per quanto riguarda l'art. 6, la questione interessa questo Ministero soltanto per l'iscrizione negli albi delle professioni di avvocato e di procuratore.

A tale proposito occorre premettere che gli ex ufficiali della giustizia militare, gli unici appartenenti ai ruoli dell'Esercito, che svolgono funzioni di carattere strettamente giudiziario-giuridico, possono già in virtù della legislazione vigente (artt. 26 b e 30 a del R.D. 27 novembre 1933 n. 1578) conseguire l'iscrizione agli albi.

Per gli altri, muniti della sola laurea, i quali, per giunta, non hanno esplicato funzioni tecnicamente connesse con i requisiti della pratica delle professioni forensi, tale iscrizione non appare ammissibile, soprattutto in virtù

della considerazione che neanche nell'ordinamento professionale del 1874 in Italia la laurea in giurisprudenza ha, di per sè sola, costituito titolo all'abilitazione professionale per la quale si è sempre richiesto un periodo di tirocinio professionale congiunto ad uno o due esami di idoneità.

Pertanto, limitatamente a tali professioni si è spiacenti di non poter dare il chiesto assenso.

Per le altre professioni, la questione è di competenza del Ministero della Pubblica Istruzione, al quale soltanto spetta di vagliare l'opportunità di consentire o meno nella norma proposta.
