1. W.e.f; today, 1 July 45, the Security Control Line is operative along the western bdy of VENEZIA GIULIA.
2. The followin procedure for Italian Military personnel who wish to visit VENEZIA GIULIA will be strictly observed :-
 - (a) These living in VENEZIA GIULIA WEST of the MORGAN Line may visit their families provided they are unarmed and are in possession of an AMG pass.
 - (b) Those with homes EAST of the MORGAN Line and/or POLA Lines will equally be unarmed, be in possession of an AMG Pass, countersigned by the JUGOSLAV Mission with this H.Q., and must wear civilian clothes.
3. Applications for passes will be forwarded to this H.Q.
4. You are requested to ensure that these concessions are fully explained by all Italian Commanders to their officers and men: it is stressed that failure to observe regulations of this nature in the past has led to unfortunate incidents from which the Italians have been the first to suffer.
