

1. I enclose General PRIMIERI's letter No 5671 dated 13 Oct 45 together with a translation.
2. It contains several vague statements, and at least one contradiction, and in forwarding it I would like to express to you my view that the General has not appreciated how well the Italian army has been treated thanks to allied pressure on the War Ministry and the Treasury.
3. It is also my duty to inform you that cuts in the pay of Combat Troops have been proposed by MMIA to the War Ministry, and that these cuts will probably come into force on Dec 1st. The new scale has not yet been published as the whole question is still under discussion in ROME.
4. The effort to get the operational command to fight administrative battles for him is, of course, nothing new; but in this instance, I feel, the General has shown a lack of understanding that sacrifice is demanded from Italians; that Combat Troops form only a small part of the future Italian army, for whom the new rates are being devised, and that they must lose the specially favoured treatment they had as a Gruppo di Combattimento.

When I informed you that the grant of War Service Increment (Lire 45) to the Gruppi had been extended to the end of November (the Ministerial Order dated 8 Sep was received by me, on the 22nd) you remarked that we had obtained "a great victory". But you will also remember that on that occasion I did not share fully your enthusiasm and conviction.

In fact, on 7 Oct I received another Ministerial Order dated 15 Sep, which, as a result of the decision of the Council of Ministers to abolish the "State of War" in all Italian territory (I must believe that as far as the territory under Allied control this was decided with your consent) - it stopped with immediate effect as from 16 Sep, the war economical treatment. To those, therefore, who received this Order only on the 7 Oct, it had a retro-active effect.

War economical treatment included:-

Operational Increment - Lodging Allowance for Officers and WOs -  
A higher rate of Entertainment Allowance for Generals and Colonels -  
A Higher Rank Entitlement Allowance for officers entrusted with a Command or a post above the rank held. (In your organisation, the officer who holds the command generally held by a Lt Col, if he is of a more junior rank, is promoted to the acting rank - Lt Col Slater, Comd 51 HLU is an example - and holds this rank as long as he holds the post. On the other hand, I put forward the following example:- As Comd of Cremona I have acted as a Divisional Comd for 27 months - your equivalent rank would be that of Major General - and I had as such, all the prerogatives and remunerations. Now all I shall have will be the prerogatives, with their relative duties and responsibilities).

The Ministerial Order of the 15th Sep, establishes amongst other things a temporary increase in military Pay now in force for Officers and WOs and fixes it at Lire 120 a month for soldiers. This amount is equal (in the case of the soldier) to the War Service Increment. Appx 1, drawing comparisons between war time and peace time economical treatments, shows that, shows that for the present and as long as this Order remains in force - 30 Nov -, the War Pay of Lire 45 for the Gruppi does not suffer any decrease.

Officers' Pay, however, will suffer "cuts" which are not substantial ones except in the case of those who will have the Higher Rank Entitlement Allowance whilst occupying the post of the rank above their own.

But the decrease which will be most felt and which is not apparent in the Appx as it is an indirect increase is that due to the cessation of Lodging Allowances. Whilst this was in force there was the possibility of obtaining - through the obligations imposed on the communes - billets at cheap rates. In stopping this Lodging Allowance, billets at cheap rates are no longer possible. The officer for whom it was possible to obtain a billet for a few Lire is now obliged to make his own private arrangements - generally costing him large sums - and thus suffering an indirect decrease.

This is a question I propose to make known to our central authority; but as the Gruppo depends operationally on Allied Comd, which arranges the Gruppos' deployment and movements, I consider this fact should also interest yourself especially so as moves are still frequent and may remain so until a definite "peace deployment" has been decided upon for the Gruppo.

Peace time economical treatment provides for a special allowance called "Displacement Allowance", which, being a pre-war measure is very small (see Appx 2) but is an alternative to the Lodging Allowance. The Displacement Allowance was granted in peace-time to troops living in abnormal conditions, such as camps, or in the field or on manoeuvres. More than being on manoeuvres we are still employed in an operational role.

The competent administrative departments are of opinion that as we are living in abnormal conditions, we are entitled to the Displacement Allowance. It is my opinion, however, that this allowance will not be granted to the Gruppi for as they are still employed operationally, and that therefore the "lodging compensation" should be allotted in the meantime, thus having the situation unchanged.

One must not forget that the temporary increases to the military pay fixed some time ago to make up for those greater expenses that the officers and W.Os must meet as compared to civil servants, must once again be gradually rendered insufficient through eventual further increases of pay to civil servants. This principle is an erroneous one as it does not recognise the difficulties of the Army who will only receive a part of any increases granted to the civil servants.

It is also worth noting that a directive which is retroactive is unwise. The pay for Sep has already been paid out, and the soldier must now refund what has already now become overpaid to him through the new decreases.

The practical difficulties to obtain reimbursement are many. Some have already been discharged and others have obviously already spent the small sums that have been paid to them. Withholding the balances overpaid now means that for at least one month the soldier is going to suffer a double cut in his pay. What is most serious, however, is the fact that allowing an order for decreases to arrive so late reveals a poor understanding on the part of our authorities of the repercussions financial problems have at present on the morale.

It is a reflection that leaves one perplexed enough to ask oneself if it was worth, or if it is still worth, the trouble of having written and spoken so much on this subject and to continue to write and speak about it even now.
