The Ministry of War Cabinet has asked again this Command to take interests in the derequisitioning of the above named Villa, the proprietor is Comm. G. ARNO, Consul General of Italy, and at the present moment in service with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

The question is, that this is a high Official who has suffered very much during the Nazi-Fascist occupation. For his comportment in regard of the Germans he was interned by the German SS for 9 months. In the prisons he was always under the menace of being shot without trial. After having escaped out of prison, he helped the underground movement, and besides others collaborated with the group of Milan, whose chief was the Gen. CADORNA and who received, hid and helped the American Major Mass SALVADORI who was the Liaison Officer with the partisans.

The urgent request of derequisitioning by Comm. ARNO is explained by the urgent necessity to live in his own house and to be able to offer his family, who also have suffered very much by the war, a place of tranquility and peace.

With the above quoted letter of that HQ it was communicated, that the Villa was requisitioned by the American Army in order to house there Officers on leave. -The interest taken by the M. of W. in this matter, the necessity of the Consul Arno, who for the work he has been doing deserves every attention and considering, that the zone of Cortina d'Ampezzo is largely provided with houses, that eventually could be used as lodging for Officers on leave if that is still needed by the American Army, we ask that HQ, to please contact the American Authorities
