1.- At the present moment the BLU is being called upon by Disthree and 217 Area to perform certain duties that are not within the scope of a BLU. These duties were previously performed by the Town Major, BOLLANO, who was appointed OC Troops; he has now gone away and they are now really the job of the Town Major BOLOGNA who covers this area. These extraneous duties include such things as sending officers off to various towns in this area to see if men who have been locally released are getting on well or whether they need help.

2.- These duties all take time and are extravagant as far as this unit is concerned because owing to the few British O.R's. with the unit (there being many deficiencies against W.B.) the officers of the unit have to devote all their time to MMIA, Italian and Domestic duties.

3.- It would be appreciated if all concerned could be informed that these duties should be carried out by Town Major, BOLOGNA or the relevant branch of 217 Area.

4.- I would like to point out moreover that it was decided by ~~figures~~ 217 Area that by virtue of being employed with an Italian formation I am disqualified from being O.C. TROOPS, BOLLANO. I have no desire to be so, but I do not wish to carry out the above duties unless I am so appointed.

I have had a letter from M.T. Hill who used to be training officer under command with the Combat Groups. He asks whether it is possible for him to come back to employment in M.M.I.A.

Before answering him I would like to know whether you recommend the application being made and whether, in the event of his being accepted, you would be willing to have him as a 2nd Grade Staff Officer under your command. I do not suggest that he would be so employed, or that there is any intention of replacing any of the officers you at present have, but merely as a matter of form and because I feel that if you would accept him that I might do the same.
