Subject: Medical Materials.

The quantities of medicines reported by your Mission as the allocation for February to the "MANTOVA" Infantry Division are actually rather small and the Health Directorate of GENOA, due to the availability of the pharmacies in the area, could have used a larger assignment.

This Ministry will therefore call the attention of the aforesaid Directorate and Hospital of GENOA in order that the inconvenience is not repeated; on the other hand, we take the opportunity of pointing out how there is a general tendency, by Units, to effect excessive withdrawals, a reason for which the writer has still recently been compelled to instruct all departments under its Command to use the utmost economy.

With reference to your monthly progress report for January 1946 in which you reported shortage of Medical Officers and drugs in No.2 Territorial Command.

The War Ministry has informed me that 30 Medical Officers are being posted to Terr. HQ., for duty with hospitals and the Mantova Division.

Drugs, with the exception of Penicillin, reported in short supply are being forwarded as soon as possible. Penicillin is not at present available from Italian sources but efforts are being made to obtain supplies elsewhere.
