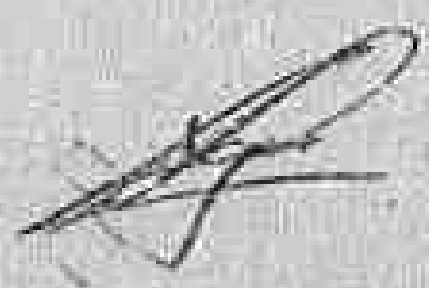

An officer of HQ Wksp "LEGNANO" together with SC REME 52 BLU visited HQ 114 Regt on the 1 Aug 45 with the purpose of inspecting the MT Service, Wksp of the Regt and the spares situation.

1. LAD Personnel & Unit Mechanics - The most urgent need seems to be a capable experienced WCO to assist the present WO i/c LAD (who is himself an energetic and reliable man, but being a gunner lacks the necessary experience to command an LAD on his own).

All Regtl MT personnel speak highly of the LAD Corporal, who appears to be the only efficient inspector as well as a first class mechanic. He was suggested already for promotion and if this could be done the first problem would already be solved in the best way.

Besides the WO, the Cpl and another fitter, the LAD has no other skilled tradesmen at its disposal. The electrician knows only what he learnt in the Unit. Since it is very difficult to complete deficiencies of skilled personnel HQ Wksp LEGNANO will send an Electrician for a period of 15 days (19 Aug - 2 Sep) to the LAD, during which time the LAD Electrician will attend theoretical and practical course at LEGNANO Wksp.

Deficiencies of Personnel are:-

2 Dvr Mechs
3 Fitters
1 Welder
2 Storemen (1 of which is to be a Cpl).

The Regtl Units have no Mechanics. At least 3 per BN should be provided. They must have the same qualifications as the Dvr Mechs of the LAD.

2. Equipment of LAD

This HQ with the assistance of 52 BLU will provide replenishments for the already shortage of stores.

Scale of issue of stores for mechanics is not complete.
Deficiencies: Forge etc.

1. LAD Personnel & Unit Mechanics - The most urgent need seems to be a capable experienced WCO to assist the present WO i/c LAD (who is himself an energetic and reliable man, but being a gunner lacks the necessary experience to command an LAD on his own).
