1. A considerable amount of Training Ammunition is still in the dump at PIETRAFUSI. In order to have training ammunition immediately available at the new destination it is essential that this ammunition should be taken.
2. It is therefore requested that this ammunition should be distributed immediately to regts and units for them to carry. The following suggestions are made for the carriage :-

.25 pr - in the limbers with the guns

.17 pr }
.40 mm } - in the gun towing vehicles.

- *.503 Bandolier - one bandolier carried by each man as far as it will go round.
- *.303 Carbine - Bren mags carried full, certain number of men to carry 50 rds loose in their pouches.
- *.45 Thompson - magazines carried filled, certain amount of loose rds can be carried in the mens pouches.
- .5" Mortar - in the Mortar Carriers.
- .2" Mortar - in the Bren Carriers. etc

All units in the division can carry a proportion of the remaining types on their vehicles. Where magazines are filled they will in no circumstances be carried on the gun but in the mens pouches.

3. May the ammunition dump be cleared by 11 April.
