TO: General Frattini, II Territorial Hq., Genoa

1. Have been informed by MMIA that MMIA LO with 2 District will liaise with the Genoa Command. Major Bird is the MMIA LO with 2 District and can be reached in care of 2 District, Milan. For any future dealings, kindly contact Major Bird.

2. Have conferred with Headquarters MMIA in regard to your problems and the following information is furnished.

a. Rations - Sufficient complete rations have been turned over to British authorities for all Italian troops in your area. You are to draw all your rations from 203 DID including bread.

c. QM Supplies - Requisition thru' M/W.

d. Officers Cloth - Col. Simmons has list and says that release will be granted.

e. Hospital Diet Items - From DID.

f. Vehicles - MMIA is endeavoring to obtain needed vehicles from the north. Major Edwards has list of tools needed and if possible will try to obtain them. MMIA states that vehicle stickers are not needed at this time.

2. Enclosed find MMIA answer to request for an officer transfer. Also find papers no longer needed by me.

SUBJECT: II Territorial Headquarters, Genoa
TO : Land Forces Sub Commission, AC (M.M.I.A.)

1. Pursuant to instructions have liaised with II Territorial Headquarters, Genoa for the past few days and the following information is submitted:
 - a. GOC - Enrico Prattini
 - b. Territorial Headquarters - Casa del Fascio, Piazza Corridoni, Telephone, Genoa 22729.
 - c. 92nd Division is in command and as soon as phase I is completed 57 Area will take over. Both headquarters have been very helpful.
 - d. Liaison action has been rendered to Territorial Headquarters in property, P.o.l., rations and various other matters.
2. ST, MT, & Medical reports are attached as appendices A B and C.
3. Arrangements have been made with 57 Area for the reception and transmission of all communications.
4. During the week two companies of 519 Guard Battalion have arrived from Siena. It is expected that the remaining companies will arrive in the near future.

SUBJECT: ST Re ort, Genoa

TO : Land Forces Sub Commission, AC (M.M.I.A.)

1. Italian units are being supplied with a complete Italian ration from 203 DID, Genoa.
2. Supply, 57 Area states that he has enough Italian provided items for 1200 men for 60 days.
3. Attached hereto is a breakdown of Italian rations issued 23 May 1945 from 203 D.I.D. .
4. 519 Guard Battalion is to draw on 1 June 45; the ration strength of Territorial Headquarter will be increased on 1 June 45 by about 300; one Italian Mine Clearance Company is due in the area; within the past week the strength of the CCRR has increased by about 1000; with these increases it is estimated that the feeding strength will soon be approximately 4000.
5. Supplies are shipped by sea from Leghorn and Naples.
6. The Italian Military Bakery has been requisitioned by the Allies, but the Italian are using a civilian bakery with a maximum output of approximately 2000 loaves.

1. Attached hereto is a list of vehicles in possession of Territorial Headquarters, Genoa. Request that authority be granted to repossess Italian Military Vehicles in control of 5 Army to fill shortages.

2. The military garage of Genoa was stripped of all tools and parts. Attached hereto is a list of parts and tools that are needed for the Territorial garage to properly function. Understand that 5 Army has some 750 tons of parts and supplies belonging to the Italian Military. Request that Genoa Territorial motor needs be filled from 5 Army stockpile.

3. POL is now being drawn from 57 Area but arrangements will have to be made with CIP as soon the territory will no longer be army area.

4. Vehicle stickers are necessary to allow vehicles to circulate. Request that they be dispatched without delay.
