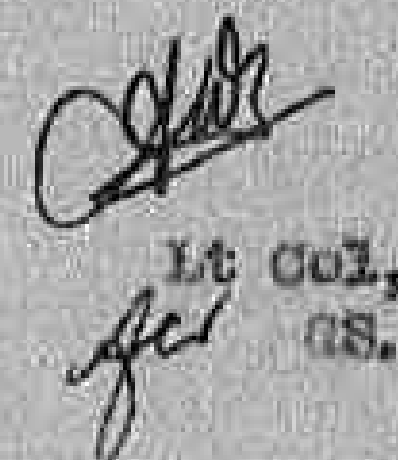

Dear Sir.

You have probably heard the name of the "Teccenta di Presciano" as it is a by-word in Siena for bad luck and misfortune! Anyhow, as the owner of the estate, allow me to give you a summary of our adventures during recent events.

First used by the Germans as a prisoner of war (British) camp, Presciano was afterwards occupied by the SS for over three months. They kept in the attics of the villa some Polish prisoners of war they had made previously. During their stay, they stole 200 oxen, 60 pigs and a number of sheep, as well as destroyed or stole all the furniture. Then the fight came through and the estate was occupied first by French white and coloured troops and after by the Americans, who among other things turned some cornfields and vineyards into a flying field. Afterwards we had a period of some calm until November 1944 while Marshal Alexander's HQ occupied the premises. A month of peace followed in which the villa was as far as possible re-arranged, and I came to live in it.

At the beginning of January 1945 the whole of Presciano was requisitioned by the 'Legnano' Division (command of the regiments, 800 men, lorries and tanks). I was turned out of the villa and had to live in a room in the 'Fattoria', which belonged to my coachman, with no bath nor any other commodity. However as there was a war on, there was nothing to say and I said nothing. In March the 'Legnano' left and eight days after was on the premises. What these two Divisions, especially the second, did in the way of tree cutting, wanton destruction and unnecessary damage to buildings all over the estate, is difficult to relate. In June the 'Mantova' moved elsewhere in installments, and this morning the last of it was supposed to leave, thus allowing us the use of our granaries where the corn is to be brought during the next few weeks beginning on Saturday. To my intense dismay I was told this morning that the villa and all the buildings, the granaries, the store rooms, the 'tinaio' and even the stable (which so far had been left to us as there was no other place where to keep the horses and cart) were again requisitioned, and that the 130 caterpillars (cingollette) belonging to the Division were to be concentrated in the big courtyard surrounded by the villa and the adjoining buildings until orders were given by the British Command to take these vehicles either to Arezzo or to Naples. I objected that the corn had been cut in the fields, that the operations of thrashing and bringing it in must begin on Saturday and that by that date the granaries must be clean and ready to receive the crops. I was answered that this was no concern of theirs, and that I had better not try to bring in the corn as they would oppose by force any attempt at storing it in the granaries.

You know the difficulties we have had in the provinces of Siena as to the beginning of the thrashing operations. We are late already and the corn cannot be kept any longer in the open. A rain might now spoil the whole crop. If the peasants hear that I cannot store the corn on Saturday owing to this new imposition of the troops that have already stolen their fruits and most of their potatoes, I am afraid that there will be trouble. Anyhow a crop of 3000 quintals of corn runs the risk of being spoilt or lost. I do not mean to be fussy, but I do think that after 18 months of military occupation we should be allowed to gather and store our crops in peace at last!

1. Combat Group MANTOVA are at present engaged in guarding prisoners of war and in assisting AG with the evacuation of refugees. These duties necessitate the forming of a large number of small camps for the various dirty personnel.
2. This sub division of various units has resulted in great difficulties of water supply as the water trucks held by the Group are constantly employed on distributing water and cannot be used for storage in unit lines.
3. In order to overcome this storage problem it is requested that 15 two hundred and fifty gallon static water tanks may be made available to the Group. Application is being made through Engineer channels subject to confirmation by the 'Q' staff.

1. The rooms in question appear to be those which were vacated by Capts BELL and PACE on the Saturday before I left S. GIORGIO, instructions were given to the Italian batmen and Soldier Servant that the rooms were to be left in a clean state.
2. On Saturday 21st April a British Sgt in the Yorkshire Dragoons, name unknown came to collect the kit etc, from the flat and take it to AFRAGOLA. Instructions were repeated to him regarding the cleaning of the billet and when he left, handed over the key of the flat at the same time assuring me that the billet had been left in a clean and tidy condition.
3. The key of the flat was at once handed over to the Town Major who was waiting at S. GIORGIO.
4. Re the light, I regret to say this must have slipped my memory.
5. On Monday morning, before leaving BENEVENTO, I informed the Town Major that if anything was wrong with any of the billets, arrangements had been made with the Italian Camp Commandant, Capt. CETTI. to supply the necessary men if required. The Town Major seemed to be in perfect agreement with these arrangements.
6. The first knowledge I had about an inventory for the furniture in the billet was when the Town Major showed me a copy on the morning of the 23rd. I was unable to account for the deficiencies.

Reference Baron Nisco's house at SAN GIORGIO DEL SANNIO, used as a Serjeants' Mess.

We have received from Lieut. VOS, the Marching Out State of furniture. In comparing it with the original furniture inventory taken by Lieut. Col. HOWARD, a copy of which is enclosed, we find there is a considerable deficiency. Can you tell us what happened to this furniture, and if same was handed back to Baron Nisco, as we have no trace in our records.

I regret to inform you that the billet was left in a dirty condition. The two rooms at the right in the front of the building were particularly so. There was bread, orange peel, bottles and all types of literature strewn about the rooms. Also there was a packet of Tea (approx 4 lbs) left on one of the beds in another room. A light in the porch had been left on apparently for days and when I spoke to the Officer about this on Sunday morning, 22 Apr 45, I was assured that this light would be turned off. On returning on Tuesday, 24 Apr 45, I found this light still burning, and I switched it off myself, the switch being in one of the rooms upstairs.
