			1. Reference your signal Q 469 of 26 July 1945. 2. Arrangements have been made to obtain the use of German 6 ton vans to ship on or about 30 July: a. 80 mules from S. Martino in Spino to Turino. b. 50 mules from S. Martino in Spino to Genoa. c. 90 mules from S. Martino in Spino to Bologna. Request the Italian L.O. and MMIA LOs alert the Territorial HQs concerned. 3. It is contemplated to use these same trucks to move the Agricultural Sub Commission mules to Fara Sabina and Grosseto if it can be completed prior to your proposed date for rail movement. Query: What about the remaining Italian War Ministry mules: 60 to Florence 110 to Rome 140 to Naples 250 to Palermo When do we move these by rail?
