16)SAFEGUARDING CAPTURED ENEMY MATERIEL1. General.

- a. All captured or surrendered German supplies, equipment and installations discovered by U.S. units in the Fifth Army area will be safeguarded initially by guards posted by the discovering unit. These guards will be responsible that materiel is not illegally removed prior to relief by guards supplied by Fifth Army.
- b. Discovering units will then notify the Army Supply Service concerned, or the AC of S, G-4 this Headquarters without delay, giving the location of the dump or stock of supplies or equipment. The AC of S, G-4 (or the Army Service through the AC of S, G-4) will place a request or AC of S, G-3 for receiving guard detail. This guard will relieve that posted by the discovering unit.

2. Guard Units Under Army Control.

- a. Upon notification of location of any area or materiel to be guarded, an officer of the guard unit will report to that area and determine the number of posts required, making arrangements at the same time for relief of any guard personnel then on duty.
 - b. Primary mission of all guards will be to prevent the improper removal, damage to or destruction of the materiel designated to be guarded.
- (1) Supplies or equipment will be removed from guarded areas only on written authority from the appropriate Army Service under direction of the AC of S, G-4, or under direction of appropriate service detachment operating in the area. (See copy of release form attached as Inclosure #1)
 - (2) Once a dump depot or area is taken over, a constant guard will be maintained until properly relieved by orders from this Headquarters or until all supplies or equipment are removed by properly authorized personnel.

3. Reports.

3. Reports.

a. A report in duplicate will be submitted daily (in writing) to this Headquarters (AC of S, G-3 and copy to the AC of S, G-4) by the CO of the organization detailed to furnish guards, giving the following information:

- (1) New installations or areas placed under guard during past 24 hours.
- (2) Exact location (map coordinates) of guarded area.
- (3) Number of posts on each new area or installation.
- (4) Brief description of materiel.
- (5) Total number of men remaining available for guard duty.

4. Any special instructions required by Army Services for guard detachments or for any specific situation will be given verbally through the AC of S, G-4 or AC of S, G-3, Fifth Army.

INSTRS FOR THE HOLDING OF SURPLUS VEHs, EQPT & STORES

INTRODUCTION

1. (a) Recent inspections by the Inspectorate of Army Equipment show that units continue to hold vehs, eqpt and stores to which they are not entitled.
- (b) In order that surp of vehs and eqpt may be conserved to the utmost degree, it has been decided that all demands for surplus vehs and eqpt will be co-ordinated, and Retention Certificates issued, by HQ FIFTH ARMY.
- (c) The only exception to the above rule will be that:-
 - (i) A Corps HQ may issue Retention Certificates to units under command and to Corps Tps.
 - (ii) Div and Indep Bde HQ are authorised to issue Retention Certificates to basic units under command provided such surpluses are held within the total entitlement of the unit.
- (d) Except when the provisions of para (c) above are applicable, the procedure to be adopted is outlined below.

AUTHORITY FOR HOLDING SURPLUS EQPT

2. (a) With effect from the date of this Order, holdings above War Establishment or Staff Rept Tables will require specific authorisation from HQ FIFTH ARMY or a Corps HQ, with the exception of surplus unit holdings held within full entitlement covered by the terms of para (c)(ii) above.
- (b) Veh and stores held "in lieu" of holdings authorised by War Establishments, Staff Equipment Tables, AF G1098 or Special Equipment Lists will not be regarded as surplus. Expt stores, eqpt, tools and plant (known as expt stores of ord origin) issued by RE Stores will not be held in lieu of AF G1098 eqpt of ord origin and provision, except on authority of RE Army.
- (c) Normally authority for the retention of surplus eqpt will only be granted where there is a general requirement which necessitates an amendment to a WE being put forward. In individual cases, however, authority may be given to meet special operational requirements of a temporary nature.
- (d) The following are the competent authorities for the issue of Retention Certificates:-

(1) Vehicles:

- (a) (SD) Army or Corps for all "in" and "ex" vehs other than those enumerated below.
- (b) Army or Corps for OP armv cars and SP armv (less SP armv

- (b) Veh and stores held "in limbo" of holdings authorized by War Establishments, Staff Equipment Tables, AF G1098 or Special Equipment Tables will not be regarded as surplus. Eng stores, expt, tools and plant (known as eng stores of ord origin) issued by RE Stores will not be held in lieu of AF G1098 expt of ord origin and provision, except on authority of RE ARMY.
- (c) Normally authority for the retention of surplus expt will only be granted where there is a general requirement which necessitates an amendment to a WE being put forward. In individual cases, however, authority may be given to meet special operational requirements of a temporary nature.
- (2) The following are the competent authorities for the issue of Retention Certificates:-

(1) Vehicles:

- G(SD) Army or Corps for all MAP and TAP vehs other than those enumerated below.
- RA Army or Corps for OP arm'd cars and OP arm'd (less SP arm'd for RAQ units).
- RE Army or Corps for RE mech and anti vehs.
- OS Army or Corps for all tech vehs except mech expt which is controlled by RE.

(12) Class VI vehs for conversion:

Class VI vehs required for conversion will not be issued by ORD or S&I except on authority from G(SD) Army or Corps. Such authority will not be given unless the conversion is required to comply to War Establishment or under conditions as in para 2(c) when a Retention Certificate is required.

- One copy to fam or unit concerned.
 One copy to Corps or equivalent HQ through which application has been made.
 One copy to Q(AR) ARHQ.
- (c) Units will show details of all surplus holdings on Census Form LS and Veh Census. The authority on which they are held will be clearly stated.
- (d) In all cases application for renewal will be initiated through the normal channels 21 days before the authority expires.

UNAUTHORISED HOLDINGS

4. (a) OCS units will be held personally responsible if they are found to be holding eqpt, vehs or arms exceeding their entitlement which are not covered by Retention Certificates mentioned in para 3.
- (b) In such cases, a full report will be required in writing, to be furnished through the normal channels to Army HQ. Disciplinary action will be taken if any infringement of these orders occurs.

DISPOSAL OF SURPLUSES FOUND BY INSPECTOR OF ARMY REPORT

5. In order to obviate the necessity of backloading any existing surpluses and to enable a redistribution to be made, the following procedure will be adopted forthwith.
- (a) Procedure during inspection by Inspectorate of Army Report
- (i) When carrying out an inspection of any unit, the Inspector of Army Report concerned will enter any surpluses on the special
