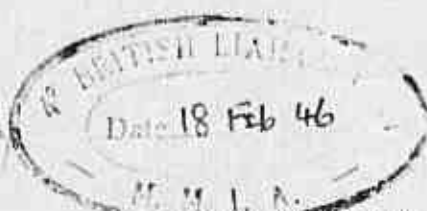

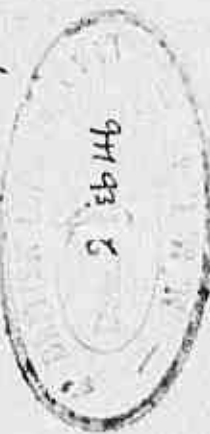

If, after full consideration, Commanding officers find it necessary in the interests of military efficiency, to promote individuals who do not come within the terms of para 4 of GRO 1336/45, they may promote up to and including the rank of sergeant without reference to GHQ 2nd Echelon. Normally promotion should not be given to individuals with less than 2 months to serve with their unit. Acting ranks thus granted will be subject to reversion in the event of suitable War Substantive NCOs becoming available on X(IV) list and being posted in by GHQ 2nd Echelon.

LIAP etc in answer to queries as to when promotion considered essential (.)
It is considered that cases where promotion of offr or soldier in
replacement of a leave casualty is essential are extremely rare and never
unless absentee offr or soldier will be away for more than 61 consecutive
days (.) Although it may be alleged that the man doing the work should get
the pay it is considered that offr and soldiers who have rendered good service
should wherever possible be able to take their leave on full pay including
command and staff pay in their present rank (.) As the absentee offr remains
on strength there can be no claim under ACI 1498 of 1941 (.)
