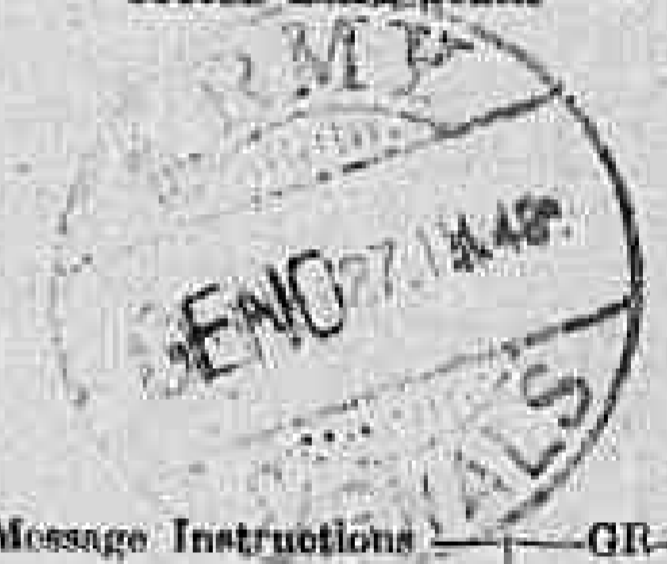



1. The ruling of the Chain of Command - Infantry Divisions (as Combat Groups) up to 25 Aug 45 date issue of circular letter 16229/ORD/1 was laid down by letter 10230/ORD of 25 Jan. herewith attached that stated:

Three types of Chain of Commands:-

- (i) Under Allied Command (Training supply, returns and other supplies)
- (ii) Under S.M.R.E. (W.R. and Welfare)
- (iii) Under R.M.H. Territorial Hq and later under the Territorial Hq in charge of districts. (drawing of money and return of administrative books and papers)

The procedure to follow for discipline, court martial, personal documents, practicals, court of inquiries and employ of officers.

2. The 3/m circular 16229/ORD/1 of S.M.R.E. cancelled the letter 10230/ORD and stated that W.R.F. 1 Sept 45 whilst the function of Allied Hq maintained its value as far as operations were concerned the Combat Groups "for every other matter" would be under command of the Territorial Hq (of the one in which each Group Hq was).

3. Reference to above, I submit to your attention the following:-

- (a) At present the Infantry Divisions are under command of Allied Authorities not only for operations (as stated in the circular letter of S.M.R.E.) but also in other fields, i.e.

The letter 2576/R/L of Suph 2/4th of S.M.R.E. (which you forwarded with your 01/361/ORD of 8th Oct 45) which gives to the Territorial Hq's the authority of supervising and directing the training had not yet reached this office when I asked for an explanation about Chain of Commands. To the above mentioned letter I am going to answer separately.

Three types of Chain of Commands:-

- (i) Under Allied Command (Creating supply, rations and other supplies)

- (iii) Under RMA's Territorial H) and later under the Territorial H) in charge of districts. (drawing of money and return of administrative books and papers)

2. The 3/4 in circular 16229/OM/1 of S.M.R.A. cancelled the letter 10250/OM and stated that S.M.R. 1 Sept 45 whilst the function of Allied H) maintained its value as far as operations were concerned the Combat Groups "for every other matter" would be under command of the Territorial H) (at the time in which each Group H) was.

3. Reference to the above, I submit to your attention the following:-

- (a) At present the Infantry Divisions are under command of Allied Authorities not only for operations (as stated in the circular letter of S.M.R.A.) but also in other fields, i.e.

The letter 2674/R/L of Sept 25th of S.M.R.A. (which you forwarded with your OI/361/ADD of 8th Oct 45) which gives to the Territorial H) the authority of supervising and directing the training had not yet reached this office when I asked for an explanation about Chain of Commands. To the above mentioned letter I am going to refer separately.

SUPPLIES

Clothing, equipment, weapons, ammunition and other supplies are still being issued by the Allies with no interference whatsoever by the Territorial H) who instead supply only rations.

- (b) As far as we know we are still under direct command of S.M.R.E. up to date.
- All branches of S.M.R.E. are still dealing directly with the Infantry Division HQ's.
- It is clearly laid down that the request for reinforcements must be directly submitted to the Mobilization Office of S.M.R.E.
- Reinforcements are sent direct to the Divisions without passing through Territorial HQ's.
- The instructions for training courses, release, leave, decrease of strength, change of position by units, personnel, posting of personnel etc. are sent to us direct from the Central Authorities for action.
- Administrative and Welfare matters are dealt with directly by S.M.R.E.
- 4. The only Chain of Command which has ceased is the one from Territorial HQ's HQ's concerning the drawing of money and returning of administrative books.
- 5. This procedure had practically ceased for quite some time.
- 6. In asking for explanations on the new Chain of Commands to S.M.R.E. I sent my request through the correct channels, as my HQ, ever since it was transferred from Jerry-Bonus Division to Combat Group (1 Oct 44), has always dealt directly with S.M.R.E.
- 7. All the more I thought this was the right procedure to be followed as the same letter had been sent for action to this HQ and Territorial HQ's, and the instructions received did not seem to me (for the above reason) sufficiently clear.

All the more I thought this was the right procedure to be followed as the same letter had been sent for action to this HQ and Territorial HQ's, and the instructions received did not seem to me (for the above reason) sufficiently clear.

Subject: Chain of Command Combat Groups.

S.M.P.E.
No 10290/ND
25 Jan 45.

As the Combat Groups will move from the present equipping and training areas and will come under Operation Command of the Allies; they will have the following Chain of Command:

Directly from competent Allied Hq's for operation and rationing (arms, ammunition, equipment), - from this S.M.P.E. - in agreement with M.M.I.A., - for W.E. and Welfare matters,

From ROLL Territorial Hq for drawing of money and returning of administrative books, until such time when the field cashiers will be available at advanced Hq's.

For matters of discipline, court martial offences, personnel reports and promotions the following rules will be observed:-

- (a) DISCIPLINE.
The G.O.C.'s Group besides the normal powers will have the authority given by para, 577 and 579 of the Italian Army Rules and Regulations.
- (b) TRIAL PROCEDURES.
The G.O.C.'s Combat Group will have their own court martials.
- (c) OFFICERS' COMMERCIAL REPORTS.
For senior Officers and Lt-Col's the final report is 3213 given by G.O.C.'s, after approval by 2 i/o.
For Colonels, this final report will be given by the Army Chief of Staff.

- (d) PROMOTION.
For matters concerning recommendation for promotions, this Staff has asked the War Office to rule that up to the rank of Captain, inclusive, the final recommendation is to be given by G.O.C. Group.
For Majors, the final recommendation (and 3rd grade Lt-Col's) is to be given by the Army Chief of Staff.

Directly from competent Allied Hqs for operation and rationing (ammunition, equipment), - from this S.M.R.E. - in agreement with M.H.I.A. - for M.E. and welfare matters.

From Rome (Militarial Hq) for drawing of money and returning of administrative books, until such time when the field cashiers will be available at advanced Hqs.

For matters of discipline, court martial offences, personnel reports and promotions the following rules will be observed:-

(a) DISCIPLINE.

The G.O.C.'s Group besides the normal powers will have the authority given by para. 577 and 579 of the Italian Army Rules and Regulations.

(b) FATAL PROCEEDINGS.

The G.O.C.'s Combat Group will have their own court martials.

(c) OFFICERS CONFIDENTIAL REPORTS.

For senior Officers and Lt-Col's the final report is given by G.O.C.'s, after approval by 2 1/2 c.

For Colonels, this final report will be given by the Army Chief of Staff.

(d) PROMOTIONS.

For matters concerning recommendation for promotions, this Staff has asked the War Office to rule that up to the rank of Captain, inclusive, the final recommendation is to be given by G.O.C. Group.

For Majors, the final recommendation (and 2nd grade Lt-Col's) is to be given by the Army Chief of Staff.

(e) DISCIPLINE AND NORMAL ENQUIRIES.

Discipline, and especially formal inquiries, which call for a decision by the War Office and which may lead to a decision by the Government, will have to be submitted to the War Office through this Staff. Reinforce Officers employment - in agreement with M.H.I.A. - it remains understood that

(a) In urgent cases an officer can at any moment be temporarily relieved of his command by order of the Allied Commander and the next senior officer will take his place.

(b) Officers who are considered unfit to Command troops by the Allied Commander.

Up to the rank of Lt-Col (inclusive) officers will be examined by the Group G.O.C.'s on request of the local Allied Authorities. Only if the local Allied Authorities are not satisfied with the decisions taken, will the matter be submitted to M.L.I.A.

If a senior rank the Allied Commander under whose orders they are will inform M.L.I.A. directly, who will then handle the matter with their Staff.
