9. Recommendations will be for state courses only, and recommendations submitted when selection for the reserve courses will be recommended.
10. The National Service and National Army colleges under command are covered by these instructions. Allied and Dominion Colonies are being reviewed separately in subject instructions.

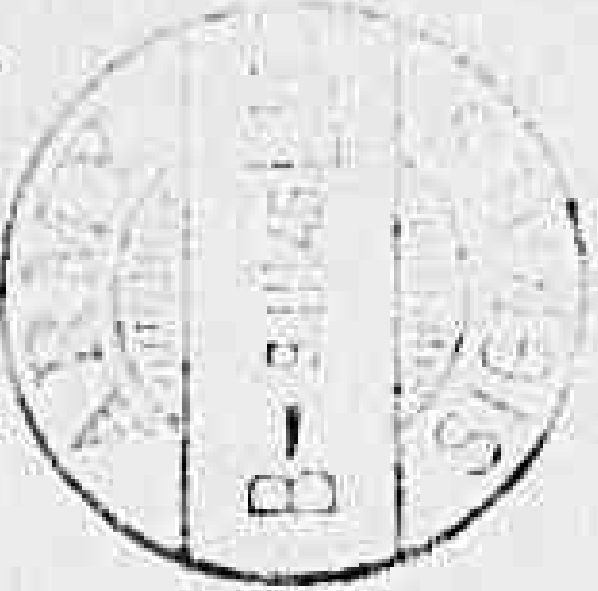

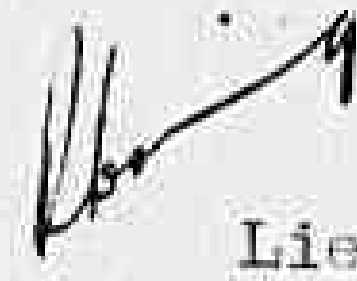

1. Deputy Assistant Provost Marshall (DAPM)

A course of instruction for the Carabinieri of the Gruppo Legnano has started to-day under the direction of British Provost Personnel, but is already handicapped by the non-existence of any officer on the HQ of the Gruppo, to correspond to the DAPM of a Division.

Within the Gruppo there are two sections of Carabinieri (approx 50 each = total 100) each of which is commanded by a Lieut. In the past, all these Carabinieri have acted solely in the capacity of military "police", but now, to conform to our British organization, a small proportion of these (approx 15 Carabinieri) have been detailed to form a PS Section under the "I" Branch. It is intended ultimately, however, to form a PS Section on the British model, which is to be known as the "Sezione di Sicurezza Militare" which will be entirely dependant of the Carabinieri.

The commander of the Carabinieri (the senior of the two see cards) comes under the direct orders of the Capo di Sezione 1(b) on the Gruppo HQ Staff who is the nearest equivalent to a DAPM. This officer, however, is already overburdened with other essential work on the Gruppo staff, as in addition to the normal duties of a DAPM, he has the supply problem of the Gruppo to deal with.

The questions of traffic control, route-marking, maintenance of MT discipline and reduction of speed, are of vital importance to a Gruppo since its present establishment of vehicles is far in excess of what it has been accustomed to: it is considered essential therefore, that the staff of the Gruppo HQ be increased by the equivalent of a DAPM who will co-ordinate the duties of the Carabinieri; and unless this is done it is felt that the Carabinieri have little hope of fulfilling their amended role.

2. Second-in-Command of a Battalion.

In the ML (Organico) of a Gruppo, no provision is made for a 2 i/c of a Bn: this has resulted in a complete lack of decentralisation, and in consequence there is now no-one fitted to assume command in the event of a Bn Comd becoming a casualty. It is not necessary to further enlarge upon the desirability of such an appointment, for this must be obvious to anyone with battle experience in a British unit in this war. There are 6 Bns in the Gruppo and this would entail therefore, an increase only of 6 officers. Not only is it essential that a 2 i/c be authorised for each Bn, but it is essential also that they be

overburdened with other essential work on the Gruppo staff, as in addition to the normal duties of a DAMMIG, he has the supply problem of the Gruppo to deal with.

The questions of traffic control, route-marking, maintenance of MT discipline and reduction of speed, are of vital importance to a Gruppo since its present establishment of vehicles is far in excess of what it has been accustomed to: it is considered essential therefore, that the staff of the Gruppo HQ be increased by the equivalent of a DAMM who will co-ordinate the duties of the Carabinieri; and unless this is done it is felt that the Carabinieri have little hope of fulfilling their enlarged role.

2. Second-in-Command of a Battalion.

In the WE (Organico) of a Gruppo, no provision is made for a 2 i/c of a Bn: this has resulted in a complete lack of decentralisation, and in consequence there is now no-one fitted to assume command in the event of a Bn Comd becoming a casualty. It is not necessary to further enlarge upon the desirability of such an appointment, for this must be obvious to anyone with battle experience in a British unit in this war. There are 6 Bns in the Gruppo and this would entail therefore, an increase only of 6 officers. Not only is it essential that a 2 i/c be authorised for each Bn, but it is essential also that they be appointed within the course of the next few days, so that they are available to take part in the final training of the Gruppo in exercises on a higher level.

3. I am new to the intricacies of Gruppi but I understand that both these points have been raised by the HMUs of other Gruppi on previous occasions - apparently however, without results. These matters are now pressing: the total increase amounts only to 7 officers for Gruppo (1 DAMM and 6 - 2 i/cs). Unless some immediate action is taken forthwith to remedy these ills, it may be too late, and to further delay a decision can only result in ultimate disaster.

Qualifications.

(a) Officers recommended for appointment to field formations.

(i) A.C. Officers will be over 25 and under 35 on 1 July immediately preceding the course. In exceptional circumstances, which must be fully explained when the recommendation is made, officers outside these limits may be recommended.

(ii) Medical Category. All officers must be medical category 'A', or if of a lower category, must be considered likely to be reclassified 'A' before the end of the course. Should an officer be relegated to a category lower than 'A' after submission of his recommendation, notification will be sent to the authority responsible for his selection, together with a medical certificate stating the probable date that the officer is likely to be reclassified 'A'. If the officer is unlikely to be reclassified 'A' before the end of the course, he will be considered for an appointment in a HQ other than that of a field formation.

(iii) Regimental experience. Officers recommended must have had at least one year's service with a unit.

(iv) Medical knowledge. An officer must, in the opinion of the recommending authority, have a sound tactical and general military knowledge appropriate to his rank.

(v) Staff experience. Before joining the Staff College, officers must have had experience in a staff appointment or must have been attached to the Staff for at least a month. This attachment can be either before or after recommendation for the Staff College. In the latter, the recommending authorities are responsible for informing G. immediately, should an officer prove unsatisfactory during his attachment so that his name may be removed from the list of candidates selected.

(b) Officers recommended for appointment to a HQ other than one in a field formation

(i) Age. Officers recommended should be over 30 and under 41 on the 1 July immediately preceding the course for which they are recommended. In exceptional circumstances which must be fully explained when the recommendation is made, officers of 30 years of age or under may be recommended.

- (iii) Regimental experience. Officers recommended must have had at least one years service with a unit.
- (iv) Political knowledge. An officer must, in the opinion of the recommending authority, have a sound tactical and general military knowledge appropriate to his rank.
- (v) Staff experience. Before joining the Staff College, officers must have had experience in a staff appointment or must have been attached to the Staff for at least a month. This attachment can be either before or after recommendation for the Staff College. If the latter, the recommending authority is responsible for informing G. immediately, should an officer prove unsatisfactory during his attachment so that his name may be removed from the list of candidates selected.
- (b) Officers recommended for appointment to a staff other than one in a field formation **CHP**
- (i) Age. Officers recommended should be over 30 and under 41 on the immediately preceding the course for which they are recommended. In exceptional circumstances which must be fully explained when the recommendation is made, officers of 30 years of age or under may be recommended.
- (ii) Political Category. Provided an officer is fit for employment in a staff other than in a field formation there shall be no restriction regarding medical category.
