1/. A quantity of M.T. stores, mostly all of a fragile nature (Dynamos, Petrol Pumps etc), were received here from D.A.D.O.S. Dump on 19/5/45;

2/. Although, as stated above, the stores were fragile, they had been placed together in a sack at D.A.D.O.S. Dump, no attempt being made to pack them.

3/. Entirely due to this negligence, one Dynamo was received here in a U/S condition, and it is considered that it was just luck that further damage to these valuable and important stores was not caused.
