1. There is a temporary theatre-wide shortage of P.O.L. and the allotment to your Command for the month of November was restricted by AFHQ Pet Sec.
2. The impending speed-up of the present movement of ammunition in Genoa area is a commitment which may have to be met mainly with Italian military vehicles; although discussions are in progress between M.M.I.A.I.O. Genoa and A.M.G. Genoa for the use of A.M.G. controlled civilian vehicles to carry out part of the movement.
3. HQ. M.M.I.A. state that the possibility of receiving an additional allocation of P.O.L. for movement by supplementary indent is remote; not because the work is not important or urgent but because the stocks are not available.
4. From above, it will be readily seen that the consumption of P.O.L. for November will require careful and methodical planning. The domestic maintenance of the Command, movement of supplies, etc. must not break down. The programme of movement for the ammunition must be super-imposed on but subjugated to the existing maintenance programme and you are requested to consider the following:-
 - (a) A 10% reduction on existing allocation to units as shown in your 3245 dated 27 Oct with the exception of 2 C.T.A. and 3 G.T.Coy. The 10% to be allocated to reserve under the conditions of STG/101 of 21 Oct.
 - (b) Utilize the present 20% reserve for allocation to vehicles engaged in the ammunition programme. **1267**
 - (c) Institute a system of "back-loading" in order that dead mileage be reduced to a minimum.

HQ. to the maximum extent.

5. Will you please examine the foregoing and
forward your proposals to this office including the number
of hired civilian vehicles at present engaged on the ammunition
programme and the maximum number which could be so employed.

Reference your letters 2173 dated 18 Oct 45 and 2168 dated 17 Oct 45 both received in this office on 13 Oct.

The removal and guarding of ammunition of Italian origin is the responsibility of the Italian Armed Forces, therefore the last paragraph of your letter 2173 dated 18 Oct is irrelevant.

Regarding your letter 2168 dated 17 Oct and further to this office 326/101 dated 18 Oct 45 it is not understood why an application for additional POL has not been submitted until it was found that 80% of your monthly allocation has been consumed in 18 days; and you therefore cannot but agree that if the essential duties required of your command are to be carried out, strict rationing of the remaining 20% is necessary therefore it is not possible for large scale movement of ammunition to take place.

Your attention is directed to the procedure regarding the obtaining of Supplementary allocation of POL, which is as follows:-

Your application for a Supplementary Allocation should be submitted to this office with full facts and figures, showing what additional POL is required and how the existing monthly allotment has been used, i.e. in this case removing ammunition, transfer of stores, etc.-

It is apparent that no steps have been taken to ensure that 2168 and 2173 should have been available for the reference and

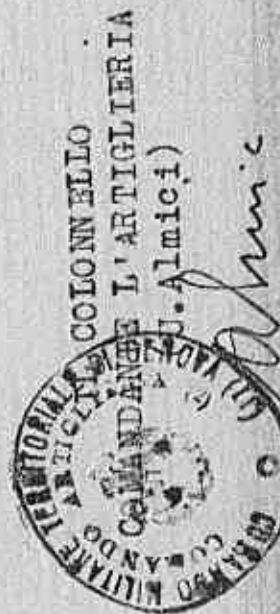

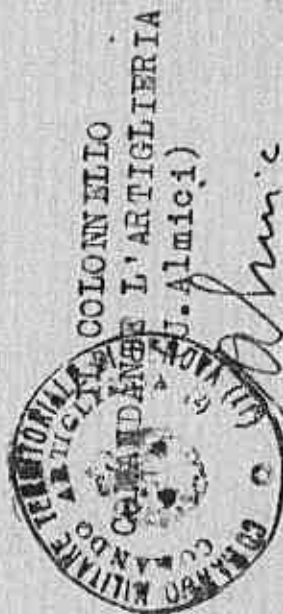
