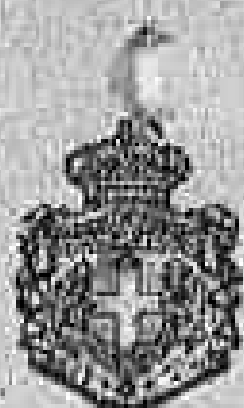

Carlo Bastico of Vigevano.

TO : M.M.I.A. LO., GENOA

It was brought to our attention that 5000 pair of shoes (Army type) were existing at the Shoe Factory Carlo Bastico, Corso Genoa 16, Vigevano, and therefore it was arranged to freeze said footwears through CC.RR.

Above Shoe Factory in letter dated 3 July 1945 (appx 1) stated that shoes were not property of the Military Administration and that they were frozen by C.L.N.A.I.; such statement was confirmed by A.M.G.

The Comitato Industriale del Cuoio (Industrial Committee for Leather), Via S.Andrea, 18, Milan, was requested to release shoes in question to this Directorate in letter dated 31 July (appx 2) and the answer was that the 5000 pair of shoes were frozen by order of the Allied Forces Local Resumes Section, the Hq. of which in Rome is liaising with Italian Military Ministries.

Your MMIA is informed of the above in order that an interest be taken in the matter for the allocation of subject shoes to this Directorate.
