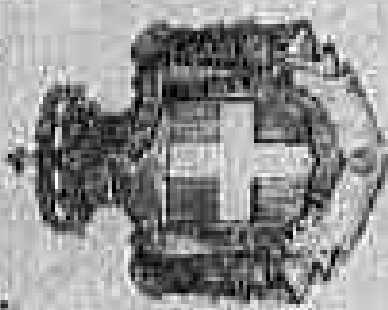

Owing to lack of transport he has not been able to return to Italy and at present he is living ~~in Tripoli~~ with his wife in Tripoli where there are difficulties in finding work. His economical condition is very poor.

Balzarotti has nevertheless assured that he will immediately write a letter to Field-Marshal Alexander thanking him for his intervention.

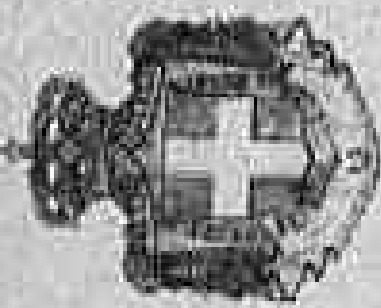

We beg the NMIA to intervene with the competent Yugoslav Authorities.

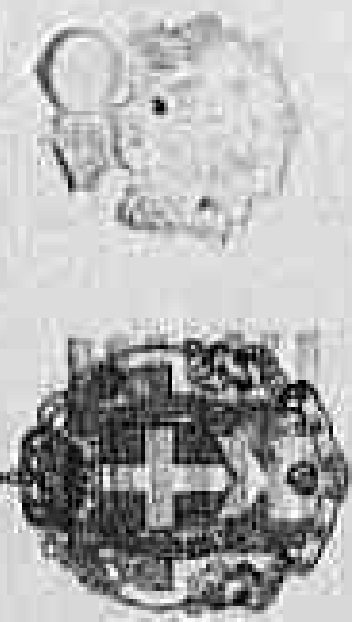

They state that they have nothing to conceal and are willing to invite an Italian delegation to examine and report on the trials."

2. It is suggested that you advise the Italian Government of the above for such action as they may wish to take with the Yugoslav Government.

3. If the Italian Government desires to have further action taken through military channels, we shall continue to press the matter through Brigadier MacLean. Meanwhile we are notifying him of the present position.

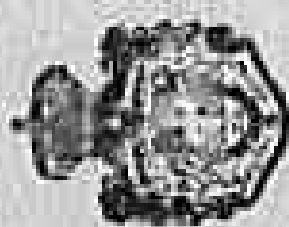

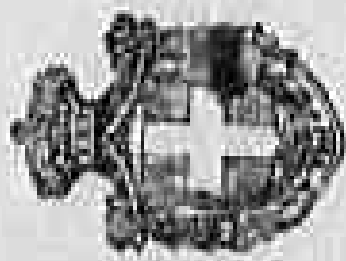

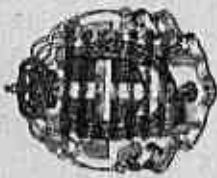
