1. Units are not always sending in vehicles when called forward by Wasps against AFs G1045. Wasp is compiling a list of specific cases of this.
 2. Deliberate delay in calling forward vehicles by Wasps in certain cases is done as the spares required for the job are not available. I agree with this policy, as it is better for the vehicle to be in unit lines where maintenance can be under unit supervision rather than the driver idling in Wasps whilst waiting for spares to arrive.
 3. I suggest that unit Commanders be asked to investigate personally their VOR and ensure that vehicles are not remaining in unit or LAD lines when they are beyond local facilities and to see that AFs G1045 are submitted soonest so that provision can be made for obtaining necessary spares.
