With reference to S/C RMBE 7 EOU letter EML/56/7 of 3 August 1946 addressed to A.D.O.S. M.H.I.A. MIA copy to you.

1. I disagree entirely with this letter for the following reasons:

(a) British practice in siting a B.O.D. has nothing at all to do with the proximity or otherwise of a base workshops; the main factors which I have been taught are: good road and rail communications, near to manufacturing centres (if based in lone country); good for expansion, good water supply, and able to be quickly garrisoned. (Vide Ord Manual par and RAGS). The fact that a B.O.D. is often near a base workshops is that the workshops I presume are sited in the same manner.

(b) I cannot see what the repair of 4th line assemblies has to do with the B.O.D., if the Base Outlying Stores section is capable of commanding and holding the stores it requires 46052000. It is only concerned with the supply of these stores to the stores section in bulk.

(c) Even if the scaling of the 60 days maintenance pack is small it surely would be better if it was issued to the Divisions for whom it was intended, instead of being kept in O.A.S.D. at Bologna.

(d) Whilst I agree with S/C RMBE that the depot would not function 100 per cent efficient in a week, I still maintain that issues could begin in one week if Ord could be given the chance to go ahead with the work.



(a) I cannot see what the repair of 4th line assemblies has to do with the B.O.D., if the Base Workshop Stores section is unable of generating and holding the stores it requires **480 B.O.D.** is only concerned with the supply of these stores to the stores section in bulk.

(c) Even if the scaling of the 60 days maintenance pack is small it surely would be better if it was issued to the Divisions for whom it was intended, instead of being kept in C.A.S.E. at Bologna.

(d) Whilst I agree with S/C RME that the depot would not function 100 per cent efficient in a week, I still maintain that it is and could begin in one week if Ord could be given the chance to go ahead with the work.

(e) No purpose could be served by a joint Ord and RME meeting, surely we do not call for a meeting when RME policy is involved.

With reference to your ME/20/73 dated 26 July 46 and 4 B.L.U. letter ref. 4/GR/7 undated.

1. In view of our ME/56/3 dated 20 July 46 informing you of the closing down of No. 2 CSM Depot - MODENA, para 1 of your above letter is no longer applicable as this Depot requires very little repair work, also the advantages due to the proximity of a Milan Depot to North Italian Industries is in our opinion outweighed by the technical experience, Test work and quality control facilities available in a Base W/Shop.

2. It has always been British practice to site M.T. Stores Depot reasonably close to Base W/shops and as in the Italian Army the necessary technical experience and knowledge of 4th Line repair of vehicles and repair of Major Assembly does not exist in either the Technical Coordinating Section or in any of the Divs it is obvious that this responsibility will eventually involve on the C.A.R.E.

All these points would appear to favour the choice of the MODENA Depot which is Italian Military owned property and its taking over for the purpose of M.T. Stores Depot should therefore present no difficulties.

3. Our suggestion re the establishment of a C.O.P.P. for the initial period would appear to be in agreement with the 4 B.L.U. letter and was based on the assumption that a Base Depot would require considerable organisation and the preservation of a W.R. and we consider that the expansion of the "Legnano" C.O.P.P. into a C.O.P.P. would provide immediate facilities for receipt and issue of M.T. Spares received either from Local Manufacture or ex-Allied stocks.

4. With reference to para 3 of your letter, the points referred to in our ME/56/4 dated 24 July were intended as a suggested procedure and although it is agreed that the organisation of Base Depots is an RACC responsibility this surely does not prohibit suggestions being made particularly as in the Italian Army RACC, RMB and RASC function as one Corps and the eventual organisation of the M.T. Stores Depot would have considerable effect on the C.A.R.E. and the Base Overhaul Programme.

It is suggested that the advantages of the locations proposed by us will possibly be

Stores Depot would have considerable effect on the C.A.R.S. and the Base Overhaul Programme.

The actual advantages of the locations proposed by us will possibly be more apparent from the attached sketch in which the various divisional Armes and industrial concentration are approximately indicated.

5. With reference the 4 B.I.U. letter sub-heading "General" it is most unlikely that the proposed MODMA Depot would be able to issue in one week and although standard racking could be manufactured by the Turin Arsenal its installation will require some considerable time and the initial requirements of a C.O.F.P. is once again obvious.

6. Reference to the 60 days maintenance pack is ineffectual as it is well known that the total quantity and type of Stores involved represent only a fraction of Divisional requirements and do not include Major Assemblies which are responsible for approx. 80% of the Divisional V.O.R. figures.

7. In view of the above it is considered by this HQ. that a joint CPO and MOD meeting should be held in B.L.O.C.M.A to enable a decision to be arrived at and also the question of financial authority for Local Contracts given priority as locations and suggestion without the facilities for manufacture are worthless

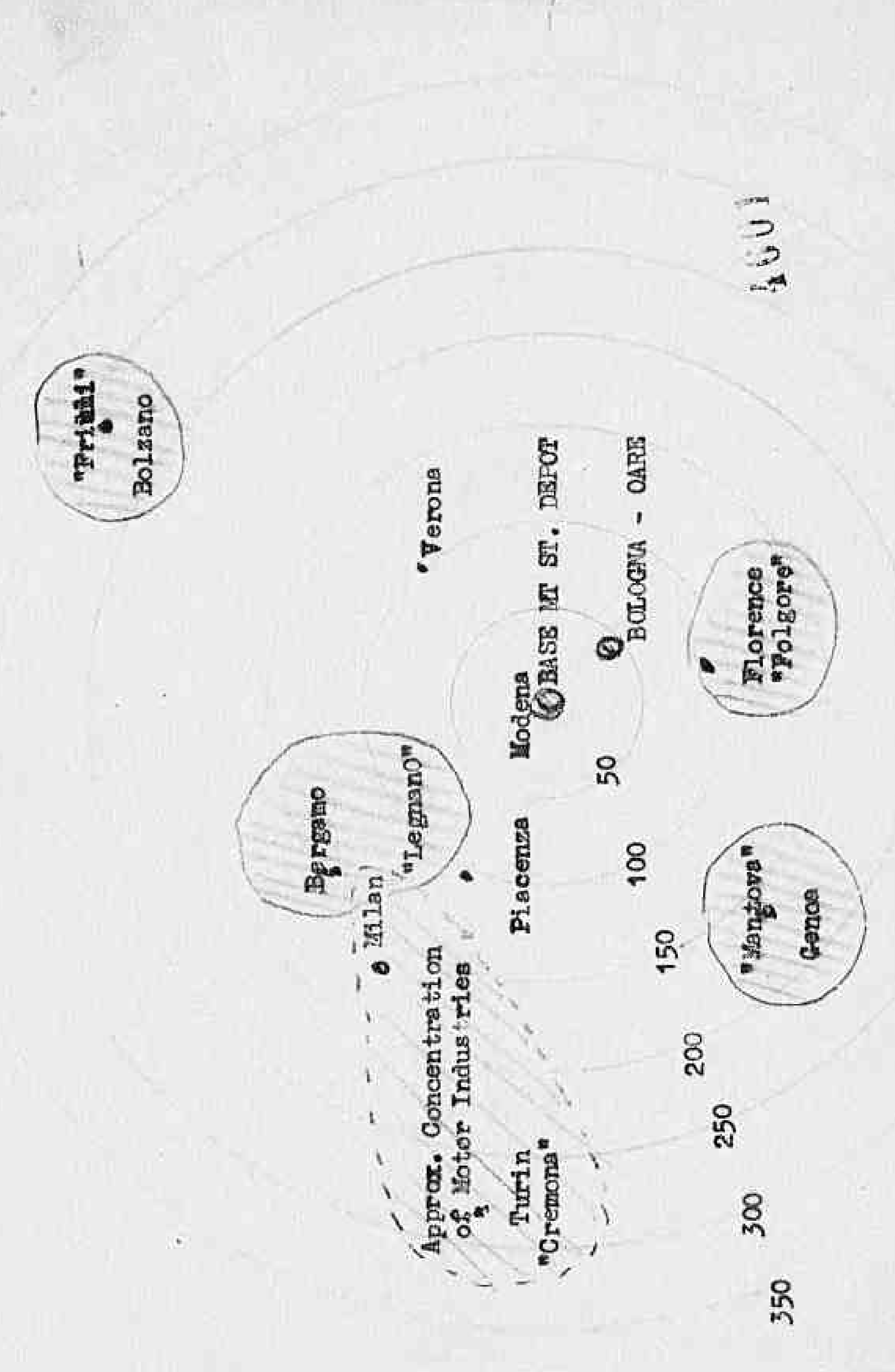

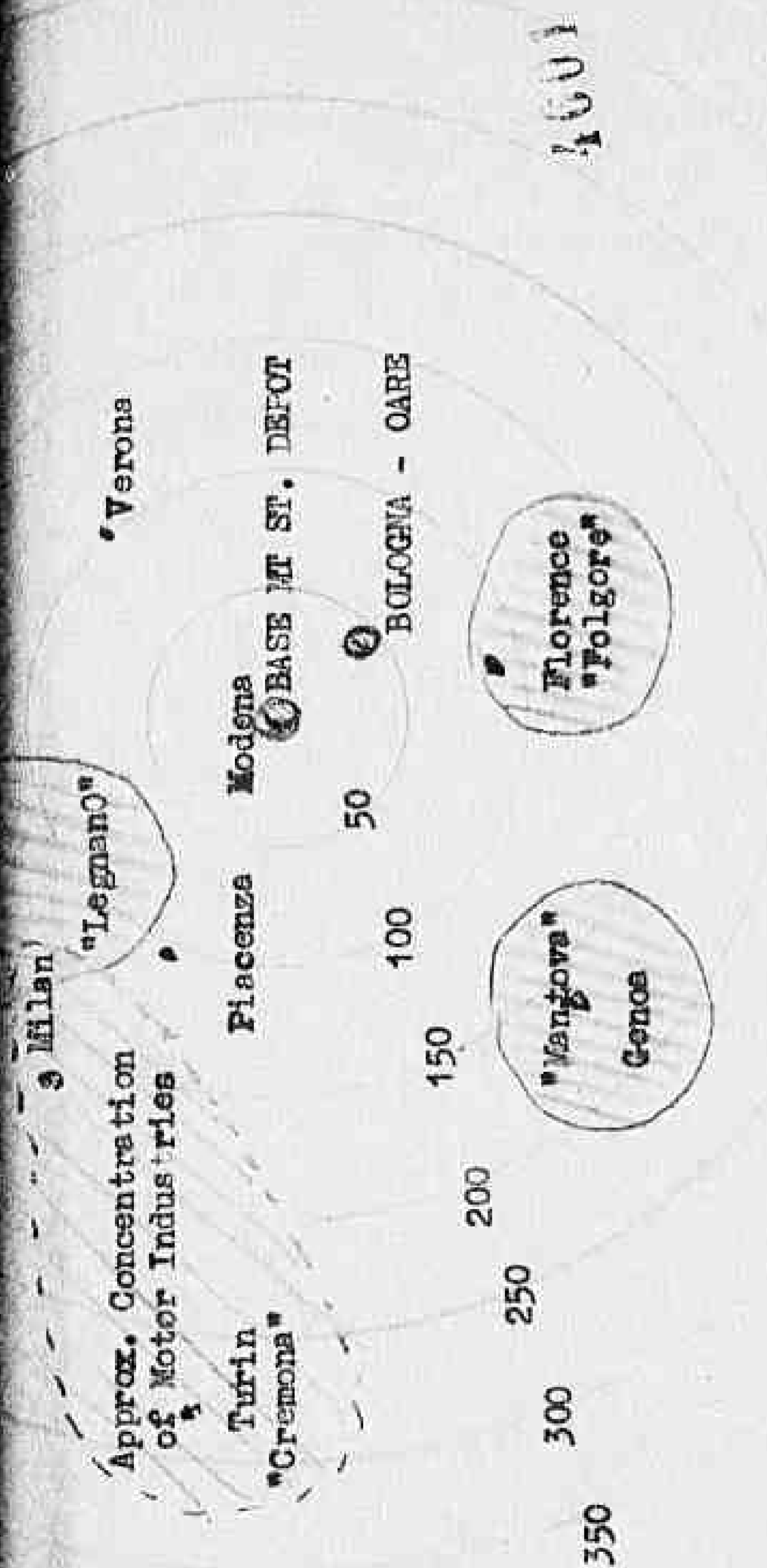

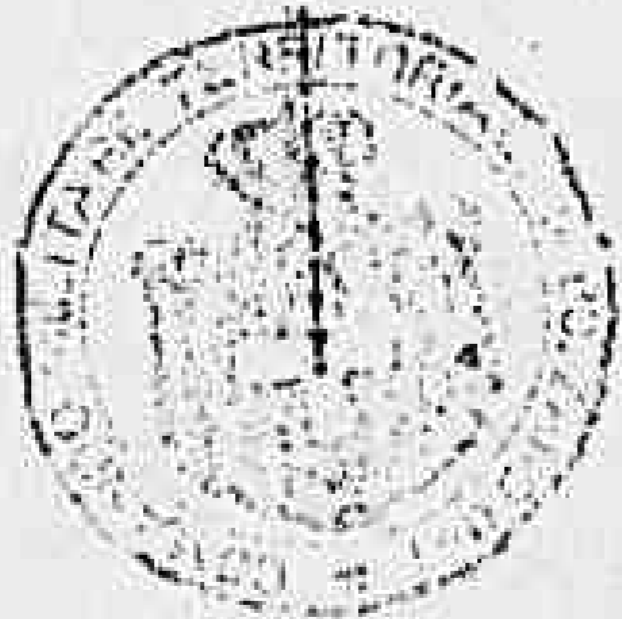

There is no improvement in the supply of M.T. spares, no instructions have yet been received from Ministry of War on the procedure to be adopted by formations to obtain M.T. spares, the result is that now all Infantry Divisions are attempting to buy spares a costly and unsatisfactory procedure. Is it at all possible to hasten Ministry of War to lay down a set procedure to be adopted by Divisions when they require spare parts.

Ministry of War have not yet given permission to occupy the barracks at Monza which is required for use as a Technical stores Depot, if permission could be given soon most of the difficulties re supply of stores could be smoothed out, as the Italians could lay directives re supply of stores from the Depot.

Great difficulty is still being

experienced in keeping the transport of the Infantry Divisions on the road, owing to the complete lack of M.T. spare parts. It is hoped that the 60 days maintenance pack, at present held at Bolzano, will soon be issued to an Italian Stores Depot from where it can be distributed, it is emphasised that if the Infantry Divisions do not get some M.T. spares very soon their transport will be entirely off the road.

Wireless and Artillery spares seem to be still in fairly good supply from the Div. O.F.Ps, this stock is not such a long time however unless a source of supply to the O.F.Ps is found, at present they are existing on stocks provided before 15 November 1945.

Small Arm spares are required, these are also included in the 60 days maintenance pack, and as the retailers cannot replace 2HR small arms at the moment, it is vital that those they have be kept in a good state of repair. Flanellette is another item that is urgently required.

Armourers tools are required by 4 C.A.R., they have no tools at all for the repair of small arms, this fact has already been reported to M.M.I.A. by G.S.O. 1 of this F.L.U., also if the Territorial Regiment is to be equipped with British Arms, they will require armourers tools and a ceiling of spare parts for small arms.

Stores Depot at Bologna.

1. The building allotted for use as the stores depot at Bologna is at the present unfit for use owing to extensive bomb damage, it is estimated that three weeks will be needed to complete repairs if the GenCo start work on it at once. Could you please obtain a priority for this work.

2. The building is not very suitable for a depot, being a three storied barracks with a basement, a plan of it is being drawn and I will forward it with my next letter.

3. There are at present 4 Italian Captains and 2 NCO's, detailed for duty at this depot, but of course they can do nothing until the building is repaired and tools are obtained and an office set up. Would it be possible to send the Italian Captain to Logistics Division O.P.F. for training whilst these repairs are being done?

4. A much more efficient depot would be made if Roney Huts could be obtained, I estimate that 9 would be sufficient. Is there any chance of getting these, if so the depot could commence work much sooner than will be possible if building is to be repaired.

5. From conversations I have had with Capt. Nelson I gather that the best idea is to incorporate the Ordnance aids of the Italian Army in with the GenCo. This is of course dead against instructions re the training of the Italian Army, and will not work. HALL seems to be going ahead arranging local purchase of A.L. spares, and having all stores released to the Italian Army passed to the GenCo workshops at Bologna. Examples are the 60 days maintenance pack which has been placed in the workshops stores section and the 1000 tyres released from 57 I.C.D. which are also under control of workshops. Would it be possible to have a building from the building list

3. There are at present 4 Italian Captains and 2 WO's, detailed for duty at this depot, but of course they can do nothing until the building is repaired and rooms are obtained and an office set up. Would it be possible to send the Italian Captains to Legation Division C.F.F. for training while these repairs are being done?

4. A much more efficient depot would be made if Romney Huts could be obtained; I estimate that 5 would be sufficient. Is there any chance of getting these, if so the depot could commence work much sooner than will be possible if building is to be repaired.

5. From conversations I have had with Capt. Meloni I gather that the plan is to incorporate the Ordnance side of the Italian Army in with the I.A. This is of course done against instructions to the training of the Italian Army, and will not work. I am seen to be going ahead arranging local purchase of M.T. spares, and having all stores released to the Italian Army issued to the Ordnance workshops at Bologna. Examples are the 60 days maintenance pack which has been placed in the workshops stores section and the 1000 tyres released from I.A. stores which are also under control of workshops. Could it be possible to have a ruling from the beginning that

- (1) Ordnance and only Ordnance are responsible for the supply, distribution and storage of I.A. stores in the Italian Army;
- (2) the Italians which we are now training will be entirely separate from workshops and under no supervision by workshops;
- (3) local purchase to be done on the Ordnance system, at the moment the local purchase system is very bad, and purchases are being made without reference to stores actually in stock and without regard to intelligent provision.

Would you please take up the matter of I.A., as of course it has nothing to do with us except as a channel from which I can obtain stores when the depot is functioning, but I think I.A. should be a branch of the depot provision branch and not entirely under I.A. as at present.

30 Days Maintenance Pack.

6. This has been expected and placed in racks in the workshops stores section, no accounting action has been taken, as a matter of fact the No. 3 copies of the vouchers have been ~~issued~~ with the stores. Owing to the fact that the stores have been unissued, the work will be more difficult, as in some cases the stores have now no vouchers. No system of issuing has yet been done and the fact is that no one knows what actually is there, or where anything is. I wish to emphasize that the workshops stores section have done the best they could under the circumstances, they have



as far as possible blind stores by types of vehicles, but it is a great pity that Ord could not have supervised this work from the start. I estimate that to get the stores section functioning efficiently will now take 2 months. I will do my best to do it sooner, but the difficulties are great.

7. Is it possible for Dept. of the Interior to be transferred to belong to work with us, or even some there on loan. This matter is of great importance, as the sooner he arrives the sooner the work can commence.

8. Would you please inform me of your policy as regards to this maintenance part; does not to do the dividing of it, of course, but if you agree, my team would do so face against Indians as well when the stores are received and not to even build allotments to Divisions and companies. The great pity is that it is proposed in workshops 5/8 as it is in a way very much more. If you agree to have an out system established of the above, can I start then making divisions for location in order that the Dept. Division office can be set up and an idea obtained of our limitations and needs. This is important for local purchase etc.

9. In conclusion I can advise that to get this done and stores section functioning properly I will be very unpopular in many circles, but I will do my best to get it done. I will either do this job on Ord lines or not as you see. What if you can give to have control in any way of stores, I respectfully ask to be sent, as it is entirely impossible to work on these lines.

1. The disposal of M.T. spare parts at the LAIVES depot and neighbouring C.E. S. dumps near Bolzano has been placed in the hands of the Allied Commission, War Material Disposal Sub Commission.

2. It is the intention that these stores shall be handed over to the Italian Government, who is to decide as to their allocation between the Army and the civilian industry. Your claim that a considerable proportion of the contents of the LAIVES depot are of military origin is noted and your proposal to negotiate a satisfactory allocation to the Army with A.R.A.K. is fully approved.

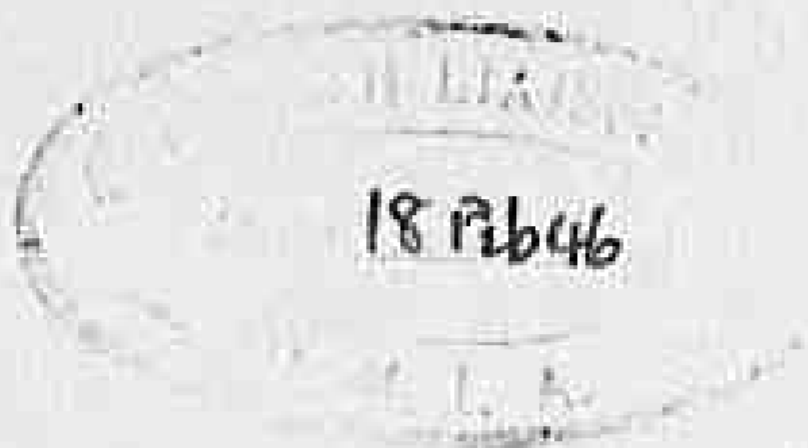

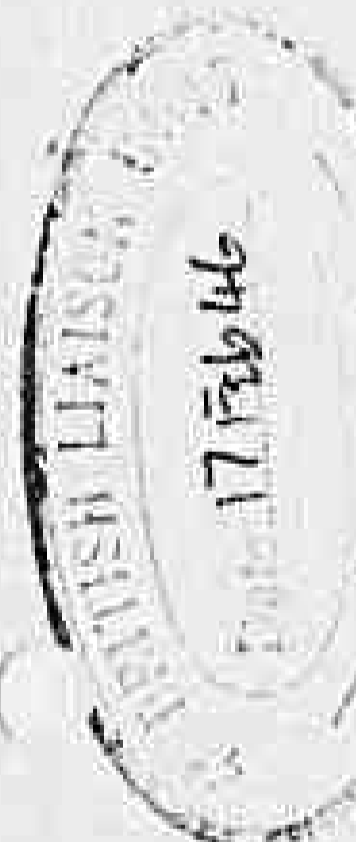

1. The Italian War Ministry is now solely responsible for the supply of all Ord Stores, AF Spares, Signal Stores, Gun parts etc., and the method of indenting, system of supply etc has been laid down in directives issued by the Ministry of War to all Terr. Commands.
2. With a view to enabling the Ministry of War to maintain such British Equipments and Vehicles as are in possession of the Italian Army at present, AFHQ have instructed 557 British Ord Depot, NAPLES, to select and prepare for issue a 60 day Maintenance pack of all available AF spares and connected Gun spares etc for all Vehicles and Equipments reported as being in possession of the Italian Army. This instruction was issued to 557 B.O.D. on 14th January 1946 and the Depot is acting on it immediately.
3. It will necessarily take some time before the Maintenance pack reaches the issuing stage from the Italian Depots and British Vehicles will be going off the road at an alarming rate. At the same time however, the War Ministry are in the process of transferring to BOLSON, U/S vehicles for repair and cannibalisation on a small scale, and some spares are becoming available already from this source.

Munitions requests have, from time to time, been made to AFHQ for permission to continue submitting indents for Ord Stores on the system containing prior to Nov 15th, but such requests have been

At the same time however, the War Ministry are in the process of transferring to BOLOGNA U/S vehicles for repair and cannibalisation on a small scale, and some spares are becoming available already from this source.

Numerous requests have, from time to time, been made to IAHQ for permission to continue submitting indents for Ord Stores on the system containing prior to Nov 15th, but such requests have been turned down.

Whilst it is regretted that there is no source of supply from which vehicles etc can be maintained and kept on the road, it is emphasised that strong measures must be taken to ensure that when vehicles do become V.O.R. they are not tampered with nor cannibalised, pending receipt of spares etc from the 60 days Maintenance Pack.

In conclusion it is pointed out that

(a) the method of obtaining ordnance stores is by indent from unit to Territorial HQ, who either meets the demand from stocks under their administration or passes the demand to the Ministry of War.

(b) Items of clothing, boots and personal equipment are in reasonable supply, whilst MF spares, Gun parts etc at the present are practically non-existent, although it is expected that the position will improve in the near future.

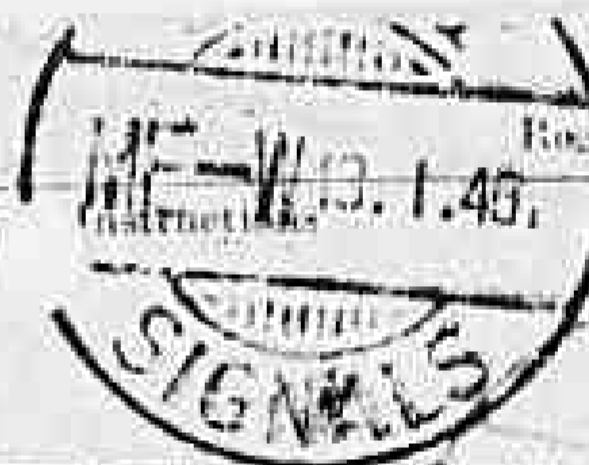

Approval has been obtained by M.M.I.A. for the temporary retention of the R.M.M.B. training increment. In addition it is anticipated that British Ordnance Officers will be attached to the B.L.U.'s concerned, who will continue to give what assistance is possible.
4. Further instructions will be issued to the B.L.U.'s as soon as a decision on this subject is reached by Higher authority.

With reference to Land Forces Sub Commission (M.M.I.A.) Directive No. 2 dated 16th May 45 the following notes on Ordnance procedure are issued for guidance.

1. "B" Type B.L.U.'s requiring technical information or advice on Ordnance matters should obtain same from the Ordnance Officer or Ord W.O. of their parent B.L.U.

At present an Ord Warrant Officer is on the strength of a Type "A" B.L.U. and it is hoped that an Ordnance Officer will be attached in the near future to No. 1, 3 and 6 B.L.U.'s.

2. Clothing and/or Equipment Depots are maintained under the Ministry of War at the places shown in appendix "A" and these should be frequently visited by the Ordnance Officer or O.W.O. of the B.L.U., and periodical reports on the progress at appendix "B" submitted to ADOS M.M.I.A.

3. The Ordnance Officer or W.O. will assist in an advisory capacity in:

- (a) - Selection of sites for dumps;
- (b) - Method of storing different types of Stores;
- (c) - Repair;
- (d) - Maintenance;
- (e) - Accounting;

and in introducing a simple "Bin Card" System, so that each article handled may be readily identifiable by name in both English and Italian.

4. He should at all times be conversant with the W.O.s of Units in his territorial Command in order to be able to advise on either the increase or decrease of certain items from time to time as considered necessary, in the interests of economy and the needs of the Italian Army as a whole.

Any tendency to "hoard" stores in Unit or Sub Depot will be strongly discouraged and if necessary specific examples brought to the notice of the Territorial Headquarters concerned.

5. On matters of policy or change of system H.Q. M.M. ~~424~~ ⁴²⁴ invariably be kept informed, the Ordnance Officer, or O.W.O. reporting ~~to the~~ ^{to the} ~~Depot~~ ^{Depot} in accordance to AIOS HQ. M.M.I.I.

6. The position regarding the supply of spares for British M.A. and other Warlike stores is at present being discussed.

For the time being, the system ruling prior to Nov 1944 will remain in force. It is proposed that the Lilies will hand over to the Italian Government in the near future a bulk allotment of spares. It is the intention that these shall be handled at No. 6 M.F. Spares Depot at Bologna.

Further instructions on this matter will be issued when the ~~final~~ ^{final} decision has been reached.

7. Spares for Italian M.T. are handled by the Repairs organisation of the Italian Army. Stocks are held at No. 3 M.T. Spares Depot at Piacenza and No. 8 M.T. Spares Depot Rome. Issues are made to Repairs Units only, against fortnightly demands made by them through their Territorial Repairs Director.

Tyres for Italian Army M.T. are in very short supply. Issues are controlled by the War Ministry and effected only through Repairs Units.

8. The question of spares has also been raised in R.E.M.E. Directive No. 1, para 4, and close liaison with E.M.E.'s on this subject will be necessary.
