Your are informed that by the Audit Office of the Engineer Directorate some pieces of correspondence have been found concerning the death, occurred between 1942 and 1943 in the "Colonia Fara" Hospital of Chiavari, of 6 Allied P.O.W. belonging to P.O.W. Camp of Pian di Coreglia.

The bodies have been buried in the Cemetery of Chiavari and on March 1944 exhumed and buried again in the Cemetery of Cicagna where they still are.

The names of said P.O.W. appear from the attached notice of the Municipality of Chiavari - City Office.
