The three Armourer's Mechanics with the Rifle Companies are considered to have duties corresponding to the storemen trained in Armourers' duties in British units.

The four Armourer's Mechanics with the Support Company are the only "armourer's mechanics" in that company. It is thus clear that their principal function is the servicing of the 3-in. Mortar, 6-Pz. A/Tk. Guns and the Carriers. Armourers Tools, of course, are not required for these purposes. It is considered that the four "armourer's mechanics" in the Support company should, more correctly, be termed "artificers". The counterparts in the Support company of a British Infantry Battalion are termed "fitters" and "fitters, L.V." of which there is a total of four in the British Support Company.

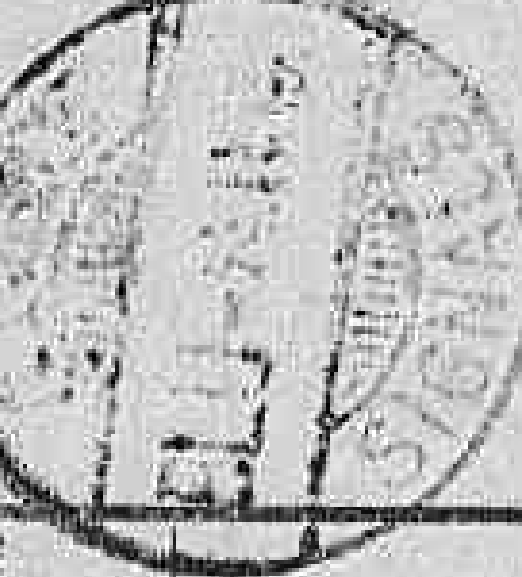
