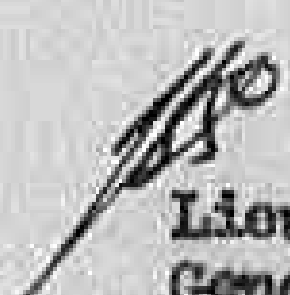

FAR.I.

- 1) The attitude of the political parties, the information received by the security organizations, detection of big quantities of hidden arms, existence of dumps not as yet located, are reasons that may suggest an eventual armed action of clandestine forces, aiming to sabotage the public order and ferment an open armed revolution.
- 2) Whilst on one hand, through a very active intelligence service - we will continue as has been done so far to locate and raid hidden depots of arms in the various zones and turn in to the security forces certain persons which may be considered chiefs of disturbance movements, on the other hand one must be in a position to prevent armed actions and what's more to prevent the clandestine forces of the various zones to contact each other. It is, therefore, necessary to arrange for a continuous contact among the garrisons, including the allied ones, formed in the Cremona Sector, in addition to an active intelligence service.
- 3) The rules in force concerning the security of each garrison must be borne in mind, i.e.

It is requested that each unit have an armed picket guard (equivalent to 10% of the troops), with arms, ammunition and vehicles in working order;

It is requested that each unit make arrangements for their internal security and "Alert" scheme capable of action in the least possible time.

Arrangements for the defense of H.Q.s., barracks, and buildings used for troops' lodgings, stores and dumps employing the minimum of

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It is requested that each unit have an armed picket guard (equivalent to 10% of the troops), with arms, ammunitions and vehicles in working order;

It is requested that each unit make arrangements for their internal security and "Alert" scheme capable of action in the least possible time.

Arrangements for the defense of HQ.s., barracks, and buildings used for troops' lodgings, stores and dumps employing the minimum of troops indispensable to this purpose, and carrying out any work which may be deemed necessary. Arrangements must also be made for a fire plan, including motives.

It is requested that arrangements be made to defend installations and plants of vital importance to inhabited localities (such as power stations and wireless stations, food stores, water plants, etc.), and of all plants used as arms and ammunition depots.

Arrangements should be made to the effect that communications be kept in working order.

EAR. II SECTORS AND AVAILABLE FORCES.

1) The sector responsibilities - as far as training of troops employed in public order operations is concerned - are those pointed out in par. 5 - foglio 01/3353 dated 20 Sept., i.e:

- a) 21 Infantry Regt. HQ. : Provinces of ALESSANDRIA - ASTI - CUNEO.
- b) 22 " " : Provinces of NOVARA - VERCELLI.
- c) 7 Arty. Regt. HQ. : " " TURIN.

As regards the zone on the French border in the Turin and Cuneo Provinces a strip of land 15 Miles wide has been excluded.

2) All the "Cremona" Units and in the event of emergency, as per foglio 01/3434 of 22 Sept. and 01/3693 of 6 Oct., all the balance troops both of the Army and the Italian Police Service stationed at the above localities are under the jurisdiction of the Commandant of each Sector. Therefore, reports on operations (Sitrap) and on information (weekly security reports and general information) must be addressed to each Commandant of Sector, who will forward them to this Group HQ. In accordance with these instructions, the intelligence service and Sector Commanders will issue orders to this effect.

3) As far as the layout of communications is concerned (especially wireless stations) the location of troops in the Sector must be adhered to rather than that of the establishment. Major FERRE is asked to give detailed instructions to this effect.

4) For your information definite sector locations are set out below (with effect from 15 Oct.).

PAR. III - Hypothesis.

1. Among the various hypothesis which may occur in the event of disturbances, the following appear to be of particular importance and should be studied.
 - a) Forces that from the West (Turin, Valleys of Lanzo, Canavese - Serra d'Ivrea) or from the South (Monferrato - Langhe) should attempt to link-up with forces moving from the North (Biellese, Val Sesia - Borgomanero - Zones of Lake d'Orta and Lake Maggiore, Zone of Ossola) and from the East (Zone of Novara) with the purpose of gaining control of the piemontese valley in the Chivasso - Biella, Novara - Casale M. area which is of vital logistic importance for the clandestine forces in question.
 - b) Disturbances of a general character in industrial centres (Turin, Biella, Alessandria, Novara).
 - c) State of general emergency throughout Piemonte.

2. In the following par. IV instructions are given as to what should be done in this case. Of course, the aforesaid arrangements are largely dependable upon the information gathered by the intelligence service. These are, therefore, rough instructions, for the purpose of becoming familiar with the ground and for the training of units. These instructions are liable to change if and when the situation should arise.

3. Thus, we shall be ready to face any event which may materialize.

PAR. IV. PREDISPOSITION.

1. Case A. Linking-up attempt of clandestine forces :
 - a) Strong road blocks and barriers so sited as to have all round defence (360°), along the roads and where necessary in order to prevent any linking-up attempt of clandestine forces, should be organized.

b) The personnel and equipment for each road block must be adequate

b) The personnel and armament for each road-block must be adequate. Rather strong forces may attack the blocks. These forces may be equipped with up-to-date arms (including artillery and not excluding tanks). The use of sections and platoons is, therefore, envisaged, with mortars, PIAT and some 6 Pdr A/TK.

c) Road blocks will be supported by mobile forces which must in an emergency always be kept in readiness. Bren carriers are particularly suitable for this purpose but every effort should be made to avoid excessively splitting them up into small groups. The mobile columns (already formed with 7 Arty. Regt., the 21 and 22 Inf. Regts. will form with the means

otted and in accordance with instructions) stationed at respective Regimental HQ.s will be employed to patrol the most important lines of communication of the Sector.

- d) The arrangements for the aforesaid road blocks, in addition to establishing the adequate forces to each post, shall also include:
- Rece for alternative routes in case normal road communications are interrupted.

-Rece for positions;

- preparation of field works as preventive measure.
- preparation of eventual reinforcement equipment.
- Instructions for installing the required communications.
- Allotment of ammunitions and reserves of food supplies, fuels and lubricants and medical supplies.

- e) In case a garrison must be established on the main line Biella-Massazza (J.4573) - Formigliana (J.5959) - Vercelli - Sesia River - Po River - Tanaro River, as far as Alessandria.

2) CASE B : Disturbances in industrial centres:

a) The lack of available forces as compared to the size of the towns, areas where public order is to be maintained, make it impossible to control all the important points.

b) In such cases it will be necessary:

-To ensure the defense of all the HQ.s, the lodgings, the stores of vital importance to the Gruppo; if necessary, exposed groups of personnel not absolutely indispensable may be withdrawn.

-To make sure of communications.

-To establish a proper defense in accordance with the available forces of important civil plants (telephone exchange, water and power plants, head offices of the State Administration).

-To confine all troops to barracks, forming mobile columns ready for any operational emergency.

-To patrol the town with mobile columns, communicated by wireless.

-All personnel at HQ.s, offices, stores, messes, etc. must be armed.

c) The above arrangements shall previously have to be agreed upon by the Allied Authorities concerned, and by the Italian forces in the area (other units, CC.RR.)

d) As far as the units of Turin are concerned, the following measures must be taken, in the event of disturbances:

-a section of CC.RR. must immediately be stationed at Corso Oporto to protect the Group HQ.s.

-a strong nucleus of CC.RR. shall be stationed at Via Cavour 8, to protect the intelligence section of the Group HQ.s.

-a Coy of the IIL/21 Inf. must be sent to the "Scuole Barracks" (formerly 1st Arty. Alpina) at Corso Vittorio Emanuele, to protect the food store, the wireless station and as a reserve for the HQ.s areas.

- To make sure of communications.
- To establish a proper defense in accordance with the available forces of important civil plants (telephone exchange, water and power plants, head offices of the State Administration).
- To confine all troops to barracks, forming mobile columns ready for any operational emergency.
- To patrol the town with mobile columns, communicated by wireless.
- All personnel at HQ.s, offices, stores, messes, etc. must be armed.
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 - The Quartier Generale with the remaining CC.RR. will look after the defense of the building formerly used for the "Scuola di Guerra".
 - detailed instructions will be issued by the "Operations Section to this effect.

3)-CASE C : State of General Emergency:

- a) All garrisons will be instructed as per par.2 above.
- b) The columns employed for supplying the various garrisons must be duly escorted (carriers, mortars, PIAT and A/TK.
- c) The principal roads connecting the garrisons of the Group must be occasionally patrolled by mobile columns (reinforced by mortars, PIAT and A/TK) wireless communication.
- d) All the available troops, including those of units not employed, must be in hand according to exigencies.

PAR. IV. - GENERAL.

1) Provisions of a general nature for which I am awaiting separate acknowledgement for each of them, from the HQ.s concerned:

a) Arrangements for alarm signals at each garrison (defense of HQ.s, lodgings and military establishments; instructions as for the summoning up of the officers and the troops.

b) Reserve of ammunitions, food, fuel, lubricants and firewood must be set up at the garrisons.
As regards the ammunitions these must be decentralized as follows:

- All 1st line ammunitions;
- Part of reserve sufficient for 7 days' fire; these will be allotted to the units in the near future.

As regards isolated garrisons (due to season contingencies, or to their being stationed at the outskirts of a town) reserves must be adequately increased.

c) All wireless equipment must be in good working order; sufficient reserves of wire must be supplied;

d) Arrangements to ensure secrecy of radio frequencies; codes and ciphers must be kept up-to-date; those engaged in ciphering must be duly trained; instructions must be issued in the event of one having lost the code or the cipher. Lt.Col. IANZG
Major FRANK will issue instructions to this effect.

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Major FERRE will issue instructions to this effect.

e) Allocation of frequencies to out-stations.

f) Immediate radio control, liable to be transformed, if and when the case may arise, in an interpretation station of eventual clandestine radios.

2) In this respect the officers concerned will go into the matter, and will send me the results of their studies.

3) Arrangements must be made in order that the personnel is trained accordingly, without their finding out the reason of the general

provisions taken. Nevertheless, mention must be made of this letter and of its provisions only to the Battalion Commanders and Unit Commanders concerned, for their personal guidance.

- 4) This letter and the studies and plans referring to same are of a secret nature and must be kept as such.

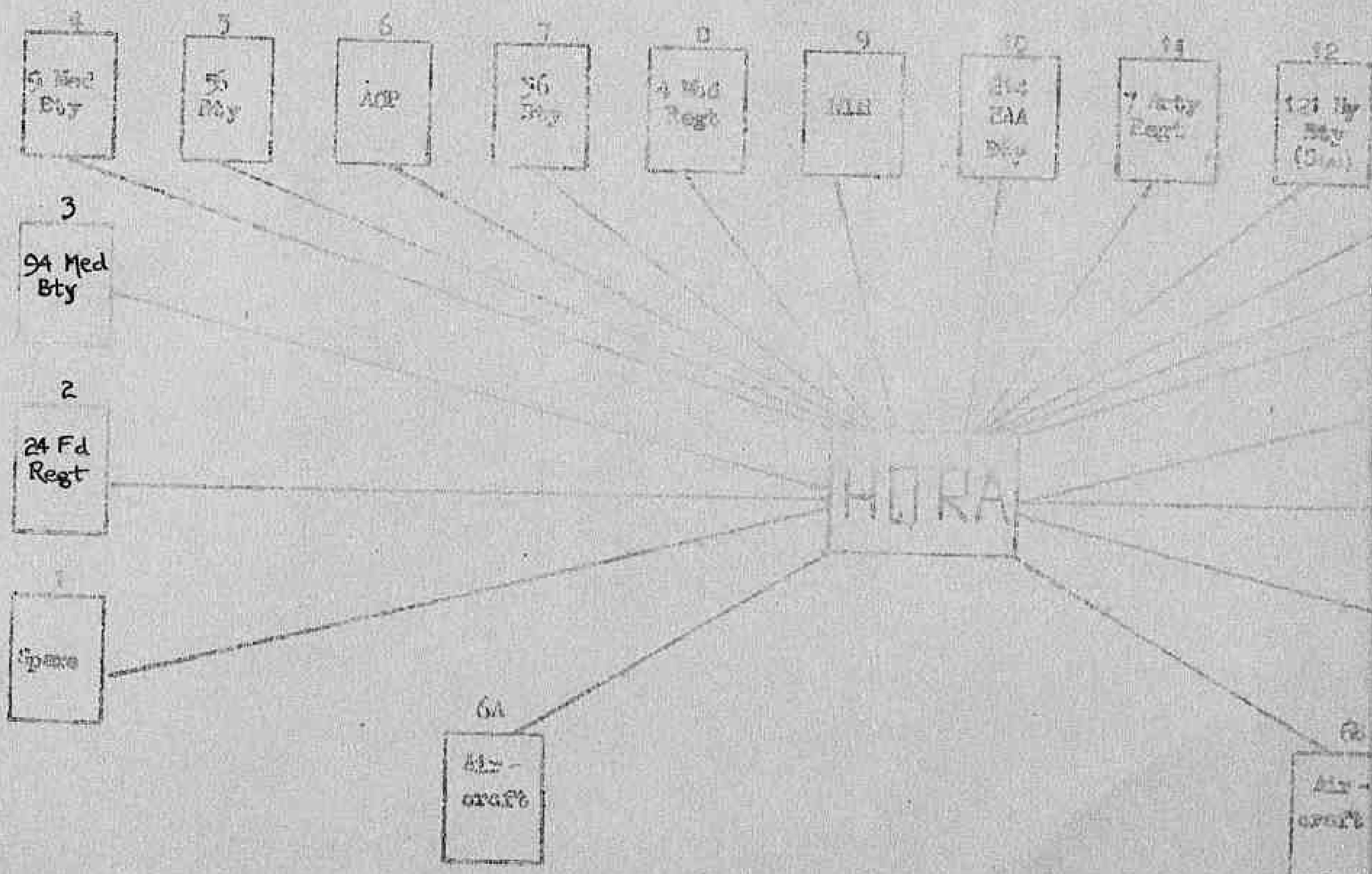

RA CRIBANA GOLF WIRELESS DIAGRAM

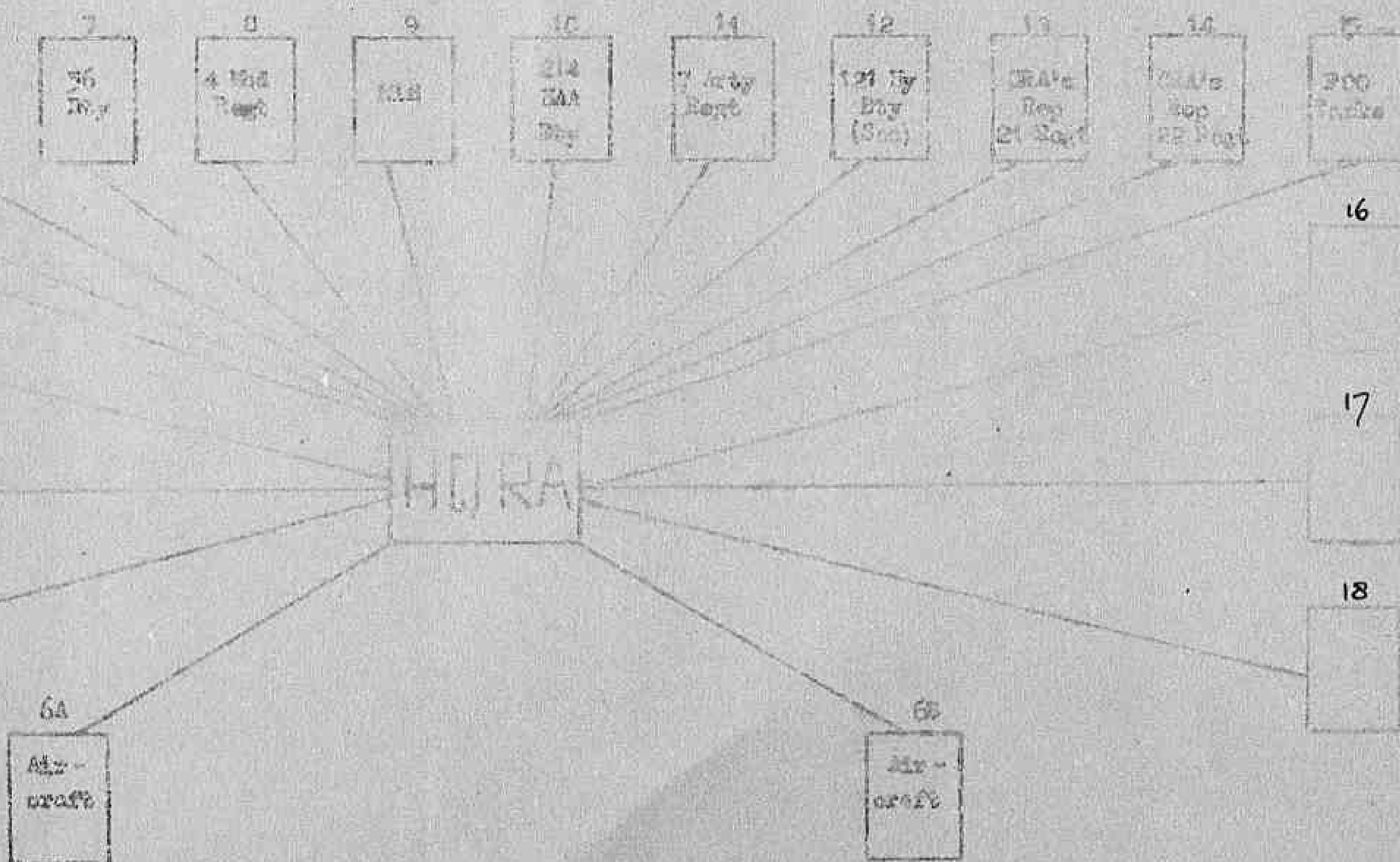

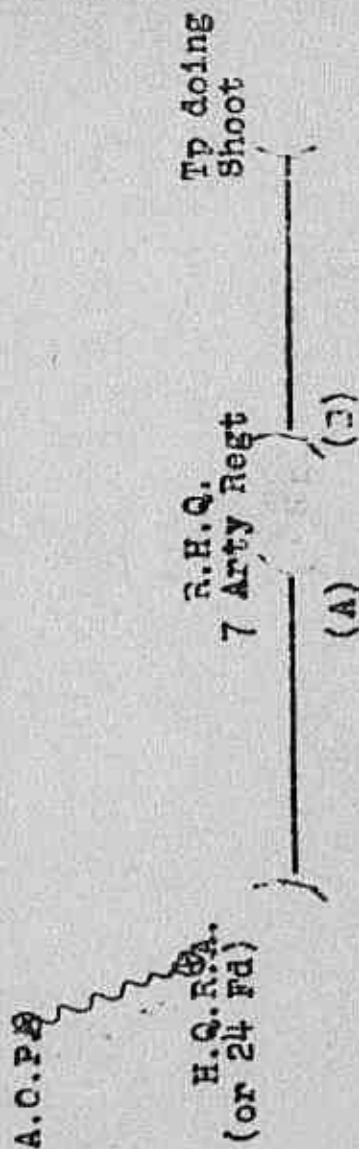

(11) All exchange operators between H.Q.R.A. and 7 Arty Regt and 7 Arty Regt and Tp will be instructed to leave the necessary lines plugged through until end of shoot.

5. All shoots will be prearranged so that the G.P.O. will have plenty of time to work out his opening switch and range and get his guns laid. Also the communications will be tested and working by the time the pilot is ready to observe.

6. Normal A.U.P. procedure will be used.

This entails the following :-

- (a) Opening switch and range is corrected for meteor.
- (b) Ranging is carried out by one gun. If the pilot does not see any round he may ask for a rd of smoke. In this case the next round fired will be smoke. the G.P.O. then reverts automatically to H.E. again.
- (c) "Fire by Order" is in force throughout the Salvos" to be fired. shoot unless cancelled at any stage by the pilot.
- (d) Corrections to line are ordered as "More" or "Less" so many degrees and minutes.
- (e) Corrections to range are ordered in the form of "Add" or "Drop" so many yards.

7. PRELIMINARY WORK

Before any shoot is to be carried out, H.Q.R.A. will issue the following instructions to 7 Arty Regt or A.O.P.:

- (a) Number, description and map ref of Target.
- (b) Numbers of guns to be used.
- (c) Type of shoot i.e. Registration, Neutralisation.
- (d) Gun available for shoot.
- (e) Time 7 Arty Regt to be ready to fire.

8. On receipt of the above, 7 Arty Regt will pilot a Troop to do the shoot. The G.P.C. of the Troop will report "Ready" and time of flight when his guns are ready. This should be a short time before the time given in (e) above.

Line communications will be as in para (4) above.

9. On receipt of "Ready" from 7 Arty Regt H.Q.R.A. will inform the Pilot who will order "Fire" when he is in a position to observe.
