There have been a number of complaints from D.D.O.S. and A.D.O.S. of Districts and Areas in rear of Armies, that when notification is received by D.D.O.S., A.D.O.S. and D.A.D.O.S. of Formations and Areas, that Formations or individual units are shortly leaving Army Areas for the rear, that there is a tendency to "turn off the tap" in the supply of ordnance stores, with the idea that the unit etc will be able to complete its G1096 entitlement by drawing direct from Base Depots.

2. Units etc leaving Army areas for rear areas will at all times be made up as far as possible, to their authorized G1096 entitlement, as due to Armies getting priority of issue of any available stores held in Base Depots, it is a false policy to withhold any stores expecting the units to be able to obtain them when they arrive in base areas.

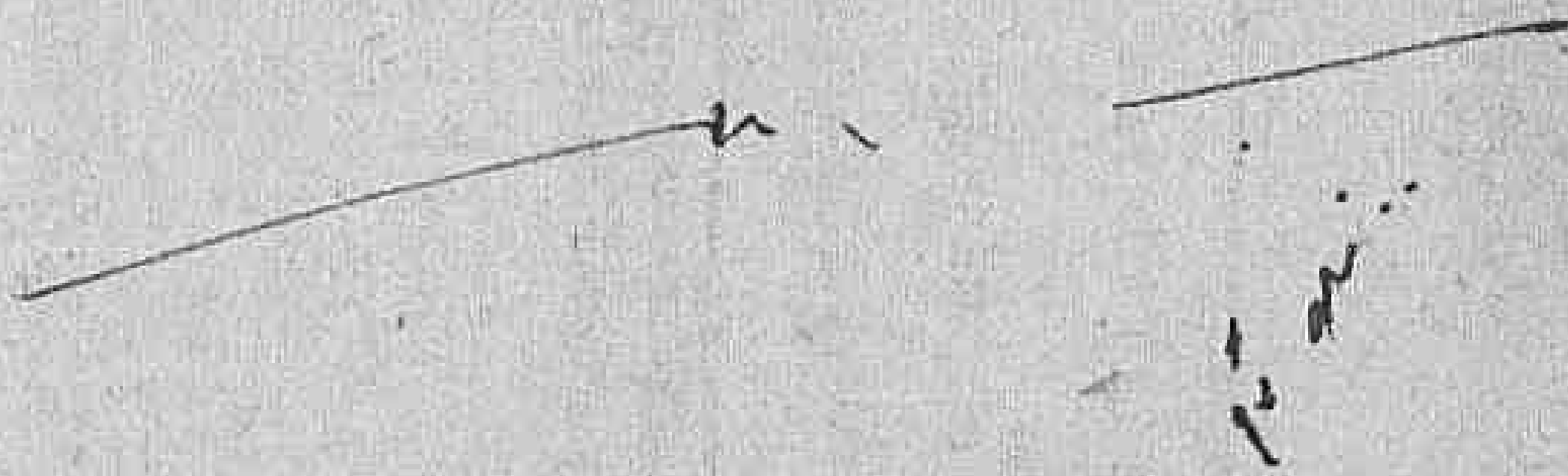



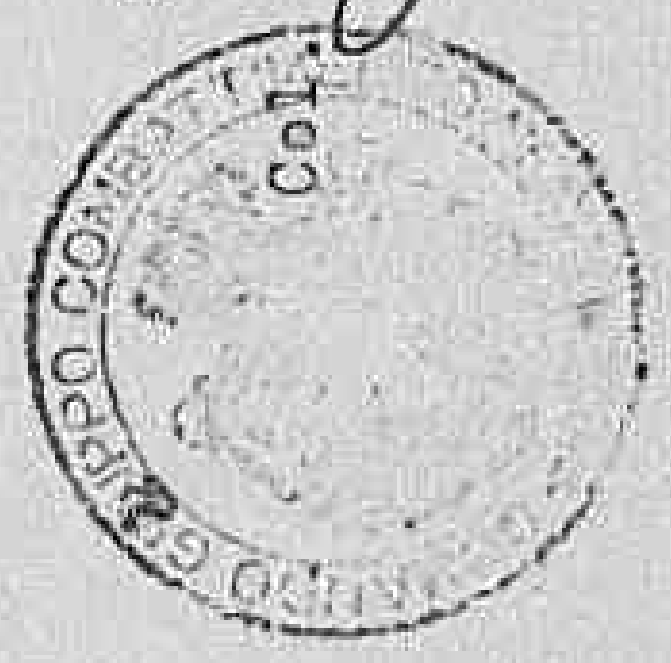

REPORT ON SMITH & WESSON .38-IN. PISTOL REVOLVERS

We recently received six issues to the Regt of 294 of the above type revolvers, these were all brand new in the cases as they had left the manufacturers factory at Springfield, Mass. (according to the packing notes).

On inspecting them prior to individual issue, every one, without exception was found to have thick rust on some part of the body, the majority round the metal work of the pistol grip frame, and many also at the muzzle end of the barrel.

It was found that in 8 revolvers, the mainsprings were broken due to the action of the rust, and owing to the non-availability of spares, these had to be reworked and replaced (Serial Nos quoted below). It is feared that many more cases of this kind will occur after little use, due to the mainsprings being affected and left weak through the action of the rust.

Each weapon was packed, slightly piled and loosely wrapped in waxed paper, in a cardboard carton, but the absence of mineral jelly, or grease, obviously renders them unfit for an overseas journey, or long storage.

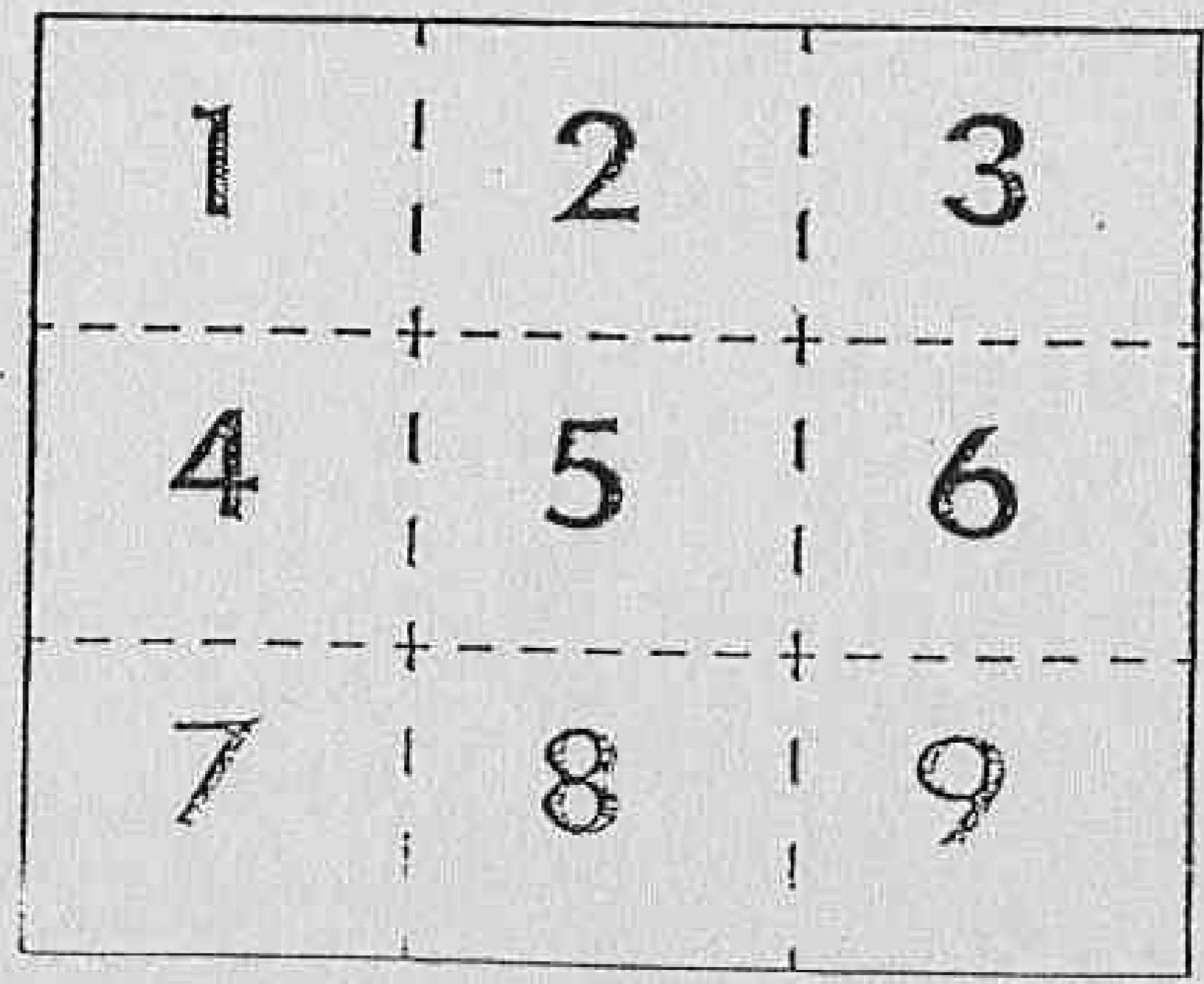
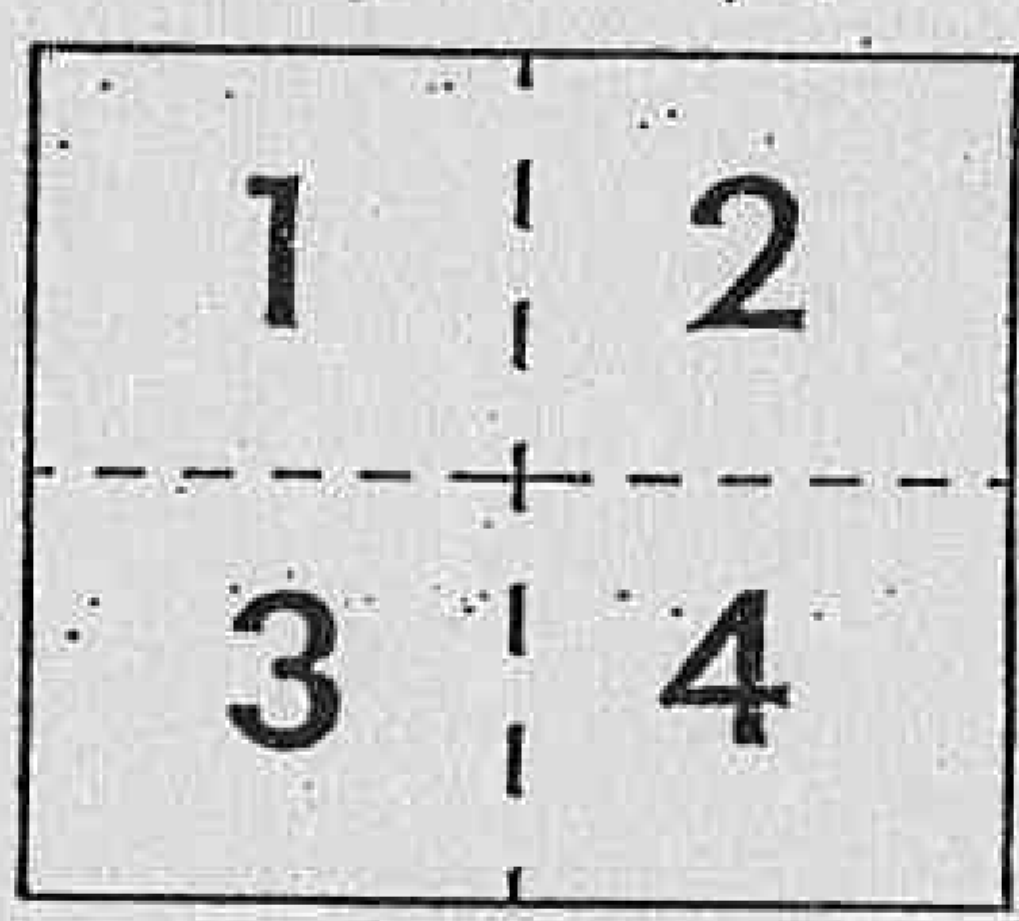
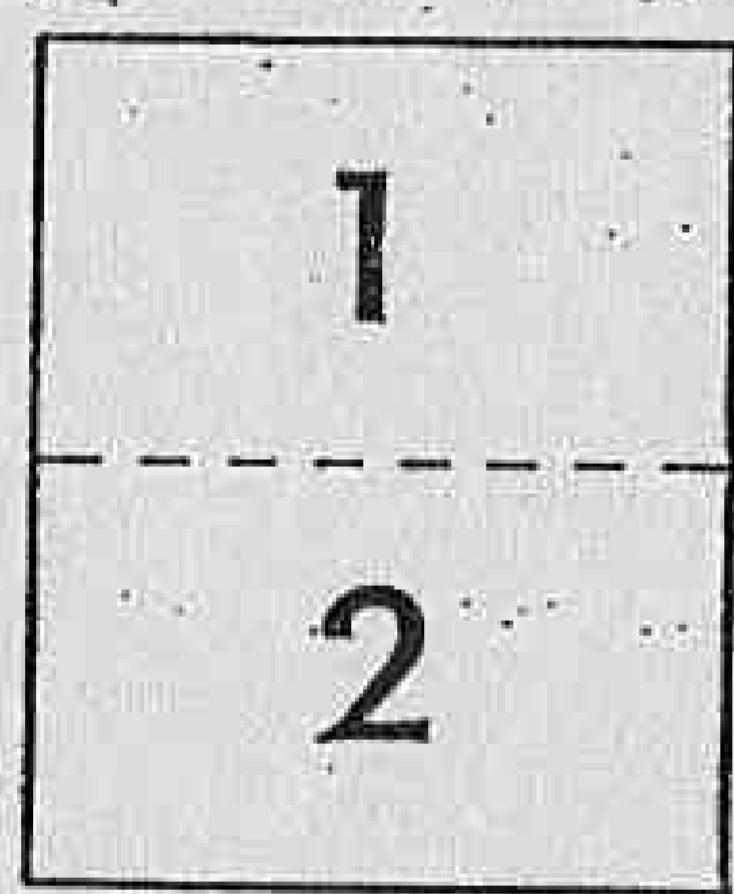
