I am really sorry for not being able to fulfill your desire in regard to Sgt Major Cardullo Giuseppe employed by your MMIA Detachment, since Ministry of War with specific instructions states that the daily 20 lire for extra work pay are to be given to servicemen organized into special Labor Units (other than ITI-ITI-) and employed by Allied Hq. in works such as loading and unloading stores, stivadoring, transporting stores and foodstuffs and road repairing work.

Since Sgt Major Cardullo is assigned to Quartiere Generale of this Hq. is not part of above mentioned Labor Units, he cannot be entitled to allowance to which servicemen of the same unit are not entitled to ~~it~~, and therefore it is not possible to derogate from specific orders.
