

Ref your 20042/F/N/23 attached correspondence which evidently has had some difficulty in reaching me.

1. Could I please be supplied with fuller details of the transaction as I cannot recollect authorizing the payment of repairs to Wireless sets, especially as I have never personally owned one in C.M.F.
2. There was to my knowledge a set in the Prefectura Pavia which I imagine was the property of the Prefectura and on loan to A.M.C. Repairs to this set should be borne by the Prefectura. In addition there were of course a number of other sets but these were owned by the officers.
3. In the month of December the only officers remaining on the A.M.C. HQ staff apart from myself were Capt Riley, Public Security and Capt Wirgman C.A.O. The former is now released and in England and Capt Wirgman is, I believe on Milan Transit Camp staff.
