Subject: Clothing for Italian Troops.

To: MIA (for Q)

- 1.- During the past week the following points have been put to this unit by the Italian Commanding Officers concerned and they are herewith forwarded to you for information and any action you may deem necessary.
- 2.- The C.O. and Q. staff of 4 CAR feel that it is a false economy to have only a 25% reserve of boots at CAR for exchange purposes. They feel that they should have, at least, 60% reserve; above they feel that the position will not be really satisfactory until every man has a second pair.
- 3.- The second point is that they require PT shorts and PT shoes for physical training. They feel that it is insanitary to use the same K.D. shorts for training, PT, and walking out. At the same time they must be laundered occasionally.
- 4.- They have also requested camouflaged helmet covers for training purposes.

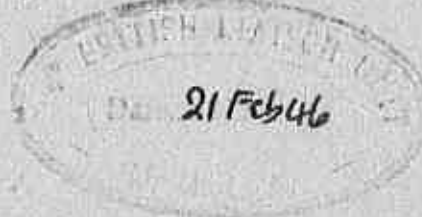


