It is very important that clear instructions are posted on the walls of E.T. rooms on how to take the necessary precautions against V.D., and it must be impressed on the men by means of lectures by officers, the desirability of avoiding contact, or failing this, of taking the most thorough and careful precautions; these precautions are effective if properly used and no time is lost after exposure.

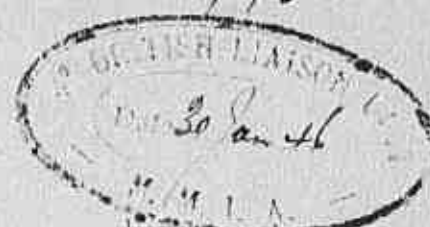
