1.- The problem of accommodation for Italian troops in the province of Bolzano is acute, particularly in view of the oncoming winter season. Briefly the situation is as follows:

- (a) Territorial HQ No 4 is located at Bolzano and has suitable accn.
- (b) N. 505 guard Bn is distributed as under, the gen. in most cases being schools:

One Coy Trento
One Coy Verona

HQ & Two Coys Bolzano

- (c) N. 509 guard Bn (in process of formation) will require accn. in the Verona area, when the Coy of 505 Bn at present at Verona will move to Bolzano.

- (d) A third guard Bn is due to be formed to complete the Internal Security Bde, and this together with Bde HQ. will require accn. in the Trento area.

(Bde HQ at present Verona)

- (e) Commissariat Services are already catered for.

- (f) The MIGRONS Bn at Bolzano are required as work-shops, and is the only suitable accn for this purpose. The Barracks are at present occupied by an American Service Regt, who will be moving ^{out} before the workshops move up from Southern Italy.

(c) N. 509 guard Bn (in process of formation) will require soon. In the Verona area, when the Coy of 505 Bn at present at Verona will move to Bolzano no.

(e) Commissariat Services are already entered for.

(f) The MICHIONE Bde at Bolzano are required as work-shops, and is the only suitable soon for this purpose. The Barracks are at present occupied by an American Service Regt, who will be moving ^{out} before the workshops move up from Southern Italy.

(g) The two Combat Groups in the area (Friuli and Feltre) are already suitably accommodated.

(h) The Italian General Hosp is at present occupying unsuitable soon in the Verona area, the two soon being 10 miles apart. It is desired to take over the SANTO SPIRITO Hospital at Verona, which is the only suitable place. This also is occupied by the Americans.

(i) Carabinieri throughout the area have adequate soon.

2.- American units in Bolzano province have occupied nearly all the undamaged buildings. These units are in the process of moving out, or at any rate, thinning down, but although their numbers are decreasing, they continue to occupy the same amount of soon.

3.- It is requested that this matter be taken up by 217 Area and an equitable distribution of available soon made.

3.- Ammunition Dumps and Artillery Materiel.

(a) A large number of ammunition dumps in the BOLZANO area are in a dangerous state, and explosions may occur with the advent of frost.

From time to time the Italian Artillery Directorate have asked permission to be allowed to enter these dumps and sort out their ammunition and explode it. Para 3(f) of the AMHQ letter quoted in Para 1 above, lays down the procedure, and it is requested that early steps are taken to dispose of these dumps, which constitute a danger to life and property.

(b) There are some fixed artillery installations in the mountains round BOLZANO, MESSANON, etc. These in some cases contain weapons, which will be ruined during

1. As you know, all materials captured from the Germans or acquired as a result of the Germans' surrender in the North are classified as captured enemy material, regardless of whether it is of German or Italian origin or its original ownership, and under AFHQ instructions are under control of the Allied Military Commander in the Area. Certain of these materials are used for Allied purposes, and certain materials become available to the Italian Army on authority of the District Commander.
2. A large amount of captured enemy material has already been allotted to the Italian Army, and has been recovered through the efforts of the Recovery Commissions and MMIA. This runs into thousands of tons of motor vehicle material, clothing and other items. However, the material must be released by the Districts after the Allied requirements have been met, and this obviously requires that the Districts first inventory the material in the dumps to ascertain what is there. Once this has been done, then MMIA makes every effort to secure the material which can be used by the Italian Army.
3. It is suggested that you direct your Territorial Commanders to report to the MMIA LO on the spot the availability of any material known to them which has not been released to the Italian Army in order that the MMIA LO may secure release from the District Commander and also that your Territorial Commander be instructed to recover such material as is in the hands of civilians without fear of favor.

Each Admin Div/Regt will have its own dump (holdings to be on an approved scale). Surplus stocks from Admin depots now closing down will be transferred to the new depot at Florence.
5. It is probable that as soon as this organisation is working, M.M.I.A. will be required to recommend a further reduction.

The following instructions are issued in amplification of para 9 of this HQ Adm Instr No. 35 dated 23 Oct 45.

1. DEFINITION.

The word "dump" below refers to any collection of CEM other than a central Depot formed by this HQ. The word "Depot" refers to a depot formed by this HQ especially to contain CEM.

2. POLICY.

- (a) It will be the responsibility of Areas and Sub Areas to organize the work on CEM dumps so that CEM can be made ready for handing over to the Italian Government in accordance with a definite plan and with a minimum delay.
- (b) The quickest and best method of handing over is to hand over the dump complete, all stores of military value having been previously removed.
- (c) Where this is not practicable, stores for release to Italian Government will be earmarked on a limited and prepared for removal by the Italian Government agency.

3. FUNCTION OF UMLIT.

A civil organization known as UMLIT has been authorized by the Italian Government to act on their behalf in the collection, acceptance and disposal of CEM. This organization is responsible for providing the necessary guards and storemen for the dumps taken over and for the necessary transport and labour to remove stores that have been released. An UMLIT Liaison Officer will be attached to Area and Sub Area Hqs.

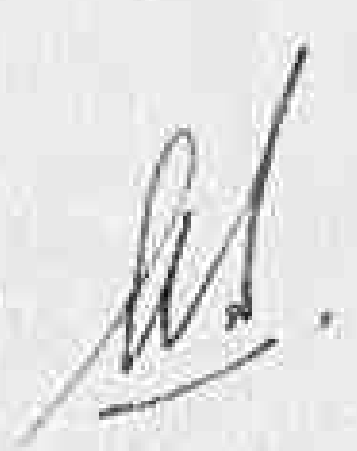

1. The question of release of CMI of It. military origin in this area back to the It. army has now reached the stage when considerable clarification should be made as to what materials, if any, are to be returned to the It. army.

2. At the present moment the only released materials are those which are specifically asked for from 2 District to meet immediate needs of troops in this area, (and these in most cases are helved) if one is in this before these are released, and two released from AFMA, both of reference in 205... dated 7 Oct. Of these one has been agreed to by AFMA and the other is awaiting decision.

3. The present situation is as follows:-

1. CMI is being controlled by (a) CMI 20 established by 2 District and (b) War Materials Disposal S.C.

(a) The two CMI 20s now operating in this area are now collecting all materials from the various dumps into central General Stores Depots. They receive instructions from 2 District and know nothing about handling over anything to the It. army. They have a considerable amount of clothing, mess bins and some equipment, equipment remaining, signal

materials, all of It. military origin and class-

wares. Has secondary interest in military stores and equipment and clothing but for reasons connected with the ultimate disposal of CMA this interest may be disregarded. "

(2) District Directive based on AFHQ policy letter A0385.3 (42)-0 dated 2 Oct. " Disposal of CMA in Mediterranean Theatre. " Para 8 (c) states " Recaptured material of it. origin which is not required for military purposes, including maintenance of P.O.V. will be turned over immediately to the it. military authorities. "

At the present moment it would appear that all material of it. origin is required for maintenance of P.O.V. "

(b) War Material Disposal P.C. section.

This section has several large dumps which hold considerable quantities of it. stores mostly clothing. "

No releases are made except on specific authority from AFHQ. "

No releases have been authorized by AFHQ; noted in para 2 above but there are still further quantities available AFHQ should be requested to release all these remaining quantities as otherwise these will eventually fall into civilian hands; releases being made from these dumps irrespective of origin. "

There is also a question of Commissions which needs to be solved. "

At the present moment it would appear that the origin is required for maintenance of W.O.T.

(b) War Material Disposal S.C. section.

This section has several large dumps which hold considerable quantities of it, stores mostly clothing.

No releases are made except on specific authority from AFHQ.

Two releases have been authorized by AFHQ, listed in para 2 above but there are still further quantities available AFHQ should be requested to release all these remaining quantities as otherwise these will eventually fall into civilian hands; releases being made from these dumps irrespective of origin.

There is also a question of Commissions which needs to be solved.

A few days ago Gen. DILLING turned up with 1 COMR officer and one civilian rep from it. State says as being a "Commission" appointed by L of P for recovery and disposal of all materials of it, origin from COM dumps.

The exact scope of this "Commission" is not understood. Furthermore to-day a further "Commission" arrived made up of two civilians who bore with them the original **6278** attached letter. These persons stated they would decide what would be given back to the Army.

On my recent visit to LIA I was clearly given to understand by Col. KERR that ALL stores of it, military origin would be handed back to the Lt. Army.

As things stand at present the Lt. Army will not get any stores back except for a very few already authorized releases. My further requests to 2 District for releases of materials as laid down in this letter 2/3/10 dated 3 Oct.

will now reach me at a time when the materials in question will already have been cleared from the dump and disposed of.

6. It is therefore essential for me to have a clean-cut policy on CEM of military origin and its handover to the It. military authorities.

The easiest and less complicated solution would be for all It. military stores to be handed back direct to the Terr. H.Q., who will keep H.Q. informed, through myself who is in constant touch with the appropriate authorities. Any special items required for maintenance of P.O.M. could always be excluded.

ADMINISTRATIVE MEMORANDUM NUMBER 48

2 November 1945

1 -- ACCOMMODATION FOR ITALIAN ARMED FORCES

1. The bulk of the Italian Army is shortly to be returned to the control of the Italian Government, when it will become responsible for the preservation of law and order over the mainland of ITALY (with certain exceptions) and the islands of SICILY and SARDINIA. In these circumstances it is logical that the Italian War Ministry should be able to locate Italian units from an operational point of view.

2. a. Formation, District, and US major commands will therefore insure that Italian Commanders are given assistance in finding suitable accommodation in the areas required for their troops.

b. Urgent consideration will also be given to releasing to the Italian authorities barracks and other Italian military accommodation which may be in Allied occupation.

c. Any cases where release of accommodation to the Italian Army would be detrimental to the living conditions, morale, or administration of the Allied forces, will be referred for the personal decision of the Commanders of XIII Corps, 2 District, 3 District, PAAC, or US major command, as applicable, for a decision.

d. In all other cases barracks or Italian military accommodation required by the Italian Armed Forces will be returned to the Italian authorities as rapidly as possible.

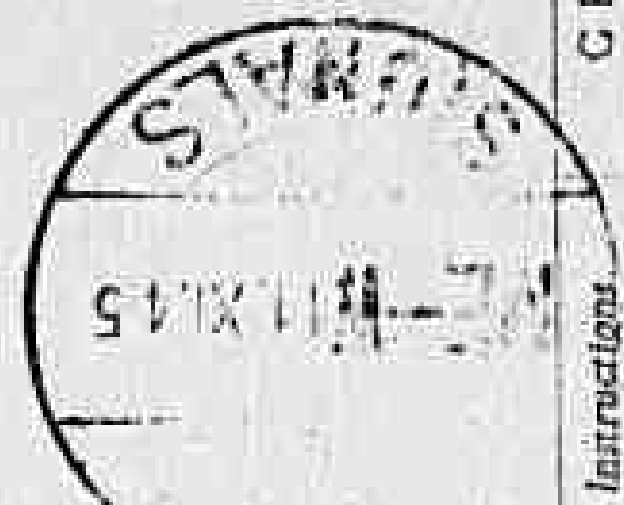

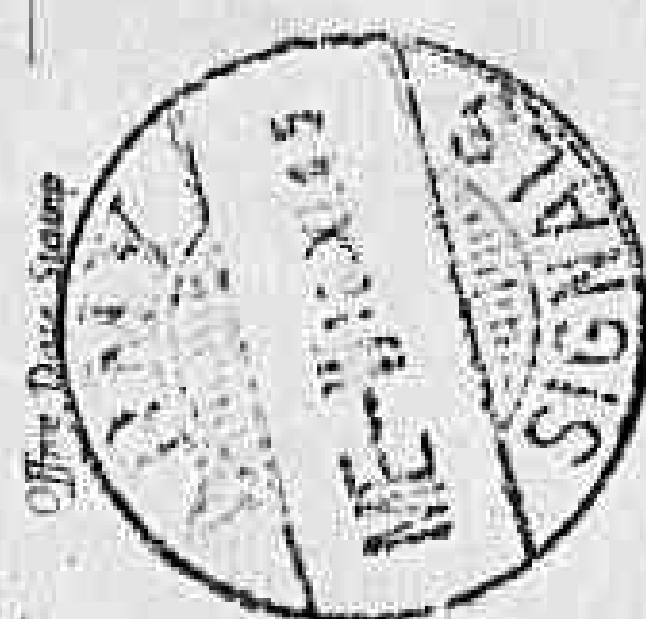
