1. Personnel detailed above who embarked for overseas service during Aug and Sept 42 are eligible (subject to para 7 below) for evacuation to UK on PYTHON 36 in June '46.
2. Officers in Age and Service Groups 29, 30, 31 and 32 (or earlier) and OR's in Age and Service Groups 30, 31 and 32 (or earlier) who embarked in Aug and Sept 42 will NOT report for PYTHON 36 but will be given priority of release within their Age and Service Groups.
3. Designation of Transit Camp and date for reporting will be issued in due course by formation headquarters.
4. (a) Eligible personnel serving in the unit under your command whose names are not listed above should be reported to this headquarters by signal as soon as possible.
(b) If any of the above-named are not now serving with your unit this authority should be forwarded to the Officer's or OR's new location and this headquarters informed accordingly.
5. Documentation will be completed in accordance with Instructions on reverse.
6. If any of the above named Officer's or NCO's (where applicable) are considered suitable for employment as instructors in UK, it is requested that recommendations be forwarded to this headquarters forthwith.
7. (a) Attention is drawn to GRO 263/45. Cases covered by this GRO will NOT be despatched to Transit Camp unless certified by a Medical Officer as fit to proceed under para 1168 King's Regulations.
(b) If any of the above are now in close arrest, whether serving sentence or awaiting FGCM, this authority in his/her respect is to be considered as inoperative and this headquarters informed of the circumstances immediately.
