1. Confusion is being caused by Italian Army units using obsolete designations.
2. A case in point is the Italian Service and MT Coy A.2. (Ep.It.Servizi e Trasporti AC.) detachment at Genoa using the designation "266/1 Coy (Autonoma Artieri)."
3. Where alleged BR-III Service units cannot be identified in the Italian Army Strength State, they will be refused maintenance at British DIB's and instructions issued by this office that they will be maintained from III-III depots until inquiry as to the proper status is made.
4. Detachment Italian Service and MT Coy AC at Genoa is a BR-III unit and arrangements will be made by this office for rations to be drawn from 16 DIB Genoa in future.
5. MMIA LO Genoa letter STG/ 15/2 dated 21 Nov. 45 is cancelled.
